**Corps members consist of 40 young members of state
service corps -- ten each from the Penn. Service
Corps; Maryland Service Corps; City Year (Boston)
and D.C. Service Corps. They are all in their
uniforms.**

Three young speakers include:

- o Pricilla Aponte: A fifth grader (11) from the Blackstone School in Boston whose class is involved in Service Learning projects (per City Year and Senator Kennedy's office.)
- o SOS Young Participant: Yet to be determined -- who answered the President's Rutgers challenge.
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10:30 Eli Segal serves as moderator. Segal makes brief welcoming remarks and sets context for the event. Segal introduces Representative Ford.

10:33 Ford makes brief remarks and introduces Kennedy. Ford is reseated in front row.

10:38 Kennedy makes brief remarks and introduces 11-year old Pricilla Aponte. Kennedy is reseated in front row.

10:43 Pricilla makes brief remarks.

10:44 Eli Segal introduces first and second SOS participants.

10:45 First SOS participant makes brief remarks.

10:47 Second SOS participant makes brief remarks.

10:49 Eli Segal introduces the Vice President.

10:50 The Vice President makes brief remarks and introduces the President.

10:54 The President makes brief remarks and acknowledgements.

10:59 The President sits at the bill signing desk on stage with the backdrop of the young Corps members. The President signs the bill with pens from Kennedy/Peace Corps and Roosevelt/CCC bill signings.

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11:01 President and all on stage stand up.

Closing number with all standing on stage.
Closing number by Aretha Franklin or
Bonnie Raitt.
