REMARKS BY THE PRESIDENT
AT THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR
150TH ANNIVERSARY EVENT

THE PRESIDENT: Thank you very much. Ladies and gentlemen, it's wonderful to be here today. I want to thank the Great American Indian Dancers. I got to watch on the screen, off the stage, and I thought they were wonderful. And I want to thank Dagmar and Mark for their presentations and for the employees they represent.

Mark, that was a pretty shameless pander to Bruce Babbitt, though. (Laughter.) If that doesn't get you a raise, nothing will. (Laughter.)

And I would like to say Secretary Babbitt has spent a lot of his time putting out fires, both figuratively and literally, some of which I lit. (Laughter.) And I thank him for that and for his remarkable loyalty to this department. I got kind of tickled when he said that talking to one of you reminded him of drinking water from a fire hydrant. Sometimes I feel like a fire hydrant looking at a pack of dogs. (Laughter and applause.)

For six years I have declined to tell these kinds of jokes because I have been told repeatedly it is not presidential. (Laughter.) But I feel kind of outdoorsy today, you know. (Laughter.)

I would like to also say to all of you, I really appreciated the Secretary both featuring these two fine employees and talking about the other appointees. I know we have some previous administration appointees who have left to go on to other things here in the audience. I thank all of you who have served by my appointment, and all of you who served by choice in this department.

I have some remarks to make, but I hope that you will forgive me if I mention a few words about a great American citizen who deeply loved the natural beauty of his native Minnesota. Justice

Harry Blackmun died this morning, at the age of 90. In 24 years on the Supreme Court, he served with compassion, distinction and honor. Every decision and every dissent was firmly grounded in the Constitution he revered, and his uncanny feel for the human element that lies just beneath the surface of all serious legal argument.

You can see his mind and heart at work in the landmark decision he wrote protecting women's rights to reproductive freedom, and in his decisions to make the promise of civil rights actually come alive in the daily existence of the American people.

Hillary and I were deeply privileged to know Justice Blackmun and his wonderful wife of 58 years, Dottie, for quite a

long while. I saw up close Harry Blackmun's intense passion -- his passion for the welfare of the American people, for defending our liberties and our institutions, for moving us forward together. We send our respect and our prayers to Dottie and to his three daughters.

To the millions of Americans whose voices he heard and whose rights he defended, to the countless numbers of us who knew and loved him, Harry Blackmun's life embodied the admonition of the prophet, Michael: He did justice, and he loved mercy. And now, he walks humbly with his God. Thank you very much. (Applause.)

Now, let me say that I've been wanting to come over here to thank you for a long time. I don't know that there has ever been a President who has benefitted more, in personal ways at important times of his life, from the Department of the Interior. I was raised in Hot Springs National Park, Arkansas, the first city in America to contain a national park. I spent my first 18 years in a state that is more than half

-covered with pine and hardwood forests, which is why Mike Gaudin had a little trouble appreciating Arizona. (Laughter.)

When I finished law school, I went home to the hills of northwest Arkansas, and spent some of the happiest days of my life on the Buffalo River, the very first river set aside under the National Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

Today, my family and I have the great honor of living in the most beautiful home under the care of the National Parks System. Sometimes it feels more like a zoo than a park, but I love it. Now, my lease is up in one year, 10 months, and 16 days -- (laughter) -- but who's counting? (Laughter.)

Perhaps more than any other department of the federal government, the Interior Department really does embody the history of our country: The story of manifest destiny and the great Western expansion; the story of fertile fields rising from arid desert; of people rising from the depths of the Great Depression; of a nation marshaling the resources to win two world wars. A story of scientific discovery and relentless explorations; a story of our

country's struggle to recognize the dignity and independence and sovereignty, and expand the opportunity of our first citizens, our Native Americans.

A story of the efforts of this country to expand the horizons and make real the promise of America for all Americans, as Secretary Harold Ickes did when he invited the incomparable Marian Anderson to sing from the steps of the Lincoln Memorial 60 years ago, in 1939. Most of all, as Secretary Babbitt has proved every day, it is the story of our intensifying determination as a people to conserve and restore our precious natural resources.

In 1849, when this Department was launched, with a headquarter staff of 10, and a budget of \$14,200, it lacked a unifying purpose -- hard to imagine you could do much more than one thing with that kind of money. (Laughter.) Today, with a much larger staff and a considerably larger budget, the contrast is remarkable.

Under Bruce Babbitt's leadership, everything this department does is guided by the unifying purpose of stewardship. As wise and dedicated stewards, you act in the recognition that all of us are but brief visitors on this small planet. You understand that everything we want for our children depends on protecting the forests, the streams, the deserts that were here so very long before we came along. Today, the "Department of BOTTOM ODD MORE Everything Else," as it was once called, is and forever will be the "Department of Stewardship." And for that, I thank you all.

