Family Physicians (AAFP).

PURPOSE: To thank the AAFP for their support of
our health priorities, to allow them to
briefly share some of their priorities
for the 104th Congress and to take a

BACKGROUND: The AAFP is a 75,000 member organization
representing family physicians,
specializing in preventive and primary
care. This organization has been
strongly supportive of the
administrations health care efforts from
the beginning as well as other key
initiatives.

Although they are key players in the
health care community, they are also
important to us politically because they
are more apt to be women and minorities,
and they are more apt to serve in health
care areas (i.e., public hospitals,
community health centers, etc) where we
have received the strongest support.
