The Cabinet Room

THE PRESIDENT: First of all, I want to thank these distinguished leaders of the American labor movement for coming here today for this meeting. We are meeting to talk about the economy, the challenges we face in the 21st century -- in part, what I intend to say about it in the State of the Union next week. We will be discussing ways we can work together to save Social Security, to renew our public schools, to improve health care, and deal with a whole range of other issues.

In large measure, opportunity for America's labor families and their children will depend upon whether America can master the challenges of a global economy. We have worked hard over the last year, as all of you know, to deal with the global financial crisis and restore growth. I talked about that at the Detroit Economic Club on Friday. This will require a very vigorous set of actions this year, and part of it will involve the Congress, part of it will involve our work with other nations over the course of the year. But it will be very important.

I have received a briefing this morning from Secretary Rubin and my economic team on the situation in Brazil, and on the developments in the world markets. We are monitoring these developments closely, especially what is going on in Brazil. We've been in contact with key Brazilian government officials, the G-7, and other important countries. We've been in contact with the International Monetary Fund. We have a strong interest in saving Brazil, with whom we have worked on so many important things around the world, carrying forward with its economic reform plan, and succeed. And we certainly hope that they will.

At the present time, I think that's about all I have to say about developments in --

Q Mr. President, what do you think will be the outcome of the impeachment trial? We know what your hopes are, but what do you think is really going to happen?

THE PRESIDENT: I think the Senate -- we filed our brief today. It makes our case. The important thing for me is to spend as little time thinking about that as possible, and as much time working on the issues we're here to discuss as possible. They have their job to do in the Senate, and I have mine. And I intend to do it. I am --

Q Well, do you fear any removal from office, with the build-up of this case?

,

THE PRESIDENT: I think that the brief speaks for itself and the statements which have been made by hundreds of constitutional experts and others -- I trust that the right thing will be done. And I think, in the meanwhile, I need to work on the business of the people.

Q Mr. President, your impeachment is before the ,
union, and you're giving your State of the Union address. Don't you think you should directly address that matter during your speech?

THE PRESIDENT: I think the American people have heard about that quite extensively over the last year. My instinct is that I should do their business. I think they would like it if somebody up here would put their interests first, their business first. And I think that's what they expect me to do. They know the Senate has a job to do; they expect them to do it. There is nothing else to be said to the House about it. The Senate has to deal with it.

And my position is that, in addition to that, we have to deal with the problems of America, the challenges of America, the opportunities of America, and that's what I intend to do in the State of the Union speech.

Q Mr. President, your lawyers are arguing that the charges against you don't amount to high crimes and misdemeanors. Do you personally believe that perjury and obstruction of justice are not impeachable offenses?

THE PRESIDENT: I believe that it's not necessary for me to comment further than our brief. The important thing I think you should be asking yourself is, why did nearly 900 constitutional experts say that they strongly felt that this matter was not the subject of impeachment?

My opinion is not important here. My opinion is that I should be doing my job for the country, and other people should be handling the defense and dealing with this issue. And that's what I intend to do.

Q Mr. President, on Brazil. Do you -- harmful effect on the U.S. economy? We send a lot of exports to Latin America.

THE PRESIDENT: Well, as you know, we have worked hard to keep the financial crisis in Asia, which enveloped Asia last year, from spreading to Brazil. Latin America is our fastest growing market for American goods and services. And Brazil is the largest country in Latin America. So, obviously, we hope that the situation will be resolved in a satisfactory way not only for the people of Brazil, but for all of the people in the Americas that want to continue to enjoy the good progress that all of us have enjoyed in the last several years. And we're working hard to that end and will continue to do so.

Q Thank you.

REMARKS BY THE VICE PRESIDENT
AT ANNOUNCEMENT OF 20 NEW EMPOWERMENT ZONES

Old Executive Office Building

THE VICE PRESIDENT: Thank you. I appreciate your warm welcome. Thank you for coming. Welcome to the White House. Priscilla Hill Ardoin, thank you for your kind introduction. I want to thank you, and in thanking you I also want to express gratitude to all of the business partners who have been so instrumental in making these winning plans possible here today. The teams that are here in this audience have done an extraordinary job.

This is a little bit like the play-offs or the Super Bowl -- these winning teams have made it all the way. And congratulations to all of you. And key members of your teams have been from the business community and I want to thank all of the businesses that have stepped up to the plate, so to speak, and have made a lot of these winning applications possible.