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Using a skillful touch, but not a heavy hand, you have achieved remarkable things. Many have been mentioned today, but because they're so important to me, I want to thank you personally for them. Three years ago, we set out on a mission to preserve California's Headwaters Forest, the world's largest unprotected stand of old

-growth redwoods. Three days ago, you did it. We did it. And aren't we glad. (Applause.)

Thanks to the tireless efforts of so many people here and at your sister agency, NOAA, not one of the magnificent trees of Headwaters Forest will ever be logged. Anyone who has ever strolled through a grove of redwoods -- and I have -- who have seen the tangle of ferns at your feet and a living canopy reaching high overhead, knows that these ancient forests are as much a part of our legacy, as I said, as the world's great cathedrals. Thank you for making them safe for all time.

We should also be proud that over the last six years we've set aside vast unspoiled areas of the Mojave Desert, designating three new national parks. We put a stop to a massive mining operation that threatened Yellowstone, the world's first

national park. To protect Utah's stunning Red Rock Canyons, we created the Grand Staircase Escalante National Monument, and completed the largest land exchange in the continental United States.

And I have to tell you, I just returned from Utah, where the rest of my family went skiing, and I thought about it. (Laughter.) And I was so pleased that any number of people, after all the flak we took -- any number of people came up to me, just on the street, and said, Mr. President, you might have been right about that; I think this is going to work out fine, and I'm glad we saved that land. (Applause.)

And in a project that has been particularly close to my heart because I have also been there, we are restoring the Florida Everglades -- the largest restoration project ever undertaken in our nation's history.

That is quite a legacy. But we have much, much more to do. This year, the last of this century, we must dedicate ourselves not to resting on these accomplishments, but to building on them.

First, we must preserve more precious lands. I will soon send the Congress a plan to bestow the highest level of wilderness protection on more than 5 million acres of backcountry lands within Yellowstone, Glacier and other national parks. (Applause.) In these vast regions, the roar of bulldozers and chainsaws never again will drown out the call of the wild.

I'm also proposing an unprecedented \$1 billion Lands Legacy Initiative, which Secretary Babbitt mentioned, on which many of you worked. It will allow us to continue your efforts to protect natural and historic lands across our nation, such as Civil War battlefields, remote stretches of the historic Lewis and Clark trail, and an additional 450,000 acres in and around Mojave and Joshua Tree National Parks.

It will also allow us to meet the stewardship challenges of a new century. It is no longer enough for our nation to preserve its grandest natural wonders. As communities grow and expand, it has become every bit as important to preserve the small, but sacred, green and open space closer to home. So my Lands Legacy Initiative will also help communities protect meadows and seashores, where children play; streams where sportsmen and women can fish; farmlands that produce the fresh TOP EVEN
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harvest we often take for granted.

We believe this Lands Legacy Initiative must be a permanent legacy. So today -- (applause) -- today, I promise to work with Congress to create for the very first time a guaranteed fund for protecting and restoring priceless land all across America.

There are many good legislative ideas for achieving this goal. We think any solution must provide at least \$1 billion annually, with at least half dedicated to helping communities protect

local greenspaces. It also must recognize the unique environmental challenges of coastal states, without creating any new incentives for offshore oil drilling.

Working together, we can ensure that not only our generation, but each generation to come, will have the resources to leave an even better land for those who follow. Second, as we help preserve more open spaces, we have a great opportunity to help create more liveable communities; healthy communities where people don't have to waste a gallon of gasoline driving to get a gallon of milk; where employers have no trouble recruiting workers interested in a high quality of life.

The Vice President and I have proposed record funding for public transit and Better America bonds to help communities grow in ways that ensure a clean environment and strong, sustainable economic development.

Third, we must clean up the 40 percent of our waterways that still are too polluted for fishing and swimming. Most Americans don't know that and many are surprised to hear it. I call on Congress to fully fund my clean water action plan and to reauthorize and strengthen the Clean Water Act.

Fourth, we must do more to meet our most profound, common global environmental challenge, the challenge of global warming. I have proposed a clean air partnership fund to help communities reduce both greenhouse pollution and smog, as well as tax and research incentives to spur clean energy technologies. I want to work with members of Congress in both parties to reward companies that take early, voluntary action to reduce greenhouse gases.

Let me say just one thing here that's not in the script. A lot of you clapped and a lot of you were smiling when I said I'd been to Utah, and people came up to me and said, this Grand Staircase idea wasn't such a bad idea, after all. And you nodded your head because you knew it all along. One of the biggest impediments to human progress in any free society is the persistence buried deep in the brains of the people at large or people in decision

-making positions, of old ideas that aren't right any longer. The biggest impediment we have to dealing with the challenge of climate change is not cheap oil. It is the old idea that we simply cannot have economic growth without Industrial Age patterns of energy use.

And I see it all over the world. I see it here in the United States. I see it in the United States Congress, where one subcommittee forced us to spend hundreds of thousands of dollars last year trying to defend our climate change plan, which had no new taxes, no big new regulations, was solely devoted to tax incentives, and new research and development for new technologies.

