Statement of Gregory Craig
Assistant to the President and Special Counsel
January 14, 1999

The Senate has given us ample time to present the President,s defense. It is a strong defense, and we will be making the President,s case at the appointed time next week.

The purpose of my appearance before you tonight is to make a point of personal privilege on behalf of Mr. Ruff.

When he gave his opening earlier today, Mr. Sensenbrenner falsely characterized Mr. Ruff,s testimony to use it against the President, and he misled the Senate. Last month, when Mr. Ruff testified before the House Judiciary Committee, Mr. Sensenbrenner asked him if the President told the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth when he was before the grand jury.

Mr. Ruff answered directly, and I quote, "He surely did."

Mr. Sensenbrenner surely knew that, and I would urge him to correct the record tomorrow.

THE PRESIDENT: Madam Attorney General; Deputy Attorney General Holder; Associate Attorney General Fisher; Mayor Donley; Chief Samarra; all the members of the Alexandria Police force; to all the other chiefs and law enforcement officials who are here; the representatives of law enforcement who are here; Gil Gallegos, the President of the National FOP; Sam Cabral, the International Union of Police Associations President; Ron Neubauer, the International Association of Chiefs of Police President: I am delighted to see all of you.

I really enjoyed listening to Senator Biden and Senator Robb reminisce about how this bill came to be. I want to say a special word of thanks, if I might, to the team at the Justice Department and especially to Joe Brann, who himself is a former Chief of Police, the Director of our COPS program. Thank you, Joe, for doing such a great job with our police officers -- (applause.)

You know, when I asked Janet Reno to be Attorney General, she had been a prosecutor in Miami. And the main thing I wanted to do with the Justice Department was to deal with what I thought the biggest problem in America was at that time -- legal problem -- which is that there was a very, very high crime rate and the violent crime rate was especially high. And there was -- I had spent a lot of time both as Attorney General of my own state and as a governor, I had run a prison system and watched it explode. I had managed a large state police operation. Then, as a governor and, later, as a candidate, I had actually walked the streets and been in

the neighborhoods of New York, Philadelphia, Boston, Chicago, San Antonio, Los Angeles, looking for strategies that worked to bring the crime rate down.

And so, when I asked Janet Reno to come on, I said, the most important thing is that the local police, the local prosecutors, the local mayors, the people that are out there worrying about the crime rate, they have to know not only that we are their friends, but we are their partners. And we're going to stop doing what normally happens in Washington, which is that you make speeches and talk tough, and nothing happens. I would rather say less and do more.

And by 1993, when I took office, we were beginning to see in many major cities crime rates go down because of the development at the local level of community policing strategies. And it is true that we would never have been able to do this without the leadership of Senator Biden and the support of Senator Robb. We finally were able to pass that crime bill, to get into community policing, to have 100,000 police on the street, to ban the assault weapons, to build more prisons, to have more prevention programs to keep kids out of trouble in the

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first place. And I would like to say a special word of appreciation to law enforcement for proving that Joe and Chuck and I were right.

You see Joe Biden up here, full of enthusiasm -- wouldn't it break your heart if it turned out to be wrong? House What kind of speech -- can you imagine him giving a hang-dog speech? It would have been terrible. (Laughter.) So I want to thank you. I want to thank you for a lot of things -- for staying with us with the assault weapons ban, for staying with us with the Brady Bill, which has now kept a quarter of a million -- a quarter of a million -- felons, fugitives and stalkers from getting handguns.

I want to thank you for proving that there are people like Irma Rivera out there in America all over America who want to wear uniforms and make the streets safer and give our kids their futures back. She was terrific, wasn't she? Let's give her another hand. (Applause.)

So we're very happy. If you look there at the reduction in crime on that chart, you see the crime rates overall have dropped to a 25-year low; property crime down; violent crimes declined 20 percent in the last six years. The murder rate is at its lowest level nationwide in 30 years, mostly due to the dropping number of young people with guns. We can take a lot of pride in what has happened and in the strategy that has brought it about.

We have seen the impact of more police. We've seen the impact of the prevention programs; of the penalties; the efforts to get guns out of the hands of criminals; the burning out of the

crack epidemic, thank the Lord. And we've seen greater peace of mind coming, probably more than anything else, from the presence of the police on the street, in the neighborhood, in a preventive, cooperative fashion. And that is very, very good.

