DATA LIMITATIONS

The tables are based on the latest agency data on obligations¹. They tally direct Federal obligations, but exclude other Federal resources that are related indirectly to disasters. For example, Federal income maintenance programs such as unemployment compensation to those who lost jobs due to the disasters are not in this report. Changes to Federal tax liabilities such as refunds for losses claimed against 1992 or 1993 taxes are not covered either. The totals shown include gross loan levels as opposed to loan subsidies, which would normally be scored in the budget (loan subsidies are tracked in the database). This presentation of loan levels is consistent with the original tables on the disasters. Lastly, a few of the agencies could not break out some program obligations by state. Examples include the USDA's FmHA loan program, the Commerce EDA program and the Department of Education's Impact Aid and Student Financial Assistance. The data are preliminary and, in some cases, incomplete. The next update should show some improvements.

DATA LIMITATIONS

The tables are based on the latest agency data on obligations¹. They tally direct Federal obligations, but exclude other Federal resources that are related indirectly to disasters. For example, Federal income maintenance programs such as unemployment compensation to those who lost jobs due to the disasters are not in this report. Changes to Federal tax liabilities such as refunds for losses claimed against 1992 or 1993 taxes are not covered either. The totals shown include gross loan levels as opposed to loan subsidies, which would normally be scored in the budget (loan subsidies are tracked in the database). This presentation of loan levels is consistent with the original tables on the disasters. Lastly, a few of the agencies could not break out some program obligations by state. Examples include the USDA's FmHA loan program, the Commerce EDA program and the Department of Education's Impact Aid and Student Financial Assistance. The data are preliminary and, in some cases, incomplete. The next update should show some improvements.