Now, the fact is that things we do today to reduce greenhouse gas pollution -- with available technologies, not to mention those that are just ahead and almost within our reach -- will lower greenhouse gas emissions, will reduce the threat of global warming, and will create more jobs at higher incomes. The old idea is wrong. I ask the employees of the Interior Department to help the American people get rid of an old, wrong idea, so that we can do

this. (Applause.)

These are the things that we have to do: setting aside more lands; making more livable communities; cleaning up our waterways; dealing with the challenge of climate change. We can do it. I say to the members of Congress in both parties, please join this crusade. I say to the majority party, the preservation of our natural resources, the stewardship of this great land, should not be a partisan issue. (Applause.)

This country never had a better conservation President than Theodore Roosevelt. For 12 years, I was a governor. The first Governors' Conference in history was called by Theodore Roosevelt in 1908 to talk about the conservation of our resources.

When I was out in Utah, I was looking through Roosevelt's four

-volume history of the American West, and thinking to myself, why don't we have two parties equally committed to fulfilling his vision? So I implore the Congress: Let us not waste precious time battling over these bad anti

-environmental riders, which I am going to veto anyway; instead, let's go on with the work of America. (Applause.)

Let me say in closing one very personal thing. As I have already explained, I am as deeply indebted to the work of the Department of the Interior as any President could possibly be -- to the visionaries like John Wesley Powell and Harold Ickes and Rachel Carson, to the park rangers that I've seen in Yellowstone and Grand Teton and other parks, to the people that were kind to me as a boy when I roamed the trails and the mountains of the national park which was my home.

In one way or the other, almost all of us have come to see nature as a precious, but fragile, gift, and an important part of the fabric of our lives. Probably every one of us could cite one particular example where that came home to us as never before. I remember once in 1971, when I was driving to California to visit Hillary -- we had just started seeing each other -- and I stopped at the Grand Canyon. And I crawled out on a ledge, about an hour

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-half or two before sunset, and I just sat there for two hours, and I watched the sun set on Grand Canyon -- if you've never done it, you ought to do it.

And because of the way the rocks are layered over millions of years, it's like a kaleidoscope. And the colors change over and over and over again, layer by layer by layer as the sun goes down. It is a stunning, stunning thing to see the interplay of light and stone, and realize how it happened over the ages. I never got

over it. I think about it all the time, now, nearly 30 years later.

That kind of moment can't be captured in the words I have shared with you, or even photographed, because the important thing is the interaction of human nature with nature. But we've all felt it. And we all know that part of our essential humanity is paying respect to what God gave us, and what will be here a long time after we're gone.

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That is what the Interior Department means to me. And after 150 years, it's what it means to all of America's past, and to America's great future.

Thank you, and God bless you. (Applause.)

SUBJECT: Travel Notes

I. DEPARTURE AND BAGGAGE CALL

Baggage should be in place outside of OEOB 89 « by 8 pm on Sunday, March 7. Baggage should be dropped off at Andrews Air Force Base by no later than 4:30 am on Monday, March 8. Bags must be left unlocked.

For staff traveling on Air Force One - vans will depart the West Basement for Andrews at 5:15 am on Monday, March 8.

For staff traveling on the support aircraft -- vans will depart the West Basement for Andrews at 9:30 am on Monday, March 8. The support plane will proceed directly to El Salvador.

II. OPERATIONAL SECURITY

Security issues are of extreme importance when traveling abroad on behalf of the United States government. Some important reminders are useful:

Do not leave schedules, memoranda or other sensitive information (whether classified or not) in your hotel room or in other open locations. Keep all materials in a safe location or discard it in a burn bag.

Do not discuss sensitive information on an unsecured phone line. Assume that all conversations, whether by telephone or in your room, can be monitored. Do not utter anything that could endanger the success of the visit.

Do not discuss trip itineraries, logistics or problems in restaurants, restrooms or public areas. Remember, more people speak English than you might think

III. WHAT TO PACK

Washington business attire will be suitable for most government meetings in the major cities with the exception of the following:

Nicaragua - Upon arrival in Managua, all participants in the arrival ceremony (particularly the cabinet and CODEL) should be in business attire. Casual clothing and comfortable shoes will be appropriate and necessary for travel immediately following to Posoltega.

IV. MEDICAL PRECAUTIONS

The White House Medical Unit has specific recommendations for travel to the Central American region. All travelers should be immunized with: Havrix (Hepatitis A vaccine) and Typhoid in addition to making sure that all childhood immunizations are up-to-date. In addition due to recent hurricane activity and rural destinations, malaria prophylaxis is also recommended. Representatives from the White House Medical Unit will be available to help throughout the trip. Contact WHMU at 202-757-2476 prior to your departure with questions.

V. WEATHER

Nicaragua - Located on the Pacific side of the central mountains, the weather is generally hot and dry. The skies are partly cloudy and rainfall is rare. Temperatures range from near 70F in the early morning hours to about 90F by midday. Smoke and haze restrict visibility near the industrial center.

