It is my understanding that the carbon cycle research money is coming out of the \$75M pot NOT the \$25M pot. The \$18M/\$7M split was a suggestion from Mark Weatherly to USDA regarding how to allocate the \$25M [which Linda told me she was comfortable with]. I assume you've spoken to Linda Delgado today. I spoke to her several times yesterday and she feels that USDA is just not quite ready to talk about how they would spend the \$25M. We need to ensure that USDA does not simply absorb the additional money in to NRCS or ARS. I think an internal meeting would be helpful; perhaps we can suggest to USDA how to allocate the funds versus waiting for them to give us ideas. For example, spending some of the NRCS money on training the field employees about sequestration, no-till farming, and other climate benefits of conservation efforts so they can help educate farmers.

STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT

Last March, in the wake of Pope John Paul's historic visit to Cuba, I authorized measures designed to ease the plight of the Cuban people and help them prepare for a democratic future. The restoration of direct passenger flights, resumption of family remittances, expansion of people-to-people contacts, and increases in the sale of medicines since then have had a positive impact. They demonstrate the United States, compassion for the Cuban people, our strong interest in building bonds between the citizens of our nations, and our determination to provide the people of Cuba with hope in their struggle against a system that for four decades has denied them even basic human rights.

Building on the success of the measures I announced last March, I am today authorizing additional steps to reach out to the Cuban people:

- Expansion of remittances by allowing any U.S. resident (not only those with families in Cuba) to send limited funds to individual Cuban families as well as to organizations independent of the government.
- Expansion of people-to-people contact through two-way exchanges among academics, athletes, scientists, and others, including streamlining the approval process for such visits.
- Authorization of the sale of food and agricultural inputs to independent non-governmental entities, including religious groups and Cuba's emerging private sector, such as family restaurants and private farmers.
- Authorization of charter passenger flights to cities in Cuba other than Havana and from some cities in the United States other than Miami in order to facilitate family reunification for persons living outside those cities.
- An effort to establish direct mail service to Cuba, as provided for in the Cuban Democracy Act of 1992.

At the same time, we are taking steps to increase the flow of information to the Cuban people and others around the world, by strengthening Radio and TV Marti and launching new public diplomacy programs in Latin America and Europe to keep international attention focused on the need for change in Cuba. The United States will continue to urge the international community to do more to promote respect for human rights and democratic transition in Cuba.

I am also pleased to announce that I intend to nominate Mr. Jose "Pepe" Collado and Ms. Avis Lavelle as members of the Advisory Board for Cuba Broadcasting. I further intend to designate Mr. Collado as chairman upon confirmation by the Senate. This important advisory body has been without a chairman since the death of Jorge Mas Canosa more than a year ago. We are processing other nominations and, in cooperation with congressional leaders, will continue to name members of this bipartisan board.

These steps are designed to help the Cuban people without strengthening the

Cuban Government. They are consistent with our policy of keeping pressure on the regime for democratic change -- through the embargo and vigorous diplomatic initiatives -- while finding ways to reach out to the Cuban people through humanitarian efforts and help in developing civil society. They are also consistent with the Cuban Democracy Act and the Cuban Liberty and Democratic Solidarity Act. They reflect a strong and growing bipartisan consensus that the United States can and should do more to work with the Cuban people toward a future of democracy and prosperity.

TEXT OF A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT
TO THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE

January 5, 1999

Dear Mr. Speaker: (Dear Mr. President:)

On June 9, 1998, by Executive Order 13088 (63 Fed. Reg. 32109, June 12, 1998), I declared a national emergency to deal with the unusual and extraordinary threat to the national security and foreign policy of the United States constituted by the actions and policies of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), and the Republic of Serbia with respect to Kosovo. The order blocks all property and interests in property of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), the Republic of Serbia and the Republic of Montenegro within the United States or within the possession or control of United States persons, and pro-hibits all new investment in the territory of the Republic of Serbia by United States persons, and the approval or other facilitation by United States persons of other persons' new investment in the territory of the Republic of Serbia.