I want to thank my colleagues, Secretary Cuomo and Secretary Glickman -- Rhoda Glickman is here today -- and Assistant Secretary Cardell Cooper, Under Secretary of Agriculture Jill Long Thompson, and other members of the HUD and Agriculture teams. These guys have worked incredibly hard. They're close friends, they're close friends of one another, and you can see their teamwork in the way this whole program has worked so smoothly. And Agriculture and HUD as agencies have done a fantastic job.

I'm going to acknowledge the individual Senators and members of the House and mayors and other leaders at the conclusion of my remarks, when we invite each group up for the award ceremony, so forgive me for not mentioning all of you at the beginning.

Also, there are a lot of enterprise communities that are going to be happy with the awards that are announced. We will not be presenting each one of them individually, but I want to express my congratulations to all of the enterprise community winners. And I know Senator Susan Collins, from Maine, has worked hard on the enterprise community that will be winning from Maine.

I want to thank my colleagues, Mickey Ibarra and Lynn Cutler, here in the White House; and Julian Potter, who has been the principal staff person heading up our empowerment zone and enterprise community initiative; and all of the local officials who are present -- congratulations and welcome.

This really is an extraordinary time for our country, because the excitement that you feel and the communities that have won here today is matched in communities all across the United States of America. Even in those communities that competed for these coveted awards, but did not receive the awards

today -- they've come together in order to apply for the award and they found out a lot about themselves in the process. We tried to design the application process in a way that would encourage communities to come together and develop a common vision of what the brightest future for that community might be.

I remember those early meetings six years ago, and I recall in one of those first meetings a little children's story that Disney came up with years ago -- you remember the story of Dumbo, the Elephant, with the big ears -- but he could only fly with his magic feather. And then in a moment of crisis, the feather was nowhere to be found and, of course, the feather was not ultimately necessary at all.

In a sense, the communities that have won these awards could have done most of what you have done without the award -- you could fly, so to speak, toward this brighter future even without this process. But the process, in many cases you've told us, has made it easier for you to get some of the sectors of the

communities, some of your partners to come to the table and really pay close attention to what the whole community has at stake. And I think really the biggest success of this whole Empowerment Zone Enterprise Community program has been the way it has encouraged communities to come together. It's been a privilege for me to be a part of it and I am very excited at these awards today.

You know, I do want to say this -- both my colleagues had some kind words about the way the White House has steered this -- I want to make it very clear. A few days ago we passed an historic milestone in America. This is now the longest and strongest economic recovery in the entire history of the United States of America. (Applause.) And there's one man principally responsible for it, and that is President Bill Clinton. (Applause.) And we want to thank President Clinton for his leadership and policies that have made it possible. (Applause.)

And from the beginning the President and I have tried to design policies that not only would give our country a chance to have this strong, sustained economic growth, but would also make it possible for those communities that have been left out in the past, left behind during previous economic booms, to fully participate and to be a part of the prosperity. And the Empowerment Zone Enterprise Community program has been one of the central components of a whole set of policies that have been designed to make sure that people are not left behind.

The good news is that these policies are working. We're allowing everyone to participate. We can see our shining success in neighborhoods and communities and schools across America. We can see it in parents who are hopeful, who dream of a better future for their children and then for their grandchildren -- people who refuse to accept that the way things are is the way they will always be in the future. We see it in local residents, who are bridging the barriers that have divided neighborhoods and groups in the past instead of reaching out their hands across those barriers and joining in common dreams for a brighter future.

It's true that when President Clinton and I first took office there were many willing to throw in the towel on our distressed communities. There were a lot of reasons for that -- prejudice played a role; historic development patterns played a role -- there are many causes. But we knew that if America is going to be strong, our cities and distressed rural communities have to be strong, as well.

Today, in a world more connected than ever before, we really do need the talent and the skill of every single American if we're going to succeed as a nation. We really cannot afford to leave anybody behind.

Time and again we heard from mayors and community leaders who told us that one of the keys to a successful formula

was to avoid what the federal government has sometimes done in the past, and that is to come into cities and tell the cities what to do. Instead, what we heard was, listen to us and work with us and give us what we need to do -- in the way that we know how to do it. And so we designed this whole program as a partnership catalyzing program, to help bring jobs back to distressed communities, to help bring private business partners in and get them involved and prideful and committed to the kind of progress that they want to help produce in the communities that they serve.

We wanted, also, to make sure that rural communities would no longer be abandoned. There are so many rural communities where you can go into the high school senior class and ask how many of them are going to stay there, and practically none plan to. We want to change that. And new development patterns make it possible to create hope right in those rural communities. We wanted to encourage entrepreneurs to come back into the community and build their futures there.

Well, we know that there are a lot of other pieces to the puzzle and we've worked on community policing and bringing the crime rate down, transportation policies that make it possible for people going off welfare to get to jobs and back and forth; child care; strong family policies; an effective battle against drugs -- all of the parts of the puzzle do fit together. But economic opportunity and moving communities in the right direction is really at the heart of it.