El Salvador - The weather is hot and dry with clear to partly cloudy skies. Rain occurs on an average of only one day during the month and that is usually associated with a thunderstorm. Temperatures range from the daily highs in the low 90s to early morning lows near 60F.

Honduras - The month is typically warm and dry in the central portion of Honduras. The afternoons are warm and the nights coll with temperatures ranging from the upper 50's to 80F. Precipitation is isolated during the dry season, with the chance of rain only about 10%.

Guatemala - March is in the middle of the dry season in Guatemala City. Dry in this case means only two days of light rain expected during the month. The temperatures range from the low 50's in the morning to the mid 70's. Haze and smoke may restrict visibility to less than half a mile on 5-6 days of the month.

STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT

I was deeply saddened to learn of the brutal violence that erupted Monday morning in a nature preserve in Southwestern Uganda. Hillary and I have extended our profound condolences to the families of the victims.

Eight innocent tourists from the United States, Great Britain, and New Zealand were killed. All of the victims were there because they loved Africa. It was a senseless and cowardly murder -- apparently committed by those who perpetrated the Rwandan genocide in 1994. If this attack was intended as a warning to our nation to stop supporting those in the region seeking reconciliation and justice, those who committed it should understand that we will not be deterred in any way.

We will not forget these crimes, nor rest until those who committed them are brought to justice. Already, a team of FBI experts is on the ground, working with Ugandan authorities to gather the relevant evidence so indictments of the perpetrators can be made.

Let me also underscore our commitment to breaking the cycle of violence and impunity that has gripped the Great Lakes region so that all who live in and visit the region can do so without fear.

**Congress thaws on emissions
Bill coincides with report on Earth's rising temperature**

At the same time a new report finds that the 1990s have been the hottest decade in 1,000 years, Congress appears to be warming toward legislation aimed at reducing emissions of chemicals that many scientists say are causing the Earth's temperature to rise.

A bipartisan group of senators, including conservatives who often oppose environmental initiatives, plans to unveil a bill today that would reward companies for taking steps to reduce carbon dioxide emissions now, rather than waiting for an international treaty on global warming to take effect in 2008.

The measure, which would give businesses potentially valuable credits in exchange for cutting pollution, still faces tough challenges, including a skeptical House of Representatives and some environmentalists who fear that the proposal would result in the increased use of nuclear power because it causes no carbon dioxide emissions.

The bill, written by Senator John H. Chafee, a Rhode Island Republican, and cosponsored by nine others, could get action from a Congress that has been largely hostile to efforts to slow the two-century rise in Earth's carbon dioxide levels.

"We're seeing bipartisan momentum develop for an idea that makes sense for the environment and makes sense for industry as well," said Fred Krupp, executive director of the Environmental Defense Fund of New York, one of the nation's biggest environmental groups. "This stands a good chance of passing."

Chafee, chairman of the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee, said he hopes the bill encourages companies to be creative in trying to reverse the United States's steadily rising emissions of carbon dioxide and other heat-trapping gases rather than wait for an international treaty called the Kyoto Protocol to order them to take action.

"Do we just sit around and wait another nine years before we do anything?" Chafee asked. "Whether you are for or against the Kyoto Protocol, the US should do things now to facilitate immediate environmental gains."

Meanwhile, a study finds the 1990s have been the warmest decade at least since the Norman Conquest of England in 1066. What's more, the researchers say that 1998 was the hottest year of the millennium.

Using a combination of ancient tree rings and ice drilled from glaciers, Raymond Bradley and Michael Mann of the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, along with Malcolm Hughes, a University of Arizona scientist, found that the planet is even warmer than during the so-called Medieval Warm Period when Europeans complained about the heat.

"One can't quite pin things down as well" further back in time, admitted Mann, "but our results do reveal that ... temperatures in the latter 20th century have been exceptionally warm compared to the preceding 900 years."

Their paper in the journal *Geophysical Research Letters*, joins a growing body of research showing that the 1990s have been record-hot, capped by 1998, when the long Texas drought and Florida wildfires made headlines.

But climate change remains one of the most contentious issues in environmental politics, in part because it is so complex. Skeptical scientists, such as Thomas Gale Moore of Stanford University, doubt the temperature has risen abnormally, and they are even more skeptical that human actions such as burning coal and oil have caused a temperature rise.

The climate debate has sharply divided President Clinton from the Republican-controlled Congress. In 1997, Clinton endorsed the Kyoto Protocol, which commits the United States to reduce heat-trapping gases beginning in 2008, but Senate leaders have vowed not to ratify the deal, arguing it would hurt the economy.

While the two sides wrangled, Chafee, along with Senators Joseph Lieberman of Connecticut and Connie Mack of Florida, drafted a bill late last year to encourage American companies to act now. The fact that Mack, who received a zero rating from the environmental League of Conservation Voters, was one of the bill's drafters immediately drew attention to the cause.