Now, having said all that, I want to go back to a point Senator Biden made. Dealing with crime, now that it's down, is kind of like dealing with the economy. We've got the lowest unemployment rate in 29 years. But it doesn't mean anything to somebody without a job, or to a depressed neighborhood. And given how volatile things are in the world -- all you have to do is pick up the paper every day and read about it -- we've got to stay on the economy.

The same thing is true of crime except, in some ways, more so. Because, yes, the crime rate is the lowest it's been in 30 years -- and you heard the Attorney General say that means there will be under 3 million victims. Three million people is a lot of people -- 3 million families; 3 million friends. I don't know anyone who seriously believes that we have a country as safe as it ought to be. I don't know anyone who seriously believes that we're saving every young person and keeping them out of trouble in the first place. I don't know anyone who seriously believes that we can be the kind of country we want to be if we have to continue these levels of incarceration; if we have to continue spending more and more money on prisons, that we ought to be spending on education, on after-school programs, on summer school programs, on keeping these kids out of trouble in the first place.

So I say, in spite of all this celebration, what we should do is to say, okay, we know what works; now let's bear down and keep doing it until we have got this problem as small as it can possibly be. No serious person thinks that we are there. So, for my money, what we ought to be doing today is saying, Hallelujah, this works; now let's keep on doing it until we have squeezed every last drop of possibility for peace and security out of this strategy.

We are, as you have heard, on time, ahead of schedule, under budget with the 100,000 police program. In fact, we have already funded more than 92,000 of the 100,000 community police. We will fund them all in the near future. And that is very, very encouraging.

Now, we also have to deal with the fact -- you heard Senator Biden mention this -- that our community policing effort is set to expire in the year 2000. I still believe we need to do more. It's still dangerous work -- 155 of your colleagues lost their lives in the last year. It's still a numbers game in some places.

When we started this 100,000 police program, the violent crime rate had tripled in the previous 30 years, but the

size of the police forces, in the aggregate, had gone up only 10 percent. So we got the violent crime rate and the overall crime rate coming down, but there's still not an intersection. In other words, the police force is going from 500,000 to 600,000 -- that's a 20 percent increase -- but we still need to do more.

Now, today I came here to say that in my balanced budget proposal to the Congress, which I will unveil at the State of the Union address, we will have nearly \$1.3 billion, an increase of more than \$6 billion over five years -- \$1.3 billion for the next year, budget year -- to renew our community policing program. This will help to hire and redeploy an additional 30,000 to 50,000 community police officers over that same period. It will be the best investment we can make in a safe future for our children, and I hope we can pass it with your help. (Applause.)

We also, as has already been said, need to make sure that our police officers have 21st century tools to do their jobs. Today, drug dealers communicate by cell phones and pagers; scam artists work the Internet; gangs carry cutting-edge weaponry. Criminals have the best technology. Police should, too. Therefore, today I propose we devote \$350 million in the balanced budget to put crime-fighting technology into the hands of police officers.

For too long, we have seen some criminals go free because the methods used to gather evidence were not up-to-date. But when police can report from their squad cars, rather than return to the station to fill out paperwork, they spend more time on the beat. When officers can track crime as it happens, using innovative crime-mapping technology, they can respond more quickly and effectively.

Chief Samarra has told us what a difference these new tools can make here, in Alexandria. And the Vice President has put together a task force to help more communities take maximum advantage of available technology.

Police carry a heavy burden, but we know they can't carry it alone and we have to do more to engage all our communities in the fight against crime -- to help win the fight police have been waging so successfully.

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We also have in this budget additional funds for community-based crime-fighting -- everything from neighborhood

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DAs to work closely with police and residents, to faith-based organizations to help to prevent juvenile crime.

And I want to say one last thing about the role of the

police. We could never have gotten the prevention funds we have gotten in the last five years if the law enforcement community hadn't advocated it. I was astonished when I came to Washington to see how many members of Congress were literally afraid to vote for prevention -- afraid that people back home would think they were soft on crime, or weak, or looking the other way. When all the people in uniform who had their lives on the line came up and testified, hey, we cannot jail our way out of this problem; we've got to keep more of these kids out of trouble in the first place; that's the least expensive, most humane, most ethical to proceed here -- you made it possible for these programs to work.

One of the things that's really going to help you do your job is something that is going to be in my education budget I announced last week. We are going to triple the funds for after-school programs to keep kids learning in school -- something positive, rather than learning something negative on the streets -- when during the hours after school the juvenile crime rate soars.

None of this would have been possible if the police officers of the country hadn't been willing to come to the Congress and say, hey, this works; help us keep these kids out of trouble in the first place. So we thank you for that as well.

