SUBJECT: Request for Air Support for
Reverend Jesse Jackson

In support of the President's foreign policy objectives in Africa, the Special Envoy for the President and Secretary of State for Democracy in Africa, Reverend Jesse Jackson, will travel to Kenya and Zambia from November 29 to December 5, 1997.

Kenya faces difficult parliamentary and presidential elections before the end of 1997. Reverend Jackson's primary objective is to encourage fair elections and the constitutional reform process. In Zambia, the October 28 coup reflects a serious erosion of democracy. Reverend Jackson will engage in discrete discussions with Zambian president Chiluba concerning human rights and democratic reform.

Request you make available a military aircraft on a non-reimbursable basis to transport Reverend Jackson during this mission. Per Leon Fuerth, the President told the Vice President that he supports this request.