Their bill would allow companies to cut emissions now - for instance, by converting from coal to natural gas power - and claim credit for the savings under whatever rules the United States later adopts to fight global warming. Those credits, measured in tons of avoided emissions, could be subtracted from the company's total emissions to meet the rules, or sold to other firms.

Some environmentalists fear that the bill may be too loose, giving companies credit for anything that reduces carbon dioxide even if it causes new problems. Replacing a coal-burning plant with a nuclear plant would reduce

carbon dioxide emissions, they note, but would increase nuclear waste. The bill would also give credit for shutting down factories, they add.

Still, for a Congress that only last year was considering a measure to prevent federal officials from talking about global warming, other environmentalists see Chafee's initiative as progress.

Warmest Decade so Far

Cooling Trend of 900 Years Dramatically Reversed this Century

WASHINGTON, March 3 — The 1990s were the warmest decade of the millennium, with 1998 the warmest year so far, researchers said today.

The study adds to a growing body of evidence that the global climate has been getting steadily warmer—especially the last half of the 20th century.

"Temperatures in the latter half of the 20th century were unprecedented," Raymond Bradley of the University of Massachusetts said in a statement.

Their report, published in *Geophysical Research Letters*, shows that temperatures dropped an average of 0.04 degree F per century for the 900 years before the 20th century.

Human Climate Records

Because human climate records only go back a few hundred years, and do not cover the whole globe, the team at the University of Massachusetts and the University of Arizona looked at measurements other scientists have made of tree rings, ice cores and other "proxy indicators" that record climate variations.

They heavily relied on three sets of 1,000-year-long tree-ring records from North America, as well as tree rings from northern Scandinavia, northern Russia, Tasmania, Argentina, Morocco, and France.

The ice cores they studied came from Greenland and the Andes mountains in South America.

"As you go back farther in time, the data become sketchier," Michael Mann of the University of Massachusetts said.

Startling Revelations

"One can't quite pin things down as well, but our results do reveal that significant changes have occurred, and temperatures in the latter 20th century have been exceptionally warm compared to the preceding 900 years."

He said the records were not perfect, but complete

enough to show "startling revelations."

"If temperatures change slowly, society and the environment have time to adjust," he said. "The slow, moderate, long-term cooling trend that we found makes the abrupt warming of the late 20th-century even more dramatic."

"The cooling trend of over 900 years was dramatically reversed in less than a century. The abruptness of the recent warming is key, and it is a potential cause for concern."

Warmest Year on Record

In January the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) said they had established that 1998 was the warmest year on record.

But their finding was based on records only going back 120 years.

In January the American Geophysical Union, which publishes Geophysical Research Letters, called for continued efforts to curb human-made carbon emissions to stop global warming.

In December the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) said the earth's mean surface temperature in 1998 was 0.58 degrees C above the average for the benchmark period 1961-90. For the century, global temperatures were almost 0.7 degrees C above those at the end of the 19th century.

A warmer global climate melts the ice caps, raising sea levels, and disturbs weather patterns, causing droughts, severe storms, tornadoes, hurricanes and blizzards.

THE Sydney Futures Exchange's proposed carbon emissions contract yesterday received the thumbs up from one of the US's key climate treaty negotiators.

Former US assistant secretary of State Eileen Claussen said the Australian system would help in the design of similar systems internationally.

She said that businesses, including oil giants such as Shell and BP, were already manoeuvring to take advantage of a carbon credit trading system, which would allow them to increase earnings by selling excess credits.

"There's lots of room for experimentation here. We've encouraged the companies to think about that themselves. BP-Amoco has already established an internal trading system among a certain number of their facilities."

"I think that kind of experimentation is highly desirable because I suspect some things will come out of that that will be helpful in designing both a global system and any national ones after that," she said. "Our experience in the US was that the most important thing you can do in a trading system is have a good accounting system. If you can't account for emissions, there's no real value to what it is that you're trading."

Ms Claussen now heads the not-for-profit Pew Centre, which addresses the business challenge of climate change and has 22 major companies on its books including Toyota, BP, 3M, Boeing, Enron and Lockheed Martin.

Previously, Ms Claussen was assistant secretary of State for Oceans and International and Scientific Affairs, having worked on several international treaties.

She said that business was now seeing climate change as a competitive issue and a driver for innovation, just as the Cold War in the 1950s and 1960s was the driver for development and change in industries such as electronics and aerospace.

Companies in the Pew program were not altruistic but were expecting to profit from emission reductions.

Ms Claussen spoke of a recent sea change in both Congress and big business in the US on global warming, with key Republicans helping to draft a bill giving credit to companies taking early action on reducing emissions.

THE PRESIDENT: Thank you very much. Ladies and gentlemen, it's wonderful to be here today. I want to thank the Great American Indian Dancers. I got to watch on the screen, off the stage, and I thought they were wonderful. And I want to thank Dagmar and Mark for their presentations and for the employees they represent.

