BACKGROUND: Each year, the breakfast chair and other members of the committee meet the President to get his input on the program and guest speakers. This year, the Oval Office meeting was held in October with Rep. Martin Lancaster, this year's breakfast chair, and Senator Mark Hatfield. The President suggested Andrew Young as guest speaker.

DURATION: Two hours (7:30 am - 9:30 am)

LOCATION: International Ballroom, Washington Hilton Hotel

PARTICIPANTS: Over 3,000 people including members of Congress; foreign dignitaries; heads of state; members of the clergy and lay people from throughout the country

OUTLINE OF EVENTS:

- o The President arrives and briefly meets with 20-30 international visitors. Photos are taken. (10 minutes)
- o The President has photos taken with the head table guests. (10 minutes)
- o The President is escorted to the head table. Breakfast is served.
- o The program (see attached)

REMARKS REQUIRED:

Remarks are required. Speechwriting should prepare the remarks.

MEDIA COVERAGE:

Last year, C-SPAN carried the program live. That was the first time ever media was allowed to cover the event. To date, the upcoming prayer breakfast is closed to the media, but that is subject to change.