America is grateful for the hard work of our men and women in uniform. Every day you make our streets and schools safer, our homes more secure, and in so doing -- make no mistake about it -- you make freedom more real for the American people. We know you can't do it alone. We've tried to be good partners. We intend to be better partners as we move to the next century.

Thank you and God bless you. (Applause.)

We are here at this extraordinary international gathering, the very first of its kind, to talk about a subject that lies at the very heart of economic growth and productivity -- and even basic political legitimacy -- for the 21st Century: reforming and reinventing government so that it is smaller, smarter, and more responsive to change in this fast-changing Information Age.

Just a handful of years ago, it would have been impossible to hold this conference. Government reform was considered purely a domestic, internal topic -- that is, when it happened at all. And back when our economies were defined by our political borders, it was far less of an economic imperative. After all, if our businesses had to battle a bloated bureaucracy, ever-rising taxes, and overregulation, at least all of their competitors had the same disadvantage.

Today, so many forward-thinking nations have realized that they cannot make the most of the Information Age with the creaking governmental machinery of the Industrial Age. We cannot compete and thrive in the global marketplace if we are battling bureaucracy and apathy on our own shores. And we certainly cannot earn and sustain the faith of our people if we do not show them that self-government can work for them -- that they can reap its benefits, and become full partners in its progress.

Reinvention and reform is not a way to scale back our ambitions, or tighten our belts for its own sake -- as if sacrifice were a first principle.

It is, in fact, a recognition of this fundamental truth: that we cannot chase our highest ideals unless they are grounded in workable, practical, responsible self-governance.

We need governments that are as flexible, as dynamic, as focussed on serving their customers as the best private companies around the world. We need to adopt the very best management techniques from the private sector to create governments that are fully prepared for the Information Age.

In this fast-moving, fast-changing global economy -- when the free flow of dollars and data sustains economic and political strength, and whole new industries are born every day -- governments must be lean, nimble, and creative, or they will surely be left behind.

Then there is the basic freedom that underlies free markets everywhere. When governments work for the people -- when citizens receive good basic services, and have faith in the government that is providing them -- when taxes are low, and government meets public needs without maddening bureaucracy -- then a large measure of political and economic stability naturally follows. Let this be a first principle of 21st Century government: economic prosperity demands political legitimacy.

I am exhilarated by the vision and passion for change in this room. I know the great sacrifices many of you have made to remake your governments. I want us to stand together, and forge a new global coalition for smaller, smarter governance. Over the next two days -- and at a parallel conference I am convening in February, on ways to fight international corruption and cronyism -- let us learn from one another, and make just, responsive, and responsible government a pillar of global strength and community.

We all know that there is no cookie-cutter model for reinvention. Nations have found different paths to reform -- and for vastly different reasons. For many, the catalyst was economic crisis or calamity: crippling deficits, rising taxes, declining living standards, or international defaults.

That is why the first generation of reform in many nations focussed on macro-economic reforms and privatization of state-owned assets.

In the United States, we faced an economic crisis of a different sort -- characterized by chronic large deficits. But we also faced a crisis of confidence from our citizens, and anger over government's rising cost and declining effectiveness.

In Europe, every government faced public sector restrictions imposed by the Maastricht Treaty, as well as the emerging demands of economic integration and the European Union.

In Eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union, the challenge was not to reinvent democratic self-government, but to invent it in the first place.

In South Africa, the historic challenge was to move beyond the evils and unfairness of the Apartheid era.

In Latin America, now that important progress has been made in economic reform and privatization, & la segunda generacion of reform is underway -- focussed on building responsive, effective governments that earn people's trust and faith.

In all these regions of our world, we have seen some remarkably successful reforms: from New Zealand's performance-based management, to Australia's new focus on outcomes and results; from the greater transparency of nations like Hungary and Poland, to England's focus on what we call & customer service -- service to the citizen.

When President Clinton and I began what we call Reinventing Government, or REGO, we borrowed a great deal from other nations -- such as the establishment of government-wide financial standards -- personally recommended to me by New Zealand's Treasury Secretary, Graham Scott.

The question we should consider over the next two days is whether these different roads do indeed lead to the same destination: whether we can determine both the basic purposes of reinvention and reform around the world, and the basic tools and institutions we must strengthen to fulfill them.

We know that many of us have faced, in varying stages, a singular cultural challenge: Industrial Age bureaucracies that have grown far beyond the professional classes they were envisioned to be, and at times seem to specialize in immobility and apathy, lacking the leadership and also the freedom to change with the changing times.