Mark, that was a pretty shameless pander to Bruce Babbitt, though. (Laughter.) If that doesn't get you a raise, nothing will. (Laughter.)

And I would like to say Secretary Babbitt has spent a lot of his time putting out fires, both figuratively and literally, some of which I lit. (Laughter.) And I thank him for that and for his remarkable loyalty to this department. I got kind of tickled when he said that talking to one of you reminded him of drinking water from a fire hydrant. Sometimes I feel like a fire hydrant looking at a pack of dogs. (Laughter and applause.)

For six years I have declined to tell these kinds of jokes because I have been told repeatedly it is not presidential. (Laughter.) But I feel kind of outdoorsy today, you know. (Laughter.)

I would like to also say to all of you, I really appreciated the Secretary both featuring these two fine employees and talking about the other appointees. I know we have some previous administration appointees who have left to go on to other things here in the audience. I thank all of you who have served by my appointment, and all of you who served by choice in this department.

I have some remarks to make, but I hope that you will forgive me if I mention a few words about a great American citizen who deeply loved the natural beauty of his native Minnesota. Justice Harry Blackmun died this morning, at the age of 90. In 24 years on the Supreme Court, he served with compassion, distinction and honor. Every decision and every dissent was firmly grounded in the Constitution he revered, and his uncanny feel for the human element that lies just beneath the surface of all serious legal argument.

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You can see his mind and heart at work in the landmark decision he wrote protecting women's rights to reproductive freedom, and in his decisions to make the promise of civil rights actually come alive in the daily existence of the American people.

Hillary and I were deeply privileged to know Justice Blackmun and his wonderful wife of 58 years, Dottie, for quite a

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long while. I saw up close Harry Blackmun's intense passion -- his passion for the welfare of the American people, for defending our liberties and our institutions, for moving us forward together. We send our respect and our prayers to Dottie and to his three daughters.

To the millions of Americans whose voices he heard and whose rights he defended, to the countless numbers of us who knew and loved him, Harry Blackmun's life embodied the admonition of the prophet, Michael: He did justice, and he loved mercy. And now, he walks humbly with his God. Thank you very much. (Applause.)

Now, let me say that I've been wanting to come over here to thank you for a long time. I don't know that there has ever been a President who has benefitted more, in personal ways at important times of his life, from the Department of the Interior. I was raised in Hot Springs National Park, Arkansas, the first city in America to contain a national park. I spent my first 18 years in a state that is more than half-covered with pine and hardwood forests, which is why Mike Gaudin had a little trouble appreciating Arizona. (Laughter.)

When I finished law school, I went home to the hills of northwest Arkansas, and spent some of the happiest days of my life on the Buffalo River, the very first river set aside under the National Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

Today, my family and I have the great honor of living in the most beautiful home under the care of the National Parks System. Sometimes it feels more like a zoo than a park, but I love it. Now, my lease is up in one year, 10 months, and 16 days -- (laughter) -- but who's counting? (Laughter.)

Perhaps more than any other department of the federal government, the Interior Department really does embody the history of our country: The story of manifest destiny and the great Western expansion; the story of fertile fields rising from arid desert; of people rising from the depths of the Great Depression; of a nation marshaling the resources to win two world wars. A story of scientific discovery and relentless explorations; a story of our country's struggle to recognize the dignity and independence and sovereignty, and expand the opportunity of our first citizens, our Native Americans.

A story of the efforts of this country to expand the horizons and make real the promise of America for all Americans, as Secretary Harold Ickes did when he invited the incomparable Marian Anderson to sing from the steps of the Lincoln Memorial 60 years ago, in 1939. Most of all, as Secretary Babbitt has proved every day, it is the story of our intensifying determination as a people to conserve and restore our precious natural resources.

In 1849, when this Department was launched, with a

headquarter staff of 10, and a budget of \$14,200, it lacked a unifying purpose -- hard to imagine you could do much more than one thing with that kind of money. (Laughter.) Today, with a much larger staff and a considerably larger budget, the contrast is remarkable.

Under Bruce Babbitt's leadership, everything this department does is guided by the unifying purpose of stewardship. As wise and dedicated stewards, you act in the recognition that all of us are but brief visitors on this small planet. You understand that everything we want for our children depends on protecting the forests, the streams, the deserts that were here so very long before we came along. Today, the "Department of Everything Else," as it was once called, is and forever will be the "Department of Stewardship." And for that, I thank you all.

Using a skillful touch, but not a heavy hand, you have achieved remarkable things. Many have been mentioned today, but because they're so important to me, I want to thank you personally for them. Three years ago, we set out on a mission to preserve California's Headwaters Forest, the world's largest unprotected stand of old-growth redwoods. Three days ago, you did it. We did it. And aren't we glad. (Applause.)

Thanks to the tireless efforts of so many people here and at your sister agency, NOAA, not one of the magnificent trees of Headwaters Forest will ever be logged. Anyone who has ever strolled through a grove of redwoods -- and I have -- who have seen the tangle of ferns at your feet and a living canopy reaching high overhead, knows that these ancient forests are as much a part of our legacy, as I said, as the world's great cathedrals. Thank you for making them safe for all time.

