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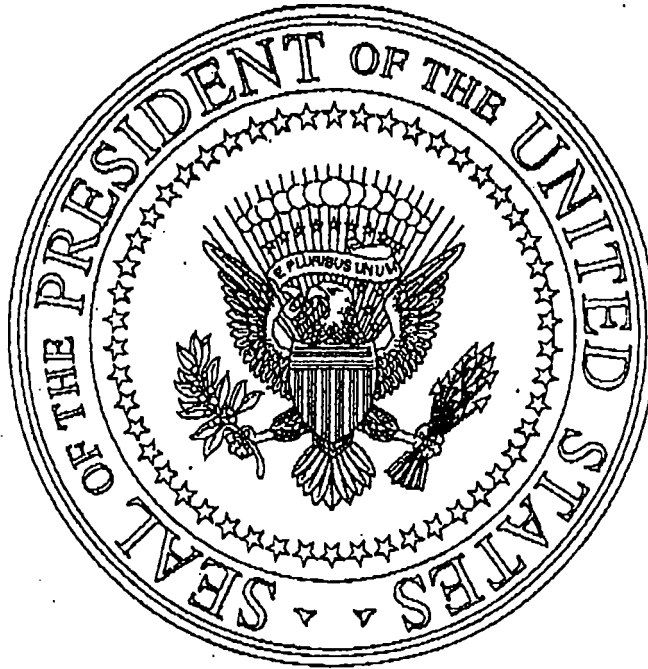

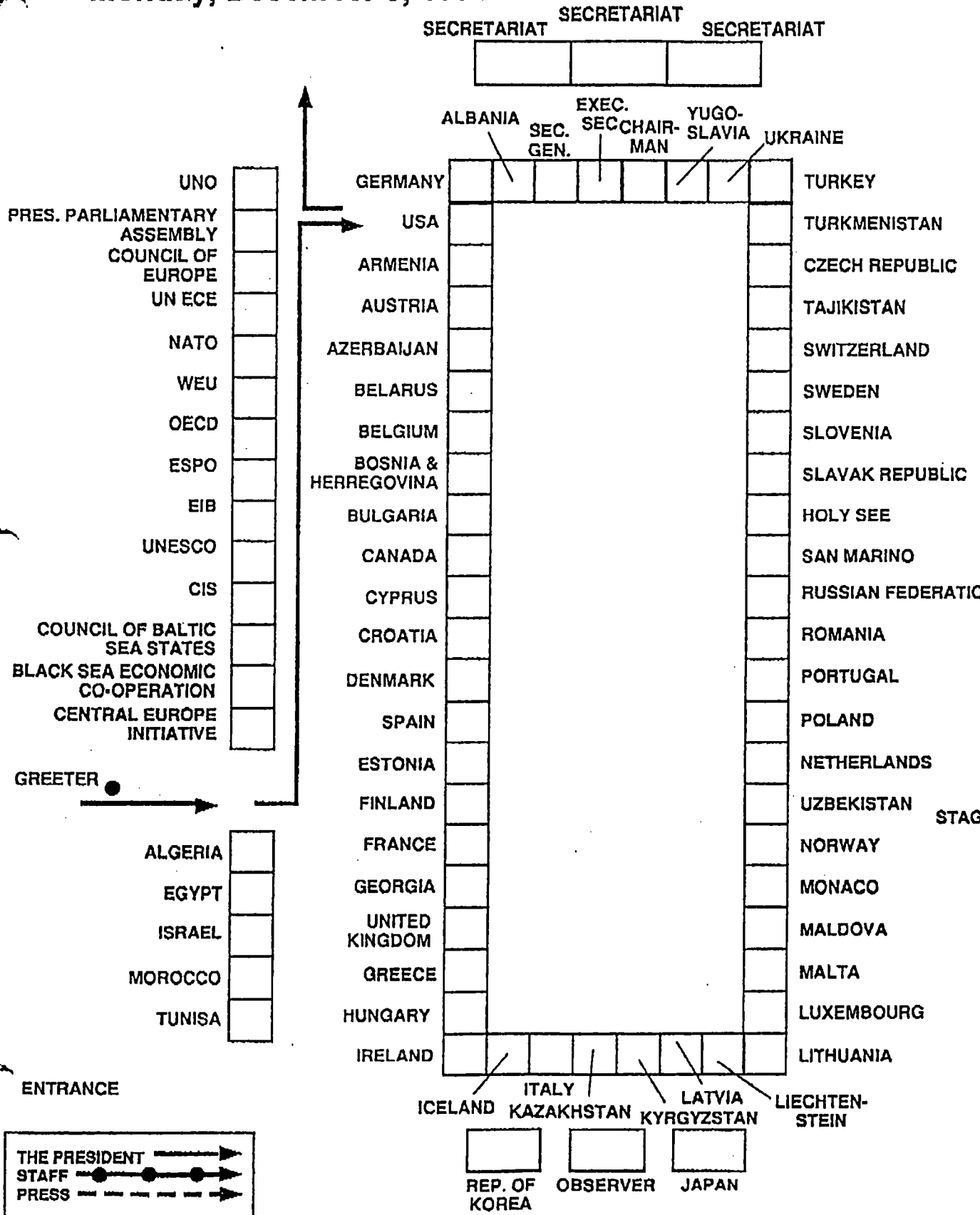

Presidents Clinton, Yeltsin and Kuchma and Prime Minister Major proceed to signing table and sign the memorandum on security assurances for Ukraine. (Each principal signs four documents). Presidents Clinton, Yeltsin and Kuchma and Prime Minister Major stand and return to their positions behind the table (toe cards).

(President Kuchma will provide the Presidents of Russia and the US and the PM of the UK with Ukraine's instrument of accession to the NPT)

President Kuchma presents Ukraine's instrument of NPT accession to Presidents Clinton, Yeltsin and Prime Minister Major as leaders of the three NPT depository states.

(Ladies and gentlemen, Presidents Kuchma, Clinton and Yeltsin and PM Major are releasing a joint declaration on Europe. Copies of the declaration will be available later)

All shake hands. President Kuchma exits the stage.

After signing, they stand and shake hands. Presidents Lukashenko, Clinton and Yeltsin and Prime Minister Major exit the stage.

(The Presidents of the five Lisbon Protocol signatory states will now sign a Protocol of Exchange of Instruments of Ratification for the START Treaty)
