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DRAFT JUSTICE DEPARTMENT STATEMENT ON EDF v. MASSEY

In declining to seek a rehearing in this case today, the administration has decided not to challenge the Court's precise holding -- namely, that the National Environmental Policy Act applies to the National Science Foundation's activities in Antarctica described in the opinion. However, the administration does not embrace language in the opinion which may be interpreted to extend beyond this holding.