This is not a new problem. Back in the days of Spanish rule in Latin America, when the viceroys were given commands by their King that they could not possibly fulfill, they answered with a phrase that still resonates through many bureaucracies today: & Obedezco pero no complø -- & I obey, but I do not comply.

In fact, we find that this sentiment is universal. In Turkey, there is a phrase that means: & I will obey the rules -- regardless of what they cause.

In Germany, government workers used to use the phrase: &I will see what lets itself be done.8

Of course, here in the United States, a common phrase used to be: &good enough for government work.8 We,re working to change that.

Clearly, all of us face the challenge of changing this culture, and leading and empowering employees to make the innovations we need. What, then, are the common imperatives as we seek to create that change? I believe there are four:

First, economic competitiveness. We all share a concern that government lay the foundation for economic prosperity, instead of being a drag on it -- which means cutting deficits and wasteful spending. We all share an interest in the transparency of government operations -- so that global investors have confidence in us, and are less prone to the rapid withdrawals of capital that we saw throughout Asia in the past year and a half.

Some of you may be familiar with the term &red tape8 -- the ever-expanding rules and regulations that governments seem to love -- and citizens hate. In a global economy where capital can be invested anywhere, red tape is like an economic noose that says: if you send your investments here, we,re going to strangle them with bureaucracy, inefficiency, and forms, fees, and requirements you can barely even understand. That,s why so many of us are working on common-sense regulatory reform.

Korea is abolishing almost half its regulations. In the United States, we forced agencies to cut 16,000 pages of needless regulation, and 640,000 pages of internal rules. This is good for the people, too; those rules and regulations make government services slower and more expensive. In Costa Rica, decrees to eliminate barriers to entry in the pharmaceutical industry led to reductions in the price of life-saving drugs and medicine -- 11 percent in only 4 months!

Second, doing more with less. In the 70's and 80's, we saw a growing international frustration with rising tax rates -- and the fact that they were paying not for better services, but for more bureaucracy and inefficiency. The stagflation of that time -- with slower growth and high inflation eating away at family incomes -- made rising tax rates even more of a burden. In America, we found that only through reinvention -- which saved us \$137 billion -- could we cut taxes, balance the budget, and improve services all at the same time.

It,s happening around the world: the Canadian Programme Review turned a budget deficit into a balanced budget, and cut the federal workforce by 25 percent. For ten years now, Chile has run surpluses and reduced its government payroll.

Third, building people,s faith in government. It wasn,t only budget deficits that were trapping our governments in the past. Many of us faced performance deficits as well -- a legitimate feeling that government wasn,t doing what it said it was going to do. With so little faith in

self-government at home, it is harder to build the faith of the world community that vibrant free markets and the free flow of capital and ideas will be sustained.

That's why, in the United States, we started treating our citizens as &customers -- the way the best private businesses treat their customers. Great Britain pioneered this notion of service to the citizen in the late 1980's. The Danish actually set maximum response times when citizens need help. The French define their goals as putting &the citizen in the core of public service -- for instance, they now can deliver passports in less than one hour!

Building faith also demands that we bring government closer to the people. Some countries refer to the principle of &subsidiarity; other countries speak of decentralization or devolution. But the concept is the same: empower governments not in some distant national capital, but in the places where people live and work, so it can be more responsive to their needs. Countries as diverse as India, Mexico, Pakistan, Poland, and Thailand now talk about decentralization and the need to build local government as more power moves toward the people.

Fourth and finally, strengthening community and civil society. In this way, reinvention and reform are about something far grander than the gears of government, or even the smooth workings of democracy. David Osborne, author of the landmark book &Reinventing Government, talked about the need to &steer, not row. A government that tries to fulfill every function itself -- a government that tries to be an omnipresent welfare state -- will only leave its people in a catatonic state. Smaller, more empowering government unleashes the energy of ordinary families and communities. That's what President Clinton and I tried to do with welfare reform -- setting national standards for moving people from welfare to work, but then letting states and local communities shape the reforms that work best for them.

This kind of empowering government -- government that sets goals, and provides the tools to reach them -- leaves a vital role for communities, churches, civic institutions, families: the kind of vibrant civic life that is the very ideal of self-government. It's happening everywhere: the representative from Ghana wrote to us about the importance of civil society to the reform process. Mongolia is shifting more governmental functions to its non-governmental organizations. This is far from an abdication of responsibility -- it is really a call to responsibility, from all quarters.