We should also be proud that over the last six years we've set aside vast unspoiled areas of the Mojave Desert, designating three new national parks. We put a stop to a massive mining operation that threatened Yellowstone, the world's first national park. To protect Utah's stunning Red Rock Canyons, we created the Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument, and completed the largest land exchange in the continental United States.

And I have to tell you, I just returned from Utah, where the rest of my family went skiing, and I thought about it. (Laughter.) And I was so pleased that any number of people, after all the flak we took -- any number of people came up to me, just on the street, and said, Mr. President, you might have been right about that; I think this is going to work out fine, and I'm glad we saved that land. (Applause.)

And in a project that has been particularly close to my heart because I have also been there, we are restoring the Florida

Everglades -- the largest restoration project ever undertaken in our nation's history.

That is quite a legacy. But we have much, much more to do. This year, the last of this century, we must dedicate ourselves not to resting on these accomplishments, but to building on them.

First, we must preserve more precious lands. I will soon send the Congress a plan to bestow the highest level of wilderness protection on more than 5 million acres of backcountry lands within Yellowstone, Glacier and other national parks. (Applause.) In these vast regions, the roar of bulldozers and chainsaws never again will drown out the call of the wild.

I'm also proposing an unprecedented \$1 billion Lands Legacy Initiative, which Secretary Babbitt mentioned, on which many of you worked. It will allow us to continue your efforts to protect natural and historic lands across our nation, such as Civil War battlefields, remote stretches of the historic Lewis and Clark trail, and an additional 450,000 acres in and around Mojave and Joshua Tree National Parks.

It will also allow us to meet the stewardship challenges of a new century. It is no longer enough for our nation to preserve its grandest natural wonders. As communities grow and expand, it has become every bit as important to preserve the small, but sacred, green and open space closer to home. So my Lands Legacy Initiative will also help communities protect meadows and seashores, where children play; streams where sportsmen and women can fish; farmlands that produce the fresh harvest we often take for granted.

We believe this Lands Legacy Initiative must be a permanent legacy. So today -- (applause) -- today, I promise to work with Congress to create for the very first time a guaranteed fund for protecting and restoring priceless land all across America.

There are many good legislative ideas for achieving this goal. We think any solution must provide at least \$1 billion annually, with at least half dedicated to helping communities protect local greenspaces. It also must recognize the unique environmental challenges of coastal states, without creating any new incentives for offshore oil drilling.

Working together, we can ensure that not only our generation, but each generation to come, will have the resources to leave an even better land for those who follow. Second, as we help preserve more open spaces, we have a great opportunity to help create more liveable communities; healthy communities where people don't have to waste a gallon of gasoline driving to get a gallon of milk; where employers have no trouble recruiting workers interested in a high quality of life.

The Vice President and I have proposed record funding

for public transit and Better America bonds to help communities grow in ways that ensure a clean environment and strong, sustainable economic development.

Third, we must clean up the 40 percent of our waterways that still are too polluted for fishing and swimming. Most Americans don't know that and many are surprised to hear it. I call on Congress to fully fund my clean water action plan and to reauthorize and strengthen the Clean Water Act.

Fourth, we must do more to meet our most profound, common global environmental challenge, the challenge of global warming. I have proposed a clean air partnership fund to help communities reduce both greenhouse pollution and smog, as well as tax and research incentives to spur clean energy technologies. I want to work with members of Congress in both parties to reward companies that take early, voluntary action to reduce greenhouse gases.

Let me say just one thing here that's not in the script. A lot of you clapped and a lot of you were smiling when I said I'd been to Utah, and people came up to me and said, this Grand Staircase idea wasn't such a bad idea, after all. And you nodded your head because you knew it all along. One of the biggest impediments to human progress in any free society is the persistence buried deep in the brains of the people at large or people in decision-making positions, of old ideas that aren't right any longer. The biggest impediment we have to dealing with the challenge of climate change is not cheap oil. It is the old idea that we simply cannot have economic growth without Industrial Age patterns of energy use.

And I see it all over the world. I see it here in the United States. I see it in the United States Congress, where one subcommittee forced us to spend hundreds of thousands of dollars last year trying to defend our climate change plan, which had no new taxes, no big new regulations, was solely devoted to tax incentives, and new research and development for new technologies.

Now, the fact is that things we do today to reduce greenhouse gas pollution -- with available technologies, not to mention those that are just ahead and almost within our reach -- will lower greenhouse gas emissions, will reduce the threat of global warming, and will create more jobs at higher incomes. The old idea is wrong. I ask the employees of the Interior Department to help the American people get rid of an old, wrong idea, so that we can do this. (Applause.)

These are the things that we have to do: setting aside more lands; making more livable communities; cleaning up our waterways; dealing with the challenge of climate change. We can do it. I say to the members of Congress in both parties, please join this crusade. I say to the majority party, the preservation of our natural resources, the stewardship of this great land, should not be a partisan issue. (Applause.)

