REQUEST: To have the President conduct a taped radio
interview with African-American talk show host
Tom Joyner and a taped radio interview with the
American Urban Radio Network.

PURPOSE: To commemorate Martin Luther King's Birthday and
to reach out to the African American community.

BACKGROUND: Tom Joyner is an African American radio morning
show host who currently syndicates his morning
show from 6-11 AM EST on about 35 stations
around the country. Joyner is open and
favorable to the administration. Joyner has
interviewed the Vice President twice and Mrs.
Gore once. Joyner flew with the President on
Air Force One from Washington to Dallas back in
March and several months ago attended the
Mandela State Dinner.

AURN is an African American radio network which
has 300 affiliates nationwide. The Vice
President was interviewed by this network a few
months ago. AURN hosted the President's weekly
radio address when he conducted a joint address
with President Mandela.

PREVIOUS PARTICIPATION: The President was interviewed by Tom Joyner
twice and AURN once during the recent
Congressional elections.

DATE AND TIME: Thursday, January 12, 1995, anytime.

DURATION: Twenty minutes.

LOCATION: To be determined.

PARTICIPANTS: Talk show host Tom Joyner via telephone and AURN
White House Correspondent Bob Ellison.

OUTLINE OF EVENTS: The President calls Tom Joyner and then the
President is interviewed by Bob Ellison of AURN
in person.

MEDIA COVERAGE: These interviews will air the morning of
January 13.