If we accept that these are our common purposes -- competitiveness, building faith, doing more with less, and strengthening civil society -- and I hope this is a subject we can debate at this conference -- then it is worth considering: does it take more than mere government reforms to achieve them? I believe it does.

The fact that we can even gather here may be because we have come to a new point in history. No longer do nations divide themselves along the stark ideological divides of the old Cold War. Instead, more and more nations are committed to the common vision of democracy and free-market

economies.

At the heart of these concepts one finds a set of institutions that allow people of different beliefs to peacefully resolve their differences. Democracy and market capitalism cannot thrive in societies that do not enjoy freedom of the press; an honest and impartial judiciary; an ability to check executive and legislative power; and a steadily expanding circle of dignity among different races and ethnic groups, women and men, different religious faiths.

These institutions are often frustrating and inefficient. But democracy and free markets work when we allow for the resolution of conflict. Too many nations are still lacking those basic institutions -- and for them conflict is bloody and brutal. But for those of us engaged in administrative and institutional reform, these underpinnings of democratic society are cherished. I believe they are the basis of any serious reform effort.

Let me talk just briefly about America's own experience, and the factors that drove President Clinton and me to undertake REGO six years ago. As I mentioned, when we campaigned in 1992, we saw a growing pressure for reform at the grassroots -- frustration with high taxes, and a feeling by many that they were not getting their money's worth. Crime and welfare were rising, the deficit was exploding, and we had fallen into a deep recession. There was a crisis of faith -- not just in government, but in our ability to solve our common problems.

In the 1960's, when you asked Americans if they trusted the federal government to do the right thing, 77 percent regularly said yes. By the time President Clinton and I ran for office, the percentage of Americans saying that they trusted the federal government had fallen to 17 percent.

With so many great unmet needs, many believed we had only two choices: tax and spend, which our people couldn't afford -- and cut and run, which our people wisely rejected. Instead, we found a new way: marrying responsible governance to our progressive ideals by balancing the budget and reinventing government, so we could invest and grow for the future.

I'll talk more about our experience with REGO in our first plenary session. But today, as we rededicate ourselves to reinvention and reform around the world, I have the honor of making three important new announcements about our efforts to reinvent government here in the United States.

If we want our government to be accountable for every taxpayer's dime, then we need a workforce that will be held accountable for real results. That is why we want to submit to Congress new civil service reform legislation, to significantly change the way many federal workers are hired, rewarded, and paid. Our civil service reform will be based on an insight that is common in private industry: you pay for performance. Instead of providing automatic pay increases based on seniority, managers in the federal government would have a significant portion of their pay

determined by how well they do their jobs, and meet the people,s needs. This won,t cost taxpayers an extra penny, but it will ensure that today,s tax dollars are far better spent. We plan to start working with our agencies and our employees, representatives to craft this proposal right away.

Of course, to truly change our culture, we must combine this legislation with the right kind of partnerships between labor and management. Partnerships which recognize the interests of both sides, but unite both front-line workers and managers in the common cause of improving government performance.

Next, we must do even more to focus on results, not red tape and regulation. This year,s budget will contain a major new initiative with a simple premise: the needs of our children first, the needs of bureaucracy last. Recently, through REGO, we began to collect statistics on children's health -- immunization rates, the absence of teen pregnancy, child nutrition. Now we will start a pilot partnership with ten cities or states that will commit to specific improvements in these areas. In return for their commitment to focus on results, we will give them unprecedented new flexibility in how they use federal funds to achieve the results they want. This new initiative, called Results for our Children, will make a profound difference in hundreds of thousands of young lives.

Finally, you cannot improve customer service unless you truly listen to the customer. This year, we will conduct the first-ever government-wide Customer Satisfaction Survey -- to assess the progress we have made in the last five years. We have already established over 4,000 customer service standards, all published on our agencies, web sites. Now we need to determine, from the people,s perspective, how we are doing, and how we can do better.

My hope is that this conference will be the start of a new international coalition for competitiveness -- one that seizes on our shared reforms to build governments that are as smart, as effective, and as dynamic as today,s global economy and Information Age. That has been the heart of REGO in the United States -- and I know we have a lot to learn from all of you.

As all of us know, this is hard, unglamorous work. But as much as REGO is about the nuts and bolts of government, it is also about the soul and spirit of self-government. By meeting this challenge together, we can create more than effective government agencies -- we can create a global economic community that is strong and vibrant and equipped for the challenges of change. We can create a new trust and faith in our people, and in each other. That is the spirit in which I hope we will work these next two days, and in the years to come. Thank you.

