SUBJECT: Expanding the In-Country Refugee Processing Program
in Haiti

In order to implement the President's decision to increase the capacity of the in-country refugee processing program in Haiti, the Department of State and the Immigration and Naturalization Service have requested from Embassy Port au Prince approval to increase the number of INS personnel in Haiti by six to permit increased adjudications. The Department of State also is instructing our Embassy in Port au Prince to notify the International Organization for Migration, the agency responsible for preparing refugee cases in Port au Prince, of the proposed INS increase so that it may adjust the number of support staff it provides to our program in order to meet the additional demands.
