In honor of Science-based commercial whaling wouldn't it make logical sense to not do testing on creatures at the brink of extinction.

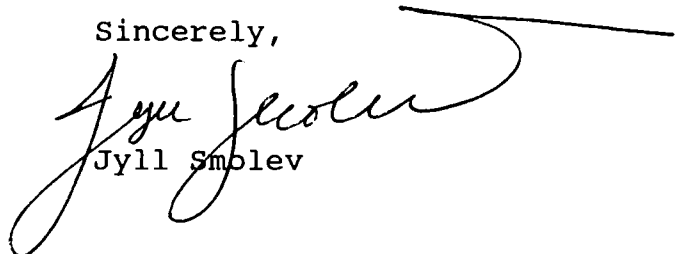