And I'm proud to tell you today that of the first round winners in our Empowerment Zone and Enterprise Community competition, virtually all of them have shown tremendous progress; tens of thousands of jobs have been created. And now for the first time in more than a generation, our central cities and rural communities are sharing in America's success.

One reason is that this program does work in partnership with other efforts to bring money back to where it needs to be invested -- such as the Community Reinvestment Act, which has inspired the private sector to pledge more than \$1 trillion in loans to distressed communities, more than 95 percent of which have been made since 1993. That is why President Clinton and I are going to make sure that the Community Reinvestment Act remains strong for the 21st century.

I have personally been to every single one of these empowerment zones, several of them repeatedly. I've been to quite a few of the enterprise communities, and I've seen what's happening with my own eyes. I recognize a lot of faces in this room from people who have been at our annual White House conferences on empowerment zones. And, indeed, in the last one the applicant communities were invited to come in and have an intensive dialogue with the first round winners, so, as Secretary Glickman said, we could learn from what happened before -- and

Secretary Cuomo emphasized this.

And if you go to some of these zones you'll be astonished. If you go to Detroit, Mayor Archer will tell you about the \$2 billion in new private investment that has been leveraged right into the heart of the Detroit zone because of the empowerment zone process.

Go to Keysville, Georgia, and they'll tell you quickly about their innovative computer network that links small towns to promote the entire region with stunning success. Go to Kansas City, and Mayor Cleaver will show you how the incentives have helped to renovate the historic jazz district. All across America communities are even reconnecting to their neighboring communities -- not just to bring jobs and opportunity back, but to find common solutions to shared problems, to build more liveable communities and to improve their quality of life.

So now we're about to spark even more growth in jobs, because today we are awarding 20 brand new empowerment zones, 15 urban zones and 5 rural zones all across our country. The second round builds on the first round by providing new opportunity in new and creative ways. At a time when many communities across America are reaching across borders to come up with regional solutions to problems, more than one-third of the urban zones are being awarded to cities that came together to form regional partnerships. And also for the first time, round two allowed Indian tribes with high poverty to qualify for and receive designation. And we're awarding one today.

And that's just the beginning. I'm pleased to announce that in the budget we will submit to Congress next month we are seeking an additional \$1.6 billion in grants to help create jobs, leverage private investment, and bring businesses back to these 20 award winning communities today. We'll need your help. (Applause.)

And let me say, we need your help in building upon the strong bipartisan base of support in the Congress, by magnifying the message that this is a bipartisan approach. There was zero consideration given to whether these communities have been led by Democrats or Republicans or what areas they were in. This is about people, not politics. This is about the future of our country. And you can help us deliver that message loudly and clearly, and that the program works, in order to secure approval of that particular provision I just mentioned. Because if Congress approves full funding for our new empowerment zones, it will help create and retain about 90,000 jobs and stimulate more than \$20 billion in new private and public investment. That's a down payment on extending the American Dream to millions of Americans.

I mentioned that we're going to have 20 rural enterprise communities. This, too, is an investment that pays

off; 11 of the empowerment zones that we're naming today started out as enterprise communities four years ago. We estimate that they will create and retain 16,000 jobs and stimulate \$500 million in public and private investment. And, incidentally, these estimates are not pie-in-the-sky figures, they're based on the real experience that we've already had with the winning communities. These are real numbers.

And there are no losers, because the communities that have gone through this process have felt that it has been a very, very successful one, because groups that have never talked to one another came together for the first time and real progress was made. And that's why I'm proud to announce, as Secretary Cuomo mentioned, that we're going to seek \$45 million in special grants to be awarded to the 15 runner-up communities, and we're going to call them strategic planning communities that were finalists in the competition for urban empowerment zones.

The more we can invest in the dreams that are nurtured in these communities, the more we can give them the tools to reach those dreams and reach their goals, turn their dreams into reality. And the stronger our communities will be and the stronger our nation will be.

Now, ladies and gentlemen, I want to thank all of you for being the dreammakers. And now it's my pleasure to present the 20 award winners here today. I'm going to ask each delegation to join me on stage as I read off their names. We're going to go with the urban awards first, and then the rural awards. And then I'll make some very brief concluding comments.

(The awards were presented.)

THE VICE PRESIDENT: Now, ladies and gentlemen, just a brief closing comment. Again, I want to congratulate all of the award winners here today. The only way we're going to meet the challenges of our distressed urban and rural communities is if we work together, and that is exactly what we are doing.