1. The declaration of the national emergency on June 9, 1998, was made pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the United States, including the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.), the National Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.), and section 301 of title 3 of the United States Code. The emergency declaration was reported by message to the Congress dated June 10, 1998, pursuant to section 204(b) of the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1703(b)).

The present report is submitted pursuant to 50 U.S.C. 1641(c) and 1703(c) and covers the period from June 9 through December 8, 1998. It discusses only Administration actions and expenses directly related to the exercise

of powers and authorities conferred by the declaration of a national emergency in Executive Order 13088.

2. The Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC), acting under authority delegated by the Secretary of the Treasury, implemented the sanctions imposed under the foregoing statutes and Executive Order 13088 and has issued the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) Kosovo Sanctions Regulations, 31 CFR part 586 (the "Regulations") (63 Fed. Reg. 54575, October 13, 1998). A copy of the Regulations is attached to this report.

The Regulations block all property and interests in property of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), the Republic of Serbia, and the Republic of Montenegro that are in the United States, that hereafter come within the United States, or that are or hereafter come within the possession or control of United States persons, including their overseas branches. The Regulations also prohibit financial transactions with, including trade financing for, the Governments of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), the Republic of Serbia,

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and the Republic of Montenegro by United States persons. However, the Regulations provide an exemption, contained in section 2 of Executive Order 13088, for financial transactions, including trade financing, by United States persons within the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) that are (a) conducted exclusively through the domestic banking system within the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) in local currency (dinars), or (b) conducted using bank notes or barter.

The Regulations also prohibit all new investment in the territory of the Republic of Serbia by United States persons, and the approval or other facilitation by United States persons of other persons' new investment in the territory of the Republic of Serbia. The term "new investment," means (a) the acquisition of debt or equity interests in, (b) a commitment or contribution of funds or other assets to, or (c) a loan or other extension of credit to, a public or private undertaking, entity, or project, other than donations of funds to charitable organizations for purely humanitarian purposes. Any transaction by a United States person that evades or avoids, or that has the purpose of evading or avoiding, or attempts to violate, any of the prohibitions set forth in Executive Order 13088 is prohibited. Finally, the Regulations provide a general license, authorizing all transactions by United States persons involving property or interests in property of the Government of the Republic of Montenegro, except as provided pursuant to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) and Bosnian Serb-Controlled Areas of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina Sanctions Regulations, 31 CFR part 585.

3. Since the issuance of Executive Order 13088 on June 9, 1998, OFAC has issued 73 specific licenses, the majority of which (55) authorized financial transactions with respect to personal remittances by individuals to the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) and funding of humanitarian operations by nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) within the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro). Other licenses authorized certain diplomatic transactions, transactions related to air safety issues and payment of overflight fees, the closure of Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) entities formerly operating within the United States and the liquidation and main-tenance of blocked tangible property, and intellectual property protection for U.S. firms operating in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro). OFAC also instituted a mechanism for NGOs to continue to support humani-tarian opera-tions in Yugoslavia and administers a registration program for NGOs to route money and supplies there as appropriate.

Since June 9, 1998, U.S. banks and banks in the United States have reported to OFAC that they have blocked 877 transactions totaling \$20,361,767 pursuant to the sanctions. Most of the blockings were of funds transfers originating from, or destined for, Serbian banks.

4. The expenses incurred by the Federal Government in the 6-month period from June 9 through December 8, 1998, that are directly attributable to the declaration of a national emergency with respect to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) and the Republic of Serbia in connection with the situation in Kosovo are estimated at approximately \$715,000, most of which represents wage and salary costs for Federal personnel. Personnel costs were largely centered in the Department of the Treasury (particularly in OFAC and its Chief Counsel's Office), the Department of State, and the National Security Council.

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5. The situation reviewed above continues to present an extraordinary and unusual threat to the national security and foreign policy of the United States. The declaration of the national emergency with respect to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) and the Republic of Serbia contained in Executive Order 13088 was made in reaction to the unacceptable actions and policies of the Belgrade authorities in Kosovo, and continues to apply. The current situation in Kosovo is fragile and, as yet, unresolved. It is of particular importance that developments in Kosovo should not disrupt progress in implementing the Dayton peace agreement. This threat to the peace of the region constitutes an unusual and extraordinary threat to the national security of the United States.