January 13, 1999

I am pleased to submit the fourth of five annual reports on the Administration's Comprehensive Trade and Development Policy for Africa, as required by section 134 of the Uruguay Round Agreements Act. This year has seen progress in our trade policy and the deepening of trade relationships

with
Africa.

I was proud to be the first President to undertake a comprehensive visit to Africa this past year. In March, I visited Ghana, Rwanda, Uganda, South Africa, Botswana, and Senegal. At each stop, I was struck by the remarkable opportunities for the United States to expand our growing relationship with Africa based on mutually beneficial trade and development. In the months since my return, my Administration has worked to expand and exploit those opportunities through practical measures, including undertaking trade missions, negotiating trade agreements, and implementing debt relief and technical assistance programs for Africa's strongest reformers.

These efforts continue to build on the strategy I announced in the June 1997 Partnership for Economic Growth and Opportunity in Africa (Partnership). Our goal continues to be sustained economic development for Africa, and we are guided by the conviction that economic development in Sub-Saharan Africa will benefit both Africans and Americans. We continue to believe, as outlined in the Partnership, that trade should not replace aid. Effective aid assists countries in building healthy, literate, and informed populations able to take advantage of the opportunities offered by increased trade and investment. Well-focused assistance, combined with strong reforms and increased trade and investment, will break Africa's old patterns of dependency.

The report I am sending to the Congress today reviews our achievements of the past year in implementing the goals of the Partnership. First, we have improved market access for African and American products in our respective markets by negotiating trade agreements that are mutually beneficial and increasing interaction between the United States and African private sectors through trade missions and high-level visits.

Second, we have implemented technical assistance programs to increase African knowledge of, and ability to work within, the global trading system. Through invigorated reform and assistance efforts, we are helping Africa to build the trading infrastructure it will need to become a strong trade partner for the United States, integrated within the global economy.

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We have also put in place a number of initiatives to increase private investment in Sub-Saharan Africa, including the Department of Transportation's Safe Skies Initiative, increased access to credit for projects in African countries through the Export-Import Bank, and the Overseas Private Investment Corporation's equity funds to finance increased private investment. With FY99 funds appropriated for this purpose, we have begun to forgive remaining bilateral concessional debt owed by Africa's strongest reforming countries.

Finally, we have begun planning for a broad-based meeting at the ministerial level with African countries to discuss how we can work most effectively together to forward our shared goal of sustained and mutually beneficial economic development and trade. We hope to hold the first U.S.-African Economic Cooperation Forum with representatives from Africa's strongest reforming countries later this year.

I was disappointed that the 105th Congress did not complete consideration of the African Growth and Opportunity Act. This trade initiative is an important complement to our Partnership strategy. It would afford greater market access for selected products from the strongest reforming countries in Africa and, by doing so, would help change the dynamic of our trade policy with the continent. The Act would also benefit American companies and workers by expanding our trade with the largest underdeveloped market in the world. I am committed to working for passage of the African Growth and Opportunity Act early in the 106th Congress.

My Administration will continue working with the Congress, the U.S. private sector, the countries of Africa, and our trading partners to implement the policies and programs contained in the report and to promote reforms boosting trade, investment, and development in Africa.

The President today announced his intent to nominate Richard Barnes to serve as Director of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service.

Mr. Richard Barnes, a native of Chattanooga, Tennessee, has served as Deputy Director of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service since 1996 and was instrumental in resolving the 1997 UPS/Teamsters strike. He has served with the FMCS for eleven years. In 1996, he was a Regional Director, overseeing operations in fifteen southern states. From 1994 to 1996, he served as District Director, overseeing operations in nine southern states. He was a Commissioner from 1987 to 1994, mediating disputes in the Atlanta Field Office. From 1972 to 1987, he served as an International Representative and District Council Business Manager of the Laborers' International Union of North America. Mr. Barnes received a B.A. degree from Antioch University.

The Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service (FMCS) assists labor and management in resolving disputes in collective bargaining contract negotiations through voluntary mediation and arbitration services. The FMCS also provides training to unions and management in cooperative processes to improve long-term relationships under the Labor Management Cooperation Act of 1978, and awards grants to joint labor-management committees to encourage innovative approaches to cooperative efforts.