Now, one final word. This award today is the beginning of a new era in these communities. I want you to know that our role as your partner is not over with the giving of this award and the resources that go along with it. We will continue to have our regular White House conferences, with the detailed break-out sessions on how to address and solve all the various problems that you've come across that you would like us to be teammates with you in solving. And we will continue to be available to you on a regular ongoing basis to facilitate communication with your peers and colleagues, and to identify other opportunities. As many of you know, along with this award designation comes not only the resources and the prestige, but also some extra help in various programs and the identification of opportunities.

So I want you to know that this is just the beginning
and it's just the beginning for our efforts to be good partners
with you, as well.

To one and all, once again, congratulations.
(Applause.)

MS. WEISS: Just moments ago, the President unveiled a three

-part budget initiative to improve the economic opportunities for Americans with disabilities. To further outline this proposal, we have Bruce Reed, the President's chief Domestic Policy Advisor; Gene Sperling, the President's National Economic Council Advisor; and Secretary of Labor Alexis Herman. We also have in the audience former Congressman Tony Coelho and Becky Ogle, who is the Executive Director of the task force.

SECRETARY HERMAN: Thank you very, very much, Amy. I would just like to briefly outline the mission and work of the task force that put forward the recommendations that resulted in the policy announcements that the President just unveiled in the East Room; and then, of course, ask my colleagues to join me for any questions and answers that you may have.

The recommendations that were put forward to the President were the result of a task force that was created by the President last March in an executive order on the employment of adults with disabilities. The specific mission of the task force was to have a coordinated federal policy to do all that was possible to remove the barriers to the employment of people with disabilities, and to do it in a way so that we would have a Cabinet

-led,
Cabinet

-level task force that would engage in this work.

I've been pleased to have served as the chair of this task force. The vice

-chair is with me, Tony Coelho, who is here today. And together we have worked at the direction of the President and the Vice President to work with our Cabinet colleagues to examine what we can do to remove those barriers.

This is an effort that is a four

-year effort, that was commissioned in this executive order by the President. We made eight recommendations at the conclusion of last year; the announcements that the President made today included five of those recommendations. The highlight, of course, includes the fact that in these policy recommendations today, no longer will people with disabilities have to choose between work and their health care. Secondly, they will have the opportunity to receive a tax credit in order to get, oftentimes, the assistance that they need to go to work. That could involve everything from BOTTOM EVEN MORE

transportation to someone to assist them with dressing in the morning for work. And thirdly, the other aspect of this proposal, of course, is all of the increased funding that the President is proposing for new assistive technology in the workplace that can make a difference.

We are very excited by the fact that the President and

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the Vice President accepted all of the recommendations in this first interim report of the task force to the President, and we look forward to further action, to further work, in the months and the years ahead.

At this time I will be happy to entertain any questions that you have and ask the head of our Economic Council, Gene Sperling, and Bruce Reed, the leader of our domestic policy team, to please join me.

Q Do you expect this to go through, do you think it will pass?

SECRETARY HERMAN: I believe, with the strong bipartisan support that was announced this morning -- Moynihan and Roth, Senators Kennedy and Jeffords -- that the likelihood for passage is very strong. And I think, as we talk today about the fact that we don't have a single person to waste in this economy, that we need everyone, that certainly doing all that we can to give adults with disabilities the proper tools and skills they will need to become gainfully employed is in the nation's best interests.

Q And the insurance companies and so forth will go along with all of this?

SECRETARY HERMAN: I believe that once we have the opportunity to lay out our proposals, to make the case of why this is a benefit and why in the end this is really a significant return on investment, that we will have the support of the

insurance industry as well.

Q Have you identified how you're going to pay for it?

SECRETARY HERMAN: That is something that obviously will be a part of the President's budget proposals, but I will certainly turn that, as well, to my colleague.

MR. SPERLING: The Kennedy/Jeffords/Moynihan/Roth portion will be within the budget paid for with other offsets on the mandatory side. On the tax cut that we have here, the tax credit for workers with disability will be part of an overall package we have and will give out the details of when we release our budget February 1st. What you'll see is a package of some of the tax credits we had last year with this and a few other new ones, and then there will be a package that will include various corporate loophole closers, corporate subsidies.

So you will see revenue offsets paying for this and other of the tax cuts so that the overall package is revenue

-neutral, and the Kennedy/Jeffords/Moynihan/Roth portion will be paid for within the mandatory side of the budget.

Q Secretary Herman, have you undertaken any investigation about why it's the second time in just a few months the labor statistics were released a day earlier than they should have been?

