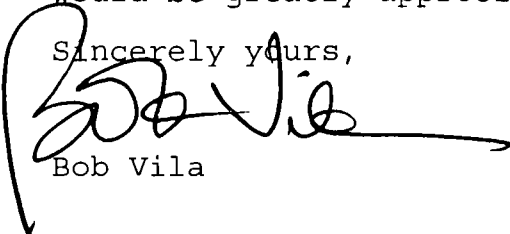
Dear Mr. President:

As a Cuban-American I applaud your actions and support of legislation aimed against the Castro dictatorship. I am writing you with a personal request from the Vila family.

My elderly aunt, AnaMaria Vila, the last family member remaining in Havana, was recently denied an exit visa. We had hoped to bring her to Miami for a 2 month visit. She is in her early seventies but frail and malnourished. This is likely to be the final opportunity for her to be with family since she refuses to become a refugee and wishes to live out her life on her native soil.

Mr. President, I'm told that the U.S. Interests Office in Havana can be influential in obtaining visas for Cuban nationals wishing to visit relatives in Miami. Your help would be greatly appreciated.
