2. WE UNDERSTAND THE SC IS TO MEET MONDAY AUGUST 1 WITH THE SYG TO DISCUSS HIS LETTER ON UNPROFOR WITHDRAWAL (REF). MISSION MAY DRAW ON THE FOLLOWING, WHERE POSSIBLE EMPHASIZING COMMONALITY OF VIEWS WITH OTHER COUNCIL MEMBERS:

-- WE AGREE WITH SOME OF THE SUBSTANTIVE POINTS IN THE SYG'S LETTER:

- -- UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, IT MIGHT BE NECESSARY FOR UNPROFOR TO REDEPLOY, EVEN TO WITHDRAW FROM BOSNIA.

- -- WE TOO WANT TO ASSURE THE SAFETY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF UNPROFOR, AND RECOGNIZE THAT ITS NEUTRALITY IS VITAL IN THAT RESPECT.

- -- IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A PEACE AGREEMENT, WE WOULD NOT EXPECT UNPROFOR TO BEAR THE MAIN BURDEN OF IMPLEMENTATION, ESPECIALLY THAT REQUIRING A MILITARY FORCE.

-- HOWEVER, WE ALSO DISAGREE WITH IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF THE SYG'S LETTER:

- -- THERE IS AN IMPORTANT ROLE FOR UNPROFOR NOW, AND IN A BOSNIA IMPLEMENTATION SCENARIO, ESPECIALLY IN PROVISION OF CIVILIAN AND POLICE PERSONNEL, JUST AS THE SYG HAS NOTED THERE IS A CONTINUING UN POLITICAL AND HUMANITARIAN ROLE.

- -- THERE IS ALSO AN IMPORTANT AND CONTINUING ROLE FOR UNPROFOR IN CROATIA AND MACEDONIA.

- -- WHILE WE WOULD NOT OVERLOOK THE CHALLENGES OF COORDINATING COMMAND AND CONTROL BETWEEN UNPROFOR AND THE MILITARY COMPONENT OF AN IMPLEMENTATION FORCE, WE THINK THIS COORDINATION CAN BE ACHIEVED.

-- APART FROM THE ISSUE OF THE LETTER'S SUBSTANCE, WE WERE CONCERNED THAT THE ISSUANCE OF THE LETTER, COMING AS IT DID SHORTLY BEFORE THE CONTACT GROUP MINISTERS MET IN GENEVA, MIGHT AFFECT THE CONTACT GROUP PROCESS.

-- THE SECURITY COUNCIL HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO CONSIDER UNPROFOR'S MANDATE WITHIN THE NEXT TWO MONTHS. THE COUNCIL WILL CONSIDER THE SECRETARY GENERAL'S VIEWS. IN DOING SO, THE COUNCIL WILL CONSIDER THE SECRETARY GENERAL'S VIEWS, AS IT WILL ALSO CONSIDER THE SITUATION ON THE GROUND.

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July 30 Ministerial on Bosnia

- o Contact Group Foreign Ministers have just concluded a meeting to take action to deal with the tragic conflict in Bosnia.
- o We have reaffirmed our unity of purpose in pressing for a negotiated settlement and carried forward our step by step approach that has succeeded in driving this process forward.
- o We have made clear that a settlement must preserve Bosnia and Herzegovina as a single union within its internationally recognized borders.
- o We also condemned recent Bosnian Serb actions against UN personnel and warned against any renewed effort to effect the strangulation of Sarajevo.
- o We welcomed the response of the Bosnian Federation, which has accepted the proposals unconditionally. But we concluded that the Bosnian Serb response was tantamount to a rejection of the proposed territorial settlement.
- o We also reaffirmed our determination to act on the agreements reached on July 5 to promote acceptance of the Contact Group proposal.
- o In light of the Bosnian Serbs' rejection of the proposal, we decided to move ahead in stages with implementation of the consequences package.
- o First, we agreed that we will put forward to the Security Council proposals for a new resolution that would extend sanctions against Serbia and tighten enforcement of existing sanctions. A new resolution will be presented next week.
- o Second, we expressed our commitment to strengthen the protection of safe areas and requested finalization of the planning to permit extension and strict enforcement of the exclusion zones -- an essential step in light of the need to safeguard the security of UNPROFOR troops as this process moves forward. We agreed that the planning is to be completed promptly in August.
- o We also reiterated that if the Bosnian Serbs continue in their rejection of the Contact Group proposal, a decision in the Security Council to lift the arms embargo could become unavoidable.
- o We agreed to instruct the Contact Group to work further with the front-line states on sanctions enforcement.

- o Regarding the embargo, the Secretary made clear to his colleagues that the U.S. is not prepared to see this process strung out indefinitely.
- o The Secretary stressed that if this phased approach to increasing the pressure on the Serbs to accept does not work, pressures in the United States to lift the arms embargo will become irresistible.
- o While our goal remains a negotiated settlement, we cannot allow the current situation -- in which the victim is penalized unfairly and denied the right to defend himself -- to continue for long without some remedy.
- o This is not an easy course we have chosen. It is not free from risk or commitment. But we believe we have no other choice if we want to achieve our common goal of bringing a durable peace to Bosnia.