SECRETARY HERMAN: Yes. As a matter of fact, we do have an ongoing investigation that is still tied to the first glitch that we uncovered in the system; we have now added to that the early release of the PPI date, and I expect to be briefed on that.

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Q As far as you've been able to tell, what happened the last time?

SECRETARY HERMAN: As far as we've been able to tell, we do know that it was a computer glitch; it was not related to our Y2K effort. We're trying to ascertain at this point all of the facts related to just what was involved in the operations of that.

Q Do you have any expectation about when those results will be released or that report will be --

SECRETARY HERMAN: I've asked for that report within 30 days.

Q Today, or --

SECRETARY HERMAN: Thirty days today.

Q Mr. Sperling, can you address on a different issue

what the White House is doing today in terms of the problems in Brazil, how you're trying to address them?

MR. SPERLING: Obviously, there has been a lot of activity monitoring this situation, particularly since yesterday evening. Secretary Rubin and others of us briefed the President this morning, around 9:30 a.m.

-10:00 a.m., on this. The Treasury officials are in close contact with Brazilian authorities, with IMF authorities, as well as G

-7 partners and, indeed, have also been in contact with other emerging markets.

At this point I would just say that we're monitoring it very closely. I would expect, within the next couple of hours, that Secretary Rubin will have a written statement that will be out. We're discussing at this moment. There is active efforts on all of those fronts. Obviously, we think it's important that Brazil implement strong policies and I'll leave it to the statement from Treasury that should be coming out shortly.

Q But, Gene, you say at this point it's just monitoring, there's no intervention contemplated or being --

MR. SPERLING: As I said, I believe we are going to have a statement out from the Secretary of Treasury, the Treasury Department, within the next couple of hours. So I think I'll let that be our next substantive statement.

Q Share with us your assessment of why it is that the \$40

-some billion bail out package that was put together just a few months ago wasn't able to do the job? What's your assessment?

MR. SPERLING: Again, this is obviously a sensitive time. I think the best thing for us to do right now is to be doing just what we are doing, which is to be gathering information on all fronts, looking at what the implications of their action concerning their currency has been. And at this point, I think the best thing to do would be to wait until we put together a more specific written statement, which, again, should be out within an hour or two.

Q Is there a Deputy G

-7 Finance Ministers' meeting this Saturday on the subject in Frankfurt?

MR. SPERLING: I know that there have been G

-7 calls and discussions going on today. I do not know whether a specific meeting on -- you mean on what's happened today or yesterday?

Q Perhaps on some other subject where this will come up.

MR. SPERLING: I'd have to get back to you.

Q Back on the budget, if I could. There was talk

that the Clinton administration plans again to introduce a proposal of taxing cigarettes at between 50 cents and 75 cents a pack to provide some of the revenue for the 2000 spending. Could you or Bruce either address this issue directly?

MR. SPERLING: We're not going to comment a lot, but since it's really Bruce's area -- I'll let him not comment.

(Laughter.)

MR. REED: Well, again, without answering the question -- (laughter) -- as the President said last fall when the states reached agreement on their settlement, we still believe that Congress needs to finish the job of passing legislation to reduce youth smoking; that will be one of our top priorities in the new Congress, and the President's budget that comes out February 1st will show some of the details.

Q Will he be mentioning this in the State of the Union as he normally tries to?

MR. REED: Yes, I suspect he will.

Q Can you tell us a little bit more about how you're going to close -- which corporate loopholes may be closed in the 2000 budget as part of sort of the revenue projections and revenue generation?

MR. REED: Quite specifically, the way that -- the process that we went through because we've had target attacks -- credits that we pay for -- is that we put forward some of the tax credits that we proposed last year that were not passed; most specifically, the school construction, which will be part of our new budget. We also then had processes where we developed some additional tax credits.

At the same time, we go through the list of offsets and do what any wise budgeting would do; see if the benefits of new proposals are worth the cost of the raisers. I think what you'll see is that you will see some measures that we tried last year that were not passed that we think we could still pass in the target tax credit. And I think there will be some new measures that we think fit the mode of being loophole close and reductions in corporate subsidies that we think are justified on economic basis in order to have some additional tax incentives that we're announcing today. And there will be another one that we'll be talking about concerning getting capital into underserved areas, that we'll be talking about on Friday, and a few others that we'll roll out between now and the budget.

Q If you can't be more specific, can you tell us what the sort of general size of the total --

MR. SPERLING: Again, this will be highly specific. It's just that we will put it out with the whole package. It will be mind

-numbingly specific and you will see the exact package of tax cuts that we have, what the total cost of them are and then you will see what the loophole closers and revenue raisers we have. And you'll see that it will be a targeted tax cut package as we have that is fully offset with revenue raisers in areas that we feel are economically justifiable in the sense that they are closing what we think are unjustified subsidies or

loopholes.

