Dear Senator Breaux:

I am writing in response to your recent letter regarding the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) affordable housing program. You indicated that several constituents had expressed concern that OMB is considering a proposal to fund this program out of resources of the FDIC's Bank Insurance Fund (BIF), rather than through General Fund appropriations.

The President's budget, which was transmitted to Congress on February 7th, does not propose using BIF resources to cover the cost of the FDIC affordable housing program. Instead, we have proposed a General Fund discretionary appropriation of \$15 million for the program.

Thank you for contacting OMB. My staff and I appreciate hearing the public's views on these important issues.
