Federal Spending¹ on the Mid-West Flood Recovery

- Through June 1994, Federal agencies report obligations totalling \$5.1 billion in the nine states affected by the flood. During the third fiscal quarter \$0.4 billion was obligated. The four states receiving the most money so far are: Iowa (\$1,199 million); Minnesota (\$970 million); Missouri (\$875 million); and Illinois (\$552 million). Each of the nine states has received commitments totalling at least \$228 million.
- The largest sources of funds committed so far have come from the following agencies: USDA, \$2,712 million (mainly for crop losses); FEMA, \$946 million (for emergency public and individual assistance); SBA, \$536 million (loans to individuals and businesses); HUD, \$322 million (CDBG and HOME program grants); the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, \$134 million (levee repair); and the Department of Transportation, \$150 million (for highways and railroads). A total of 16 Federal agencies are involved directly.
- Through the end FY 1994, Federal agencies project that \$5.9 billion will be obligated. Over the last 3 months of the fiscal year, agencies project that \$818 million will be obligated. USDA accounts for much of this (\$303 million); and HUD (\$178 million), the Corps of Engineers (\$125 million), the Department of Education (\$70 million) and the Economic Development Administration (\$62 million) would provide most of the rest. Some agencies project spending into FY 1995.
- Iowa, Missouri, Minnesota and Illinois together are projected to receive most (over 65%) of the direct Federal assistance.
- Of the totals projected through FY 1994, USDA is projected to provide over half of the assistance; FEMA 17%; SBA 9%; HUD 9%; and the other 13 agencies each providing 5% or less. USDA projects the bulk (two thirds or more) of the assistance in Minnesota, South Dakota, Wisconsin, and North Dakota; and over half of the assistance in Iowa and Nebraska.

¹ Federal spending obligations include outlays for which obligations have not been recorded previously plus outlay precursors such as orders placed, contracts awarded, services received and similar transactions that require outlays during the same or future period. This does not include indirect spending (e.g., Federal income maintenance programs), nor changes in Federal tax liabilities (i.e., losses claimed against 1992 or 1993 taxes).
