A welcome and general introduction, peppered with new information--since we last spoke to the members:

- We've been reaching out to everyone in the Pacific Northwest delegation along with the governors--on a bipartisan basis--and will continue to be ready to assist you;
 - The Conference will take place at the Oregon Convention Center;
 - Besides making sure the members and Senators and Governors are kept advised, we've also spent a great deal of time on interdepartmental coordination and communication;
 - We want you to know who the people are you'll be dealing with. Besides me, Marla Romash is handling all press inquiries about the Conference. Tom Tuchmann is overseeing the participant selection process. Stephanie Solien is heading our efforts in Congressional and Intergovernmental Affairs. Dave Van Note is heading all of our efforts on site in Portland;
 - Mr. Van Note may be contacting your offices back in the Northwest. We have a team of people already there who will be working on logistics;
 - Tom Tuchmann has been given all of the names of potential Conference participants that you've sent us. We welcome additional suggestions, but we must have them by Friday.
