Summary of Conclusions

1. We will push for Bosnian Serb compliance with the Gorazde exclusion zone and, if necessary, point to their failure to comply to explain lack of progress on a country-wide cessation of hostilities. (S)
2. To that end, Ambassador Albright will explore the possibility of a Security Council Presidency statement urging compliance with the Gorazde zone. If the GOBH is holding Serb hostages in the Gorazde area, the Presidency statement could call for their release. (S)
3. We will not press the GOBH to drop its insistence on compliance with the Gorazde zone as a condition for a country-wide cessation of hostilities. (S)

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4. We will strongly urge the GOBH to accept the Contact Group's proposals for a 51-49% territorial division. (S)

5. To encourage the GOBH, we will reiterate our commitment to helping implement a viable settlement as strongly as possible while still noting the need for Congressional support. (S)

6. We also will tell other Contact Group members that if the GOBH accepts the Group's proposal and the Bosnian Serbs reject it, we will expect their support for further tightening sanctions on Serbia. (S)

7. Leon Fuerth will prepare an analysis of the New York Times 5/29 allegation that sanctions are having no serious effect on Serbia. (S)