Q Any examples?

MR. SPERLING: Not at this point.

Q Gene, Social Security was at the cornerstone of the President's State of the Union address last January. How big of a part of this speech will it be? And would you raise or lower our expectations that the President would lay out some specific formula, guidelines or ideas about reforming Social Security in the State of the Union address?

MR. SPERLING: It's certainly going to be an important part of his State of the Union, as it was last year. Truthfully, we are working, have been working and, in fact, have a meeting within the next day or two specifically to talk about what our strategy is for the State of the Union. I believe that as we have talked with people about what is the best way for the President to help lead in getting a partisan Social Security reform, we feel that he needs to continually make efforts to move the ball forward, but, on the other hand, that we need to make sure that we have a framework that we can work with members of Congress in looking for areas of consensus. So I would not expect a detailed, comprehensive plan or anything of that sort, but I think you can also expect that the President will address the issue in a serious way.

Q Why do you want Wall Street to get a bite of a program that's worked for so many years, especially considering what Wall Street is?

MR. SPERLING: What I said following the White House Social Security Conference is that one of the things the President was exploring is how Social Security could get some of the higher returns that virtually any pension or state pension plan does, and that means having a system that would allow for some form of investment in --

Q At a cost of stability that it's had?

MR. SPERLING: No, no. In fact, the President's principles are very clear, that one of this clear principles is that Social Security reform must have a clear guaranteed benefit that is not based on the ups and downs of the market.

Q Have you decided to include some form of individual retirement account -- whether it's voluntary or supplemental?

MR. SPERLING: I'll let the President speak on January 19th. I think there is obviously a question of how we move forward, how much we talk about in the State of the Union. Those are still issues that the President's working on and we're discussing right now, as -- over these next few days critically.

Q So you don't rule that out?

Q Just to be clear, when you said that you would not expect a detailed plan on Social Security, do you mean for the State of the Union, or you mean that there's been a fundamental decision that the President's not going to offer his own --

MR. SPERLING: He asked me, at the State of the Union. I was responding -- he asked what the expectation should be for the State of the Union. What the President has said is that he will do whatever he feels is most productive in leading to a

bipartisan Social Security reform package. If at some point we feel that the President putting forward more details, more specific principles, guideposts, any of those things we feel are most helpful in moving the ball forward, and that is what we will do.

I do think that the broad number of members of Congress that we have talked to feel it's very important that the President take the time over the next couple of months to work closely with members to find out what their views are, what their concerns are, so that as he does go forward he has a strong sense of where the basis for support and, ultimately, bipartisan consensus can be.

Q Was there support for individual retirement accounts in the President's meeting today with labor union leaders?

MR. SPERLING: I'll let them express, but I think if anybody following the debate knows that their position --

Q You were there. Did it come up in the discussions between the labor union leaders?

MR. SPERLING: Yes, there was some -- it wasn't necessarily the predominant issue, but it was one of the major issues that was discussed there. And, again, the President is going to look at things that fit his five principles and is keeping an open mind. But as time goes by I think he will start to give more and more indication of what he thinks would be the best basis for having a strong Social Security reform that modernizes and protects the solvency of Social Security, but also ensures that the basic guarantee benefit that people have counted on is still a basic guaranteed benefit that is not contingent on the ups and downs or volatility of the market.

That does not mean one can close down the door in a safe and prudent and non

-political way looking for Social Security to get some of the higher returns that virtually every pension plan in the United States is able to achieve.

Q What's impeachment going to do with the President's initiatives? Have you had any soundings on the Hill, because there are many statements made that your programs won't go anywhere as long as this prevails.

MR. SPERLING: If I've learned anything over the last year it's that I don't see why anybody has any confidence they can predict anything that's going to happen. And what that really means for us is that we just go forward with our policy proposals. There has always been serious interest in Social Security on both the Democrat and Republican side, and that's for a simple reason: Because our constituents, the people who elected the President and elected the members of Congress feel this is one of, if not the most critical, domestic issue facing this country over the next few decades, and I think there will be a strong demand for us to deal with this in a productive and comprehensive and bipartisan fashion.

Q As far as timing goes, would it be productive to introduce any details to a proposal prior to the ending of the Senate trial, or should something like that wait until the conclusion of the process?

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MR. SPERLING: I really have nothing to add to what I've already said.

Q Gene, there's been articles recently that the President might favor using the surplus, tying the surplus directly to private savings accounts. How is that being viewed at this point?

