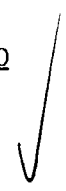

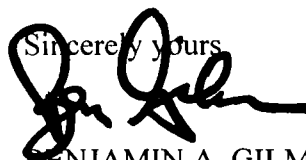

I wish to assure you that I will actively support the effort to consider appropriate legislation in the House of Representatives to permit certain Haitians who fled unrest during the de facto military regime and presently live in the U.S. to apply for legal immigration status. I understand that legislation regarding Haitian nationals will be introduced in Congress before the end of session.

I further understand that while this legislation is under consideration, you will authorize the Attorney General to take appropriate administrative actions to allay the concerns of affected Haitians residing in the U.S. I look forward to working with you to fashion an equitable solution that responds to the legitimate concerns of the Haitian community in the United States.

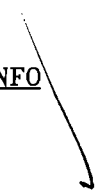

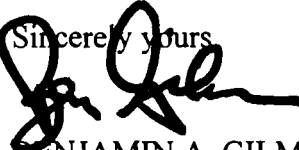
