Dear Mr. Chairman:

I am writing to join you in opposing any amendment to reduce the educational award provided for national service participants under H.R. 2010, the National Service Trust Act. I believe that the \$5,000 award is fair and appropriate.

As a long-time supporter of the national service concept, I have tried to ensure that any civilian national service option compliments, rather than competes with, military recruiting efforts. I agree with Secretary Aspin's statement that "the civilian national service program reflected in H.R. 2010 will not adversely impact military recruiting." The civilian program is far smaller, appeals to different individuals, and offers lower benefits than military service. There is no reason to believe that civilian service will in any way undermine the ability of our military to recruit individuals of the highest caliber.

The \$5,000 award is the result of a compromise among Democrats, Republicans, and representatives of veterans groups, including you and President Clinton. It is a reasonable benefit, smaller than comparable GI Bill benefits, but significant enough to help pay for post-secondary education. I have enclosed a comparison of national service benefits and military service benefits prepared by the Senate Armed Services Committee for your review.

As an advocate of civilian and military service, I join you in opposing amendments to reduce the award.

Implications of National Service on Military Service

1. We have consistently taken the position that the benefits for military service must be comparatively more attractive than benefits for national service. S. 919 and H.R. 2010 are consistent with this basic principle.

2. The annualized benefit for military service is 30% higher under the basic MGIB case and 40% higher under the MGIB with kicker case. In addition, the primary military target population is 18-year old male high school degree graduates who score in the average or above mental categories, and who are physically fit. this The National Service Program is not limited to target group. For example, people of all ages, both genders, and any disability status are welcomed in the National Service program.

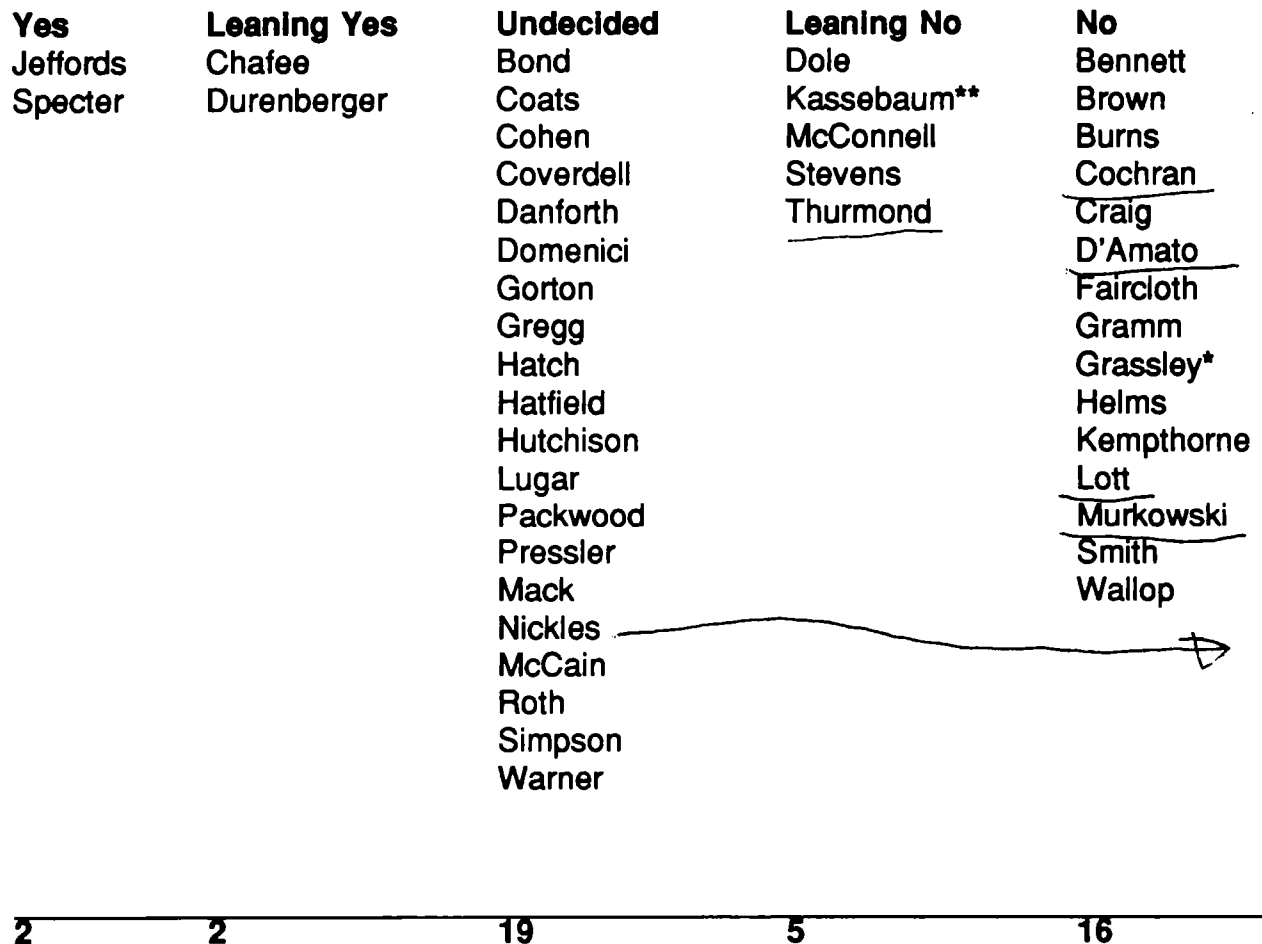