MR. SPERLING: Again, I'm going to do what any good staffer should do, which is I'll let the President speak on the issue in the State of the Union on January 19th. I think what has been reported is that we are certainly looking comprehensively and certainly we have -- as we have always done for the last few years, are looking not only at Social Security reform, but ways to strengthen the other two legs of the retirement policy stool, which certainly include strengthening an increase of access of pensions and individual savings, but that has been a policy we have had for several years, just to look across the board. So there are a number of things that the President is reviewing now.

Q Thank you.

PRESIDENT CLINTON AND VICE PRESIDENT GORE UNVEIL NEW INITIATIVE TO IMPROVE
ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES
January 13, 1999

Today, President Clinton will unveil a historic new initiative that will remove significant barriers for people with disabilities to go back to work. This three-part budget initiative, which invests more than \$2 billion over five years, includes: (1) full funding of the Work Incentives Improvement Act which will be introduced by Senators Jeffords, Kennedy, Roth, and Moynihan next week; (2) a new \$1,000 tax credit to cover work-related costs for people with disabilities; and (3) expanded access to information and communications technologies. With these new proposals, the Administration will have taken action on every recommendation made in the report of the President,s Task Force on the Employment of Adults with Disabilities, which the Vice President accepted last month. Justin Dart, one of the foremost leaders of the disability community, stated in response to today,s proposals: "The Clinton-Gore Administration has a long history of supporting the disability community. This policy initiative is one of the boldest since the landmark passage of the ADA."

CRITICAL NEED TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO WORK

Since President Clinton took office, the American economy has added 17.7 million new jobs, and unemployment is at a 29-year low of 4.3 percent. The unemployment rate among all working-age adults with disabilities, however, is nearly 75 percent. According to current estimates, about 1.6 million working-age adults have a disability that leads to functional limitations and 14 million working-age adults have less severe but still significant disabilities.

People with disabilities can bring tremendous energy and talent to the American workforce, but institutional barriers often limit their ability to work. Most critically, people with disabilities often become ineligible for Medicaid or Medicare if they work. This means that many people with disabilities are put in the untenable position of choosing between health care coverage and work. In addition, advances in technology and communications are often not accessible to people with disabilities.

Funding the Work Incentives Improvement Act in the President,s budget. Health

care -- particularly prescription drugs and personal assistance -- is essential for people with disabilities to work. Today, the President is announcing that his FY 2000 budget will fund the full cost of the Work Incentives Improvement Act. This proposal, which costs \$1.2 billion over 5 years, would:

- Improve access to health care by:

- Expanding states' ability to provide a Medicaid buy-in to people with disabilities who return to work. This provision would enable states to offer the buy-in to people whose assets and/or income exceed current limits. It also would give states the option of offering the buy-in to people with medical conditions, such as rheumatoid arthritis, who do not meet the current disability standard, but who can work only because of medical treatment. Finally, this provision would give health care grants to those states that do so.

- more-

- Extending Medicare coverage, for the first time, for people with disabilities who return to work. Although Medicare does not provide as comprehensive a benefit as Medicaid, this aspect of the proposal ensures that all people with disabilities who return to work have access to health care coverage, even if they live in a state that does not take the Medicaid option.

- Creating a new Medicaid buy-in demonstration to help people with a specific physical or mental impairment that is not yet severe enough to qualify for health care assistance, but that is reasonably expected to lead to a severe disability in the absence of medical treatment. This demonstration could help people with muscular dystrophy, Parkinson's Disease, HIV or diabetes who are able to work with appropriate health care.

- Modernize the employment services system by creating a "ticket" that will enable SSI or SSDI beneficiaries to go to any of a number of public or private providers for vocational rehabilitation. If the beneficiary goes to work and achieves substantial earnings, providers would be paid a portion of the benefits saved.

- Create a Work Incentive Grant program to provide benefits planning and assistance, facilitate access to information about work incentives, and better integrate services for people with disabilities working or returning to work.

Providing a \$1,000 tax credit for work-related expenses for people with disabilities. The daily costs of getting to and from work, and being effective at work, can be high if not prohibitive for people with disabilities. Under this new proposal, workers with significant disabilities would receive an annual \$1,000 tax credit to help cover the formal and informal costs that are associated with employment, such as special transportation and technology. Like the Jeffords-Kennedy-Roth-Moynihan Work Incentive Act, this tax credit, which will assist 200,000 to 300,000 Americans, will help ensure that people with disabilities have the tools they need to return to work. The credit will cost \$700 million over 5 years.

