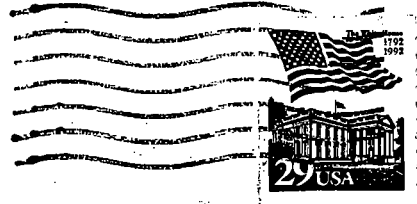
It was most gracious of you to include me with your Auntie Lon for a VIP Tour of the White House. The recollections of such a Tour will be with me for all time.

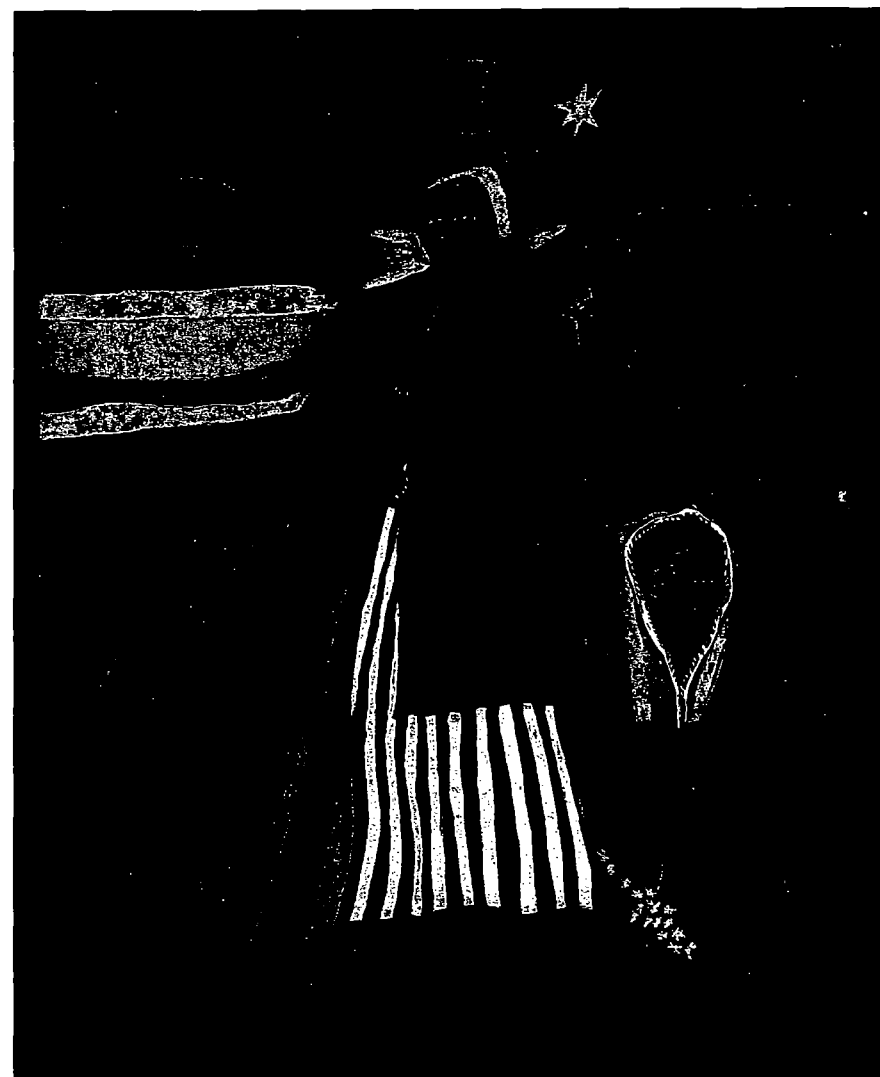

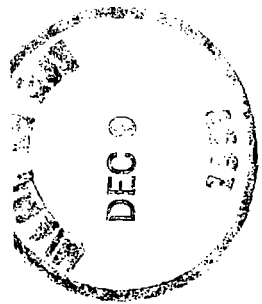

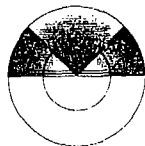

Our Loving Mother's Monthly Message to the United States

November 13, 1993

"Unity, oneness. Unity, oneness." [The Blessed Mother then waited ... see explanation on page 2 of this *Journal*.]

"My dear children, in the peace and love of my Son I greet you. My heart is joyful to have you in prayer. My heart remains sorrowful over the many souls of my children who are lost.

"I have come to encourage you to persevere in your prayers, dear children. The Evil One has planted many seeds of division in the hearts of men everywhere. Please, with the help of my Son, you will be able to resist him.

"The divisions are growing, dear ones, to you who choose to live apart from God. The way of God is the way of love and sacrifice and obedience. Please children, it is up to you to respond to these invitations of love from my Son. You are under my mantle but, please, be united under my mantle. The divisions I speak about are deep within men's hearts now, and they will increase unless you receive these words within your heart and respond to them.

"Our hearts are sorrowful and you, my dear little ones, will suffer more. Please amend your lives; and return to a life of obedience and love that my Son has set before you.

"I love you, my dear little children, and I cherish each one of you. I will bless you and everything you have brought with you. I bless you through my Son. As you make the Sign of the Cross, you will receive this blessing from my Son and I will depart but know that We will remain with you. Please thank my Son for permitting me to come."

God the Father - November 2, 1993

November 13, 1993

It was a mild, Fall Saturday. Over 100,000 pilgrims came to pray the 15 decades of the Rosary with the Blessed Mother. This was the largest number of pilgrims to be present for an apparition at Conyers. Considering the large number of pilgrims, the traffic and parking flowed reasonably well with many pilgrims arriving early in the morning.

On the day before the monthly apparition, the County notified the ministry of its new noise ordinance. The ministry was told that if it did not lower the sound system at the apparition site, it would not be allowed to use the system in the future. The sound system is primarily used to broadcast the praying of the Rosary by the priests and nuns in the apparition room, to relay the monthly message as Nancy hears it and for Nancy to talk with the pilgrims after the apparition. The ministry sought to comply with the new ordinance but this did make it difficult for many pilgrims to hear and pray the Rosary in unison.

JESUS SPEAKS BEFORE THE APPARITION

On November 13, 1993 just before noon, Nancy was praying in a small room adjacent to the apparition room. Outside the pilgrims were praying the *Angel's Prayer* given to the three young children at Fatima in 1916. As the pilgrims prayed this prayer, Nancy saw a tiny white flame appear and, then, a huge Host appeared. Nancy saw Saint Joseph and one saint after another appear.

Jesus said to Nancy from the crucifix in the room, **"I ask My dear little children from this very cross to prepare your heart for Me. I love each of you, My dear little children, whether you reject Me or accept Me, whether you hate Me or love Me. I love you all. Go in My peace and love."**

THE ACCOUNT OF THE MONTHLY APPARITION

The following account was prepared from the written notes of Nancy's friend, George, who was next to her in the apparition room:

In the apparition room, Nancy saw a mystical light descend. She tested in the Name of Jesus and the light remained.

The Blessed Mother said, **"Thank you, my dear children, for your pilgrimage of love and faith. As you pray the Rosary, know that my Son and I are with you and my heavenly court.**

"Where is the reparation? Where is the reparation? Reparation, I tell you solemnly, where is reparation being done in this world?" Jesus - October 13, 1993