With this in mind and in support of United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1099 and 1203, I shall continue to exercise the powers at my disposal with respect to the measures against the Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro), the Republic of Serbia, and the Republic of Montenegro, as long as these measures are appropriate, and will continue to report periodically to the Congress on

significant developments pursuant to 50 U.S.C. 1703(c).

PRESIDENT CLINTON ANNOUNCES INITIATIVES TO BREAK
THE CYCLE OF CRIME AND DRUGS
January 5, 1999

Today, President Clinton will announce significant budget initiatives to help break the cycle of crime and drugs. The President will announce new resources to help states and localities systematically test, treat, and sanction drug-involved offenders -- including \$215 million in his FY 2000 budget

proposal to enforce "zero tolerance" for drug use by prisoners, parolees, and probationers.

A new Department of Justice report, also released today, shows that in 1997 more than three-quarters of the nation's prisoners reported past drug use, more than half reported using drugs in the month before their offense, and one in six committed their crimes so they could purchase drugs.

The President's initiative responds to these findings.

Prisoner Drug Use. Today the Justice Department's Bureau of Justice Statistics will release a new study on prisoner drug use (Substance Abuse and Treatment, State and Federal Prisoners, 1997). Key findings regarding prisoner drug use include:

Vast majority of all prisoners report drug use. In 1997, 83 percent of state prisoners and 73 percent of federal prisoners reported past drug use --considerably more than the 21 percent of state prisoners and 60 percent of federal prisoners who are serving time for drug offenses. In addition, 57 percent of state prisoners and 45 percent of federal prisoners reported using drugs in the month before their arrest.

Many prisoners commit crimes to buy drugs or while on drugs. Nearly 20 percent of state prisoners and 15 percent of federal inmates reported committing their offense to get money to buy drugs. Thirty-three percent of state prisoners and 22 percent of federal prisoners were actually under the influence of drugs at the time of their offense.

Drug offenders have long "rap sheets." State prisoners serving sentences for drug offenses reported extensive criminal histories: 76 percent had been previously sentenced to prison or probation; 54 percent were on probation or parole at the time of their arrest; 45 percent had three or more prior sentences; and 23 percent had previously committed a violent crime. Although federal drug offenders generally reported less severe criminal histories, 59 percent had prior criminal records.

New Resources for "Zero Tolerance" Drug Supervision. The President will announce measures to ensure that the criminal justice system operates to keep offenders drug-and crime-free: (1) \$215 million in his FY 2000 budget proposal -- an increase of about \$100 million -- to drug-test and treat more people under criminal justice supervision; and (2) the availability of about \$120 million already appropriated for FY 1999 to help make prisoners and parolees drug-free.

(1) \$215 million for the most comprehensive drug supervision ever. The President's FY 2000 budget will include \$215 million for drug supervision, including an increase of about \$100 million for a proposed new program to help states and localities implement tough new systems to drug-test, treat, and punish prisoners, parolees, and probationers. This initiative

-more-

will ensure that states fully implement the comprehensive plans to drug-test prisoners and parolees that they are required by law to submit to the Justice

Department. The initiative will also support the efforts of states like Maryland and Connecticut to begin drug testing probationers on a regular basis. The President's FY 2000 budget also will include \$50 million -- an increase of 25 percent -- to expand the number of local drug courts and \$65 million for residential drug treatment in state prisons.

(2) About \$120 million this year for drug-free prison initiatives. The President will announce the release of the following grants to ensure that states fully implement their comprehensive plans for prison drug testing, treatment, and sanctions:

--Up to \$50 million for prison drug testing and intervention. Today the Justice Department will release new guidance informing states that they can use up to 10 percent of their prison construction funds (Violent Offender Incarceration/Truth-in-Sentencing grants) to drug-test and treat prisoners and parolees. Last year, President Clinton called on Congress to give the states this flexibility, and he fought for it to be included in the final budget agreement.