The Fund will provide an opportunity for cities, states and tribes to partner with the private sector, the federal government and each other to provide healthy clean air to local citizens.  - demonstrate locally managed, self-supporting programs that achieve early integrated reductions in soot, smog, air toxics, and greenhouse gases;
 - be used to capitalize local revolving funds and other financial mechanisms that leverage the original federal investment and result in greater resources for air pollution reduction; and
 - stimulate technology innovation.
- The Clean Air Partnership will fund more optimal, multi-pollutant control strategies. Currently, businesses and municipalities often invest in short-term, single-pollutant control approaches. The Partnership will encourage many industries, such as electric utilities and the transportation sector, to pursue comprehensive criteria pollutant reductions while improving energy and operational efficiencies, thereby also reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
- The Clean Air Fund will provide these needed resources through mechanisms that promise significant leveraging of nonfederal resources. It is expected that the Fund will support the development of local revolving funds, low-interest loan programs, matching funds, public-private partnerships, and other capitalization mechanisms. These mechanisms have been proven to leverage federal dollars 2 to 2 ½ times, substantially increasing the Fund's impact.

FYI, we got the following feedback on the President's whirl-wind visit to the Detroit Auto Show on January 8th. This information comes from some of the automotive company people involved.

General Motors showed him one of their fuel-cell minivan (this is the vehicle shown in the video news clips of the President at the Show). This vehicle was at the Show only for the President's visit. The fuel cell in the vehicle is not operational, but vehicle shows how the fuel cell and fuel system components would be packaged in the vehicle. The President asked about the various fuels needed for a fuel cell vehicle. The follow-up discussion expanded into the many issues involving future gasoline and other new fuels (surprise!). Apparently the President requested a White Paper from the auto industry on the fuels issues and the industry agreed to prepare it and intends to complete this in the very near future.

He walked through the large Ford exhibit. Ford happily reports that the President was very impressed by the new T-Bird. He toured Ford's extensive advanced technology display which included a methanol-fueled fuel cell, aluminum-intensive SUV based on the P2000 platform. He was particularly impressed by Ford's "world's largest" hologram of a highly stylized, aerodynamic P2000 sedan with a hydrogen-fueled fuel cell. He viewed part of Ford's video explaining the operation and fuel economy benefits of hybrid-electric vehicles.

He walked through DaimlerChrysler's large exhibit and saw at least two of the five concept vehicles. He saw the Jeep "Commander" which includes a methanol-fueled fuel cell in a vehicle based on the Grand Cherokee, but larger. He also saw the Chrysler Citedal, which has a gasoline-engine parallel hybrid electric drivetrain.

The automotive people were very impressed by how well versed the President was on many of the issues facing the automotive industry and PNGV, such as the fuels issue. Their general impression was the President enjoyed the visit very much.

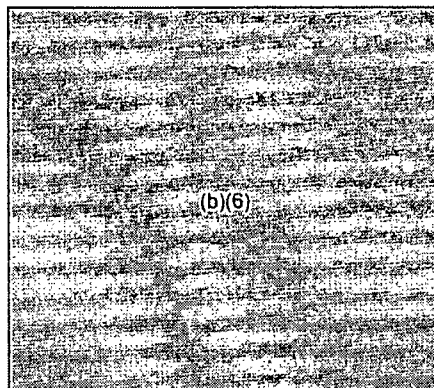

PROMOTING INVESTMENT IN AMERICA!,S NEW MARKETS
January 15, 1998

Despite the longest peacetime economic expansion in history, marked by tremendous business and job growth, and much capital in search of good investment opportunities, many urban and rural areas of the country have not participated in the capital investment that has spurred job growth and economic development elsewhere at home and abroad. President Clinton!,s commitment to building one America is a commitment to making progress for all Americans, in every home and community in the nation.

President Clinton challenged the leaders of Wall Street, who are fueling America!,s economic growth, to take the lead in investing in America!,s own "New Markets" -- inner-city areas, like New York!,s East Harlem, and distressed rural areas like parts of Appalachia. The President!,s FY 2000 balanced budget includes a new initiative designed to create the conditions for success by:

providing tax credit and loan guarantee incentives to stimulate billions of new private capital investment in targeted areas;

building a network of private investment institutions to funnel credit, equity, and technical assistance into businesses in America's new markets; and

providing the expertise to targeted small businesses that will allow them to use new investment to grow.

WORKING WITH EXPERTS AND CONGRESS

The President's New Markets Initiative was developed by an Administration task force that consulted with investment advisors, community development financial and venture capital pioneers, and Members of Congress who have lead efforts to promote investment in underserved areas. President Clinton has laid out a solid framework from which to build, but he will further solicit the reactions and ideas of a wide range of experts and Congressional leaders before he sends the legislation to Congress.