This country never had a better conservation President than Theodore Roosevelt. For 12 years, I was a governor. The first Governors' Conference in history was called by Theodore Roosevelt in 1908 to talk about the conservation of our resources.

When I was out in Utah, I was looking through Roosevelt's four-volume history of the American West, and thinking to myself, why don't we have two parties equally committed to fulfilling his vision? So I implore the Congress: Let us not waste precious time battling over these bad anti-environmental riders, which I am going to veto anyway; instead, let's go on with the work of America. (Applause.)

Let me say in closing one very personal thing. As I have already explained, I am as deeply indebted to the work of the Department of the Interior as any President could possibly be -- to the visionaries like John Wesley Powell and Harold Ickes and Rachel Carson, to the park rangers that I've seen in Yellowstone and Grand Teton and other parks, to the people that were kind to me as a boy when I roamed the trails and the mountains of the national park which was my home.

In one way or the other, almost all of us have come to see nature as a precious, but fragile, gift, and an important part of the fabric of our lives. Probably every one of us could cite one particular example where that came home to us as never before. I remember once in 1971, when I was driving to California to visit Hillary -- we had just started seeing each other -- and I stopped at the Grand Canyon. And I crawled out on a ledge, about an hour-and-a-half or two before sunset, and I just sat there for two hours, and I watched the sun set on Grand Canyon -- if you've never done it, you ought to do it.

And because of the way the rocks are layered over millions of years, it's like a kaleidoscope. And the colors change over and over and over again, layer by layer by layer as the sun goes down. It is a stunning, stunning thing to see the interplay of light and stone, and realize how it happened over the ages. I never got over it. I think about it all the time, now, nearly 30 years later.

That kind of moment can't be captured in the words I have shared with you, or even photographed, because the important thing is the interaction of human nature with nature. But we've all felt it. And we all know that part of our essential humanity is paying respect to what God gave us, and what will be here a long time after we're gone.

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That is what the Interior Department means to me. And after 150 years, it's what it means to all of America's past, and to America's great future.

Thank you, and God bless you. (Applause.)

PRESIDENT CLINTON: LASTING PROTECTION FOR OUR NATURAL TREASURES March 4, 1999

Today, at a celebration marking the 150th anniversary of the Department of the Interior, President Clinton pledges to work with Congress to provide permanent funding to preserve America's lands legacy. The President's FY 2000 budget includes \$1 billion to protect natural treasures and help communities preserve local green spaces -- the largest one-year investment ever for the protection of America's land and coastal resources. To sustain these efforts through the coming century, the President today is calling for a guaranteed funding stream of at least \$1 billion a year.

150 Years of Stewardship. The President joins Interior Secretary Babbitt to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the Department of the Interior and to honor employees and citizens who have helped advance the Department's mission and goals. Created in 1849 to administer the vast holdings acquired through the Louisiana Purchase and the Mexican War of 1846-48, the Department today manages more than 440 million acres of federal lands, including some 360 national parks and 500 wildlife refuges.

Preserving America's Lands Legacy. Over the past six years, President Clinton and Vice President Gore have worked to restore the Florida Everglades, save Yellowstone from mining, preserve Utah's spectacular red-rock canyons, and protect other precious lands. This week, the Administration concluded an historic agreement to save the ancient redwoods of California's Headwaters Forest.

As part of his balanced budget for FY 2000, the President proposed a \$1 billion Lands Legacy Initiative that charts a new conservation vision for the 21st century: preserving irreplaceable pieces of our natural legacy within easy reach of every citizen. It includes \$413 million for federal protection of natural and historic sites across the country; \$434 million to help state, local and tribal governments preserve farms, urban parks and other local green spaces; and \$183 million to protect coastal and ocean resources.

Guaranteed Funding for the Future. To sustain these efforts in the years ahead, the President today is calling for legislation to provide a permanent funding stream of at least \$1 billion a year, within a balanced budget, beginning in FY 2001. This legislation should:

Dedicate about half of the funding to state, local, and tribal efforts to protect or restore open space, greenways, urban parks, wildlife habitat, coastal wetlands, farms and forests.

Allow communities to use a range of tools, including easements and other flexible mechanisms, to protect resources in the manner best suited to local needs.

Protect wildlife by funding efforts to preserve and restore a diversity of habitats.

Recognize the unique environmental needs of coastal states without creating new incentives for offshore oil leasing.

Progress, Not Partisanship, on the Environment. President Clinton also calls on Congress to: grant wilderness protection to 5 million acres within national parks and monuments; approve Better America Bonds to help communities save green space, improve water quality, and clean up brownfields; fully fund the Clean Water Action Plan, and strengthen and reauthorize the Clean Water Act; approve the Clean Air Partnership Fund, and proposed research and tax incentives, to help meet the challenge of global warming; and pass legislation free of anti-environmental riders.