--\$63 million for residential drug treatment in state prisons. The Justice Department also will announce the availability of \$63 million for state prisons to provide long-term drug treatment and intensive supervision for prisoners with the most serious drug problems.

--\$6 million for new Drug-Free Prison initiatives. The President will announce that the Office of National Drug Control Policy will award \$6 million in grants to help eight states (AL, AZ, CA, FL, KS, MD, NJ, NY) and the Federal Bureau of Prisons make and keep their prisons drug-free. These grants will support surveillance systems, drug-sniffing K-9 teams, advanced technologies for drug detection, and other efforts to detect and deter drug use in prisons.

A Record of Accomplishment.

Pushed for drug testing and intervention in all states. The President fought for and signed the legislation requiring states to drug test prisoners and parolees as a condition for receiving prison grants. As a result, states were required to put in place comprehensive drug-testing and intervention plans for prisoners and parolees.

Expanded testing and treatment in federal prisons. The President has promoted drug testing and treatment in the federal prison system. In 1998, federal prisoners were subjected to nearly 133,000 drug tests. Additionally, the number of inmates required to receive treatment increased by fourfold from 5,450 in FY 1993 to 21,995 in FY 1998.

Leading the national drug court effort. Under the President's leadership, the number of drug courts has increased from an estimated 12 in 1994 to more than 400 today. Drug courts provide frequent drug testing, treatment, and tough supervision, and have been shown to reduce recidivism substantially.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: Let me, if I may, just make some very quick comments to follow on in the announcements we just made. There is a -- we've been involved for three years in what I think is the most fundamental problem that has been inadequately addressed in the drug threat to America -- that is the 4 million chronic addicts. And the 4 million chronic addicts at any given time, a huge number of them, probably the majority -- 3.5 million or more -- are involved in the criminal justice system. They're under arrest, in prison, or on probation or parole.

They are also the population that we believe consume two-thirds of all the drugs in America. And they're in a shoot -this process started when they were teenagers and it continues until they're dead unless something intervenes.

So what the President and the Attorney General and I did today was lay down another marker on something that formerly we said -- started in March of last year -- and that was a conference we had on the nexus between prisons, crime and drugs. And we brought together the country's experts. Our notion is by the coming fall we'll bring together a couple of thousand people and give them state legislators, community correction directors, a model on how to proceed ahead.

It's one of the reasons I had Lt. Governor Kennedy Townsend here; we have formed a partnership with the state on how to move in this direction.

Today what the President announced formally was -- and I noticed he carefully didn't use the actual dollar value -- between

FY'99, where our total drug budget again went up substantially -- it went up to \$17.8 billion -- but inside that, we had a significant increase in treatment dollars related to the criminal justice system. And you've heard these numbers talked about before. Specifically, there's three I'll just quickly highlight: residential substance abuse treatment; drug intervention program; and the drug-free prisons demonstration program. So there's some money there. We also got another \$50 million out of prison construction funding, which, in theory, a state now may elect to use for drug treatment in the criminal justice system.

Now, between FY'99 and 2000, the President just talked about a 40 percent increase in funding for those programs. So we'll have an increase of a minimum of \$62 million in the coming year.

The reason we're impressed about that -- the other thing he announced, hidden inside that money, was about \$6 million in a test grant -- there were seven states in there,

represented, today -- where we put a modest amount of money on the table for the federal system and state to sort out how do we keep drugs out of prisons. And some of the numbers are disgraceful. As high as nine percent of prisoners, depending on the system you go to, will test positive for drugs behind bars, and --

Q How do you explain it?

MR. MCCAFFREY: How do you explain it?

Q Well, how do you keep drugs out of prisons?

MR. MCCAFFREY: Well, some of the things in the \$6 million are going to be tested in the seven states in the federal system are things like ion scanner devices, which, we believe, where we've installed them, dramatic reductions in number of drugs coming in with the visitors. You tell the visitors, you're going to get swabbed, you will be tested. They come up positive, they leave, and the word goes out: you simply can't bring drugs into this federal prison.