HARNESSING THE POWER OF THE PRIVATE MARKET TO REVITALIZE COMMUNITIES

The New Markets initiative will prompt approximately \$15 billion in new investment in urban and rural areas through:

1. The New Markets Tax Credit -- To help spur \$6 billion in new equity capital for investment in America's New Markets, President Clinton has proposed a tax credit worth up to 25 percent for investments in a wide range of vehicles serving these communities,

including community development banks, venture funds and corporations, the new investment company programs announced by the President (see descriptions below), and other targeted investment funds. Credits would be allocated to the targeted investment vehicles which could use the tax credits to attract investors. The investment funds would make their own decisions about what investments or loans to make to help create and grow businesses in the New Markets. A wide range of businesses could be financed by these investment funds, including small technology firms, inner-city shopping centers, manufacturers with hundreds of employees, and retail stores.

2. America's Private Investment Companies (APICs) -- For years, America has supported OPIC, the Overseas Private Investment Corporation, to promote growth in emerging markets abroad. Now we must do the same thing in America's New Markets. Under this program, investors will put a minimum of \$100 million in equity into new private investment partnerships to be known as America's Private Investment Companies (APICs). HUD and SBA working together will provide up to another \$200 million in loan guarantees for each. APICs will make equity investments in larger businesses that are expanding or relocating in inner cities and rural areas. Under the financing structure, the private investors' funds are at risk ahead of the government. However, the individual investment decisions must be approved by the government for consistency with the public policy mission of the program.

3. SBICs Targeted to New Markets --Over 40 years, the SBA's small business investment company (SBIC) program has provided roughly \$20 billion in equity and debt financing to more than 85,000 different companies, helping them at a critical stage to grow from small businesses to household names, like AOL and Staples. However, too little of the capital invested has benefited our cities and rural distressed communities. Last summer, the Vice President challenged the SBA to find ways to meet better the needs of minority firms and underserved markets. In response, SBA determined that, under existing legislation, the Agency can offer more flexibility and new financing terms to make it more attractive for SBICs to invest in businesses in low and moderate income (LMI) areas. Specifically, SBICs making LMI investments will be eligible for a new type of federally guaranteed loan to augment their capital for business investment. Interest on the guaranteed funding will be deferred for the first five years of the 10-year term to give SBICs more time to nurture their investments in small businesses before they must produce a return. In addition, SBA will conduct an aggressive outreach campaign around the country to promote LMI investments.

4. New Markets Venture Capital Firms (NMVCs) -- There are thousands of inner-city and rural entrepreneurs who need both capital and expert guidance to transform their small businesses and great ideas into thriving companies. SBA

will select ten-to-twenty NMVC firms whose management has successful records in community-based venture capital. The equity funds of private investors will be matched with government debt guarantees of up to \$10 million per NMVC, with interest on the debt deferred. Investors

must also provide at least \$1.5 million in technical assistance over five years to the target firms, matching SBA's grants of technical assistance.

The program should provide long-term, patient growth capital and facilitate critically needed technology and management skills development for smaller businesses in new markets.

5. New Markets Lending Companies (NMLC) -- For the first time in many years, SBA will approve approximately 10 new non-bank lenders -- firms authorized to originate loans under SBA's largest loan program -- the 7(a) General Business Loan Guaranty program. Under the 7(a) program, SBA guarantees up to 80% of a loan that is made by a lender to a creditworthy small business that cannot otherwise secure financing on reasonable terms. The firms selected must have a strategy to target their lending to underserved areas.

6. Continued Growth for CDFIs -- The President's initiative to develop community development financial institutions (CDFIs), locally-based institutions with expertise in lending and investment in underserved areas, will continue to grow. His FY 2000 balanced budget will include \$125 million for the CDFI fund. Thus far, CDFI has made over \$180 million in awards to community development organizations and financial institutions.

7. BusinessLINC -- The President's budget will include \$3 million in seed money to expand BusinessLINC -- an innovative public-private partnership launched by Vice President Gore and led by Treasury Secretary Rubin and SBA Administrator Alvarez -- to new markets in economically distressed communities. BusinessLINC (Learning, Information, Networking and Collaboration) is designed to encourage large businesses to work with small business owners and entrepreneurs in order to improve the economic competitiveness of smaller firms located in distressed areas, both urban and rural. The funds will be used to leverage private sector efforts to spur new BusinessLINC partnerships at the national and local level.

8. Specialized Small Business Investment Companies (SSBICs) -- The President's budget will expand current tax incentives to increase the amount of equity capital available to economically disadvantaged people by making
