The Technology Learning Challenge Initiative is not the Challenge Grant Program.

During 1994-1995, an Interagency Task Force, under the aegis of the Education, Training, and Re-employment Working Group, initiated and pursued a **Technology Learning Challenge**. The vision of the TLC is to ensure all Americans access -- anytime and anyplace -- to quality education and training tailored to their individual learning and workplace needs. In order to realize this vision, the Interagency Task Force has pursued seven complementary activities: the **Challenge Grant Program**; a Demonstration Program; a Research and Development Agenda; a Digitization Program; a study of Interactive Hardware Connections; a plan to integrate technology into Federal Programs; and an Outreach Program. All of these are activities to be carried out by the Interagency Learning Technology Office, approved by the NSTC Committee on Education and Training (CET), and detailed in the CET's 1995 Strategic Plan.

The Peter Maxx "Technology Learning Challenge" logo is intended to be used for all aspects of the TLC.