There are also drug dogs; there's also increased training for prisoners. The next step will extend this to prisoner property inside the prison system. Using technology and intelligence, we think we can make a dramatic difference. And we owe it to ourselves to do it.

Now, that's sort of a modest piece of it, because the larger piece is how do we get prison-based drug treatment. And then, how do we have a follow-on component so, when they're released back to the community the drug treatment continues. If you do that -- and the numbers are almost beyond belief -- if you

do that, drug abuse at six months goes down as much as 73 percent and rearrest rates -- recidivism -- may go down more than 50 percent. So the payoff's immediate and potentially enormous to us.

That's what we talked about today, and I would ask you -- if you want to watch what we're doing and to sort of measure the proceedings -- when we bring out the 1998 strategy -- by the way, the law reauthorizing my agency passed, hidden in that 4,000-page omnibus bill -- we'll bring out the '99 strategy, it will be a five-year report. I won't put one out in the year 2000. And it will have tied to it performance measures of effectiveness, by law, I'll have to have those performance measures of effectiveness. And it also requires me, by law, to have a five-year drug budget projection.

So we're pretty upbeat. We think we're moving in the right direction. And the heart and soul of the effort, though, on prisons and drugs is the Attorney General, Secretary Shalala, and I. And on that note -- Jose, would you add in -- any questions I can respond to?

Q General McCaffrey, how did the problem get to be two-thirds of federal prisoners being drug offenders? How did it get to that level?

MR. MCCAFFREY: Well, the numbers are -- let me put them in context. The total number is 1.8 million and rising, and you sort out, where are they behind bars? The huge chunk of them is state-level prisoners, 900,000. About a half-million in county-city lockups, and 105,000 at federal level.

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The federal system is the place where DEA, FBI, ATF -- where we go after the major drug criminals. So if you look at that 105,000 prisoners, about 66 percent are drug-related offenses, and a huge number of those are the significant traffickers. You look at that 66 percent -- just another layer of the onion -- about half of them are foreign and half of them are American. So that's where we get the Colombians, Dominicans, Nigerians, Russians, as well as American criminal enterprise.

Q But what I'm saying is, how is it still happening? Why is it still happening? Why is it on the rise?

MR. MCCAFFREY: These are the drug traffickers. In other words, these don't tend to be drug abusers in the federal system.

Q But that's what I'm talking about, the drug abusers in the system. The prisoners who are abusers, there are instances --

MR. MCCAFFREY: That's not the federal system, by and large. The federal system -- the point I'm trying to make, the huge number of them, these are the retail, wholesale criminal enterprise. A lot of them are foreign, and -- for example, possession of marijuana. If you're behind bars in the federal system for possession of marijuana, the chances are that you were in possession of a little more than one ton.

Q Well, maybe I should change the way to ask this. Okay, let's say those who are in prison who are abusing --

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: Are abusing drugs? The place you should expect to see that is in county lock-ups. First of all, if you're addicted to drugs you're going to end up in trouble with the criminal justice system. It's a guarantee. Whether it goes nine years, but you'll end up there. You'll get in trouble sooner if you don't have a health insurance policy, if you don't have a steady income, if you're not part of a family. But sooner or later, whether you're an anesthesiologist or an 18-year-old young man with no job, you'll end up in trouble with the criminal justice system.

So if you look at the population, take heroin addicts, 800,000 of them, they're older, they're sicker, they have multiple felony convictions, and they're behind bars or on probation a good bit of their life. That's really what we're talking about -- how do you break the cycle of having a compulsive drug user -- how do you break the cycle of having them spending much of their lives under arrest, in the prison, out in three days or three years and back into compulsive drug use. And we've said if you don't do that, you simply can't get it, you can't address the problem.

Did I respond to your question?

Q No.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: Try again. Let me see if I can be

--

Q Sam, maybe you will be able to help me.

Q Well, April wants to know, I think, your last statement contained what she wants to know -- how do you break the cycle? Why are all these people there?

,

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: How do you go about it?

Q The addicts -- illicit drugs are getting into prisons, okay, state, local, federal, whatever.

Q Nine percent test positive.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: More likely, six percent. Nine percent is a high number. In one of our prisons it was nine percent.

