SUBJECT: REGIONAL ECONOMIC ROUNDTABLES

Planning is underway for follow-up events to the Economic Conference held 2 years ago. The events will focus on "making the economy work for working people." Although nothing is absolutely set, we are looking at four regional roundtables with the first being held in Atlanta, Georgia on March 28 or 29. These are day long events at which participants will engage in roundtable discussions with the President, Cabinet members, and senior White House officials on the state of the economy in that region.

The participants will be drawn from the list of attendees of the original Economic Conference.
