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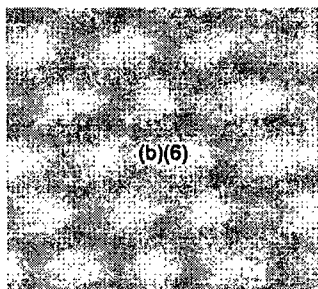

- ↳ Kasselbaum able to hold Republicans yesterday - put strong arm on Goleis -- very effective
- ↳ No discussion of Governance yesterday - voted some weak language in as placeholder -- let Kennedy offer own amendment
- ↳ Same deal w/ STW - placeholder language and amendment
- ↳ Targeting issue still not resolved. Kennedy has our amendments on all issues.
- ↳ Kasselbaum & Reich talked yesterday -- she asked Reich for language on what we want.
- ↳ we need one set of negotiators at this point -- we are unified now -- create team with Steve (Kennedy), Rodd person, Doc person - negotiate as unified team
- ↳ Reich to meet w/ Kasselbaum on Monday

- Kasselbaum willing to give some on Governance, STW, not much else
- Kennedy, Padd, Kasselbaum, DeWine, Abrams supposedly to work on At-risk-youth block grant. This is a disaster for us -- Pitts & Co. vs. Samuels vs. against each other
- Customer - Responsiveness amendment --
- National Activities Amendment - Padd - Defeat