Q What I'm saying is, why? Why is it continuing? Why are the numbers growing? Why? We understand in some --

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: The number is growing of --

Q Inmates who are addicts, who are currently addicts. We understand that there are some instances where police officers were actually bringing in drugs for inmates.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: Let me, if I can, try and --

Q Because if this is zero tolerance, you're talking zero tolerance, so that means no more drugs.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: Let's talk just about the prison population -- that's really your interest, right?

Q Yes.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: The chronic drug user who is behind bars and what do you do about it. And that -- what you do about it -- the easiest thing you do is you try and not have drugs in the prison system. You have to get them drug-free while you've got them under your control. And at one extreme you can say in some county lock-ups, with nothing going on, drugs are routinely available. You've got to get them drug-free.

So that \$6-million grant tests ways to go about that. But the larger issue, we've argued, is you can't just lock them up. You have to have a three-phase program: Phase one is diversion. When I'm arrested I'm tested for drugs. This is a break the cycle -- \$100 million in FY2000. I will be tested for drug use. If I test positive, I will go into drug treatment, mandated.

I'll then go to trial. If I'm convicted, I'll go into drug treatment in prison. When I'm in prison, part of the rationale for letting me out will be whether I responded to treatment. And then when I'm out I'm going to go to a work release program where I will continue getting tested and I'll know I can be reincarcerated for 21 days, not necessarily for four years.

Our data seems to suggest if you do that you have a dramatic change in the behavior of the compulsive drug user. And we haven't done that systematically. The federal system in the last five years has started doing it; the state has done very little of it except for states like Delaware, Maryland, California, Texas got going on it. But that's really where we're

trying to go.

What do you think? Am I getting a response? It's compulsive drug user.

,

Q Yes, you're there.

Q Let me sort of ask a related question. I'll ask the question and then give it some context. Do you feel that the federal prison system has enough funding or whatever for its drug abusers who are in prison? Because as you would know, 20 years ago federal prisons were considered white collar country club kinds of things. In those 20 years, though, Congress and the various Presidents have made more federal crimes and especially, of course, drug dealing and violent crimes and that kind of stuff. But do you think that the federal prison system itself has enough money to help treat its drug abusers, which the numbers I imagine would be growing.

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: No. Well, I'm sure we don't. Having said that, it's sort of the jewel of the system. I started this morning at 7:00 a.m. with a breakfast of the whole treatment team, which included Kathleen Hock-Sawyer (phonetic), who's the head of the Federal Bureau of Prisons. And she, properly, ought to be proud of the fact that our 42 institutions all can claim they have some form of drug treatment.

Now, having said that, we aren't even beginning to be where we need to be. But the federal system ought to be proud of what they've done. Almost every institution now has a screening device. Every institution has some form of drug treatment -- perhaps not residential, one-year, separate facilities. And she is also about to release, here, in the next few months, you'll see the 18-month data released. What that tells you is, many of our federal drug prisoners now, when they get out, are still under control of federal authorities. They continue to get drug testing, and they must stay in treatment.

And the six-month data -- how well they're doing -- is beyond-belief good. Let's wait and see what happens at 18 months. She'll talk about that in the next couple of months.

Federal systems in the van. State -- you know, Delaware's another place to go, look at an incredibly successful experiment, but their experiment is with 100 prisoners, male prisoners, about 100 females. Now we have to extend it to the drug-driven prison population. We're in the front end of this thing, no question.

Any other thoughts?

Q Do you enjoy your work? (Laughter.)

MR. MCCAFFREY: Actually, Sam, I do. I've been -- we've spent a lot of time making sure we have modest current expectations, but if you look at the long run -- look back 15 years at the nightmare we had in America from drug abuse, and where we are today, it's gotten better. I mean, even numbers in the last three years have dramatically gotten better. Crack cocaine -- people who are arrested and test positive for crack -- is down dramatically.

