- THE UNITED STATES REAFFIRMS ITS COMMITMENT TO THE PRINCIPLE OF RESPECT FOR INTERNATIONAL TREATIES, THE TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF THE COUNTRIES CONCERNED AND OF INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNIZED BORDERS. THE UNITED STATE CALLS ON GREECE AND TURKEY TO RESOLVE THEIR DISAGREEMENTS BY PEACEFUL MEANS, WITHOUT FORCE OR THE THREAT OF FORCE.

- WE BELIEVE THAT THE BEST VENUE FOR ADDRESSING SUCH QUESTIONS OF OWNERSHIP IS THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE OR SOME OTHER CONSENSUAL BODY.

- SUCH A TRIBUNAL WOULD BE WELL-SUITED TO GATHER AND EVALUATE ALL THE NECESSARY INFORMATION, WEIGH IMPARTIALLY THE LEGAL ARGUMENTS OF BOTH SIDES, AND EXPLAIN THE BASIS FOR ITS RULINGS.