Improving access to assistive technology. Technology is often not adapted for people with disabilities and, even when it is, people with disabilities may not

be able to afford it. This new initiative would accelerate the development and adoption of information and communications technologies that can improve the quality of life for people with disabilities and enhance their ability to participate in the workplace. The initiative would: (1) help make the Federal government a model user of assistive technology; (2) support new and expanded state loan programs to make assistive technology more affordable for Americans with disabilities; and (3) invest in research and development and technology transfer in areas such as text to speech for people who are blind, automatic captioning for people who are deaf, and speech recognition and eye tracking for people who can't use a keyboard. It would provide \$35 million in FY 2000, more than double the government's current investment in deploying assistive technology.

With these steps, the Administration has taken action on all Task Force Recommendations. In December, the Vice President accepted the report of the President's Task Force on the Employment of Adults with Disabilities, took action on some of their recommendations, and pledged that the Administration would review others in the budget process. With the new steps taken today, as well as an announcement that Mrs. Gore will make tomorrow, the Administration has taken action on all the Task Force formal recommendations:

- Work to pass the Work Incentive Improvement Act.

REMARKS BY THE PRESIDENT
IN PHOTO OPPORTUNITY WITH U.S. LABOR LEADERS

The Cabinet Room

THE PRESIDENT: First of all, I want to thank these distinguished leaders of the American labor movement for coming here today for this meeting. We are meeting to talk about the economy, the challenges we face in the 21st century -- in part, what I intend to say about it in the State of the Union next week. We will be discussing ways we can work together to save Social Security, to renew our public schools, to improve health care, and deal with a whole range of other issues.

In large measure, opportunity for America's labor families and their children will depend upon whether America can master the challenges of a global economy. We have worked hard over the last year, as all of you know, to deal with the global financial crisis and restore growth. I talked about that at the Detroit Economic Club on Friday. This will require a very vigorous set of actions this year, and part of it will involve the Congress, part of it will involve our work with other nations over the course of the year. But it will be very important.

I have received a briefing this morning from Secretary Rubin and my economic team on the situation in Brazil, and on the developments in the world markets. We are monitoring these developments closely, especially what is going on in Brazil. We've been in contact with key Brazilian government officials, the G

-7, and other important countries. We've been in contact with the International Monetary Fund. We have a strong interest in saving Brazil, with whom we have worked on so many important things around the world, carrying forward with its economic reform plan, and succeed. And we certainly hope that they will.

At the present time, I think that's about all I have to say about developments in --

Q Mr. President, what do you think will be the outcome of the impeachment trial? We know what your hopes are, but what do you think is really going to happen?

THE PRESIDENT: I think the Senate -- we filed our brief today. It makes our case. The important thing for me is to spend as little time thinking about that as possible, and as much time working on the issues we're here to discuss as possible. They have their job to do in the Senate, and I have mine. And I intend to do it. I am --

Q Well, do you fear any removal from office, with the build

-up of this case?

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THE PRESIDENT: I think that the brief speaks for itself and the statements which have been made by hundreds of constitutional experts and others -- I trust that the right thing will be done. And I think, in the meanwhile, I need to work on the business of the people.

Q Mr. President, your impeachment is before the

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union, and you're giving your State of the Union address. Don't you think you should directly address that matter during your speech?

THE PRESIDENT: I think the American people have heard about that quite extensively over the last year. My instinct is that I should do their business. I think they would like it if somebody up here would put their interests first, their business first. And I think that's what they expect me to do. They know the Senate has a job to do; they expect them to do it. There is nothing else to be said to the House about it. The Senate has to deal with it.

And my position is that, in addition to that, we have to deal with the problems of America, the challenges of America, the opportunities of America, and that's what I intend to do in the State of the Union speech.

Q Mr. President, your lawyers are arguing that the charges against you don't amount to high crimes and misdemeanors. Do you personally believe that perjury and obstruction of justice are not impeachable offenses?

THE PRESIDENT: I believe that it's not necessary for me to comment further than our brief. The important thing I think you should be asking yourself is, why did nearly 900 constitutional experts say that they strongly felt that this matter was not the subject of impeachment?

My opinion is not important here. My opinion is that I should be doing my job for the country, and other people should be handling the defense and dealing with this issue. And that's what I intend to do.

Q Mr. President, on Brazil. Do you -- harmful effect on the U.S. economy? We send a lot of exports to Latin America.

THE PRESIDENT: Well, as you know, we have worked hard to keep the financial crisis in Asia, which enveloped Asia last year, from spreading to Brazil. Latin America is our fastest growing market for American goods and services. And Brazil is the largest country in Latin America. So, obviously, we hope that the situation will be resolved in a satisfactory way not only for the people of Brazil, but for all of the people in the Americas that want to continue to enjoy the good progress that all of us have enjoyed in the last several years. And we're working hard to that end and will continue to do so.

Q Thank you.