The most important figure, bar none, is adolescent Americans. That's a number for you to watch -- this year, next year, and the following year. Do those attitudes change, and do drug abuse rates by adolescents change, particularly the 8th graders. Watch the 8th graders. Now, what we have argued is, in the last two years, monitoring the future data, went from six years of steady growth; two years ago it leveled out. How significant is that? We didn't say at the time. The data Secretary Shalala and I just released, it all went down or leveled out. Tiny amounts, a percent, two percent, but they were all statistically significant from the test. So that, to me, is

the best news I've had.

The final thing we've said, can you actually make a difference about the consequences of drug-related compulsive action. Yes, you can. You can drive crime down. If you get treatment programs and hook them into the criminal justice system, it's guaranteed to make life better in America. And instead of a bunch of political guff in Congress, we've got Rob Portman, Denny Hastert, Steny Hoyer, Charlie Rangel, Biden, Hatch and others who are willing to help me pay for it. So we're getting the funding. We keep it up for 10 years and America is going to be better off.

Q Do you think it will be well-received in the Congress?

GENERAL MCCAFFREY: Sure. Yes. I think, over time what I hear now is a widespread recognition, the heart and soul of changing the problem is prevention. Both parties, both Houses will buy into that. Certainly the state governors will. And there's a grudging recognition that treatment sounds like smart drug policy. And I'll tell you who is supporting it -- you watch the law enforcement association line up behind it. The smart cops are basically supporting what we're trying to do.

And on that note -- sure.

There are three pots of money to keep straight here.

The first is the \$10 million for USDA for the carbon cycle research initiative, half of which would go to the Forest Service (for forest inventory) and half to the Agriculture Research Service, which is USDA's "in-house" science agency, for work on soil carbon. (This is the \$10 million that we allocated from the \$75 million CCTI package.) This work is more in the line of basic science-- getting a better understanding the carbon cycle in forests and croplands. It really is a part of the Global Change Research Program rather than CCTI and was developed separately in conjunction with the GCRP agencies.

Second is the \$10 million for USDA in CCTI itself. This is intended to support a biomass energy effort at USDA.

Third is the \$25 million that USDA got at the end of the appeals process. USDA had initially asked for an increase of \$100 million to support climate-related efforts, primarily in farm assistance programs that have environmental benefits -- like the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). Of that \$25 million, \$18 will go to the Natural Resources

Conservation Service, which houses all of the farmer assistance/conservation programs like the CRP and EQIP (Environmental Quality Incentives program). The remaining \$7 million would go to ARS. We are waiting for a proposal from USDA (expected by COB today) that would outline how USDA would propose to spend it. There is potential for some overlap with the \$5 million allocated to ARS for the carbon cycle research initiative noted above, but there doesn't have to be -- we'll need to see where USDA wants to put the \$7 million.

If there turns out to be some additional money available, we should consider raising USDA's biomass energy program under CCTI. Last year, USDA came in with a \$40 million request, and we feel a more aggressive effort than can be mounted with \$10 million would be appropriate.

The President today announced his intent to nominate Armando Falcon, Jr. to serve as Director of the Office of Federal Housing Enterprise Oversight at the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Mr. Armando Falcon, Jr., of San Antonio, Texas, served for eight years on the legal staff of the Committee on Banking and Financial Services, United States House of Representatives, reaching the position of General Counsel in 1995. In 1989, Mr. Falcon was an attorney in private practice in San Antonio, Texas. From 1986 to 1988, he served as a law clerk to the Texas Attorney General.

Mr. Falcon received his BA degree from St. Mary's University, an MPP degree from the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University, and his JD from the University of Texas School of Law.

The Office of Federal Housing Enterprise Oversight (OFHEO) performs the function of financial regulator of the Federal National Mortgage Association (FNMA) and the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (FHLMC) ("the enterprises"). He will be contacting Geri to be sure that he's using the same estimates of sales volumes in each category.

Here is what we worked out we (i)cite the numbers of vehicles in our estimate and the savings implied and say that sales of these vehicles will be strong,y encouraged by the credit (without having to be overly specific about saying exactly what fraction is induced by the credit), and (ii) estimate the potential savings over a 20 year period assuming a reasonable penetration of high efficiency vehicles (this will be very large).
