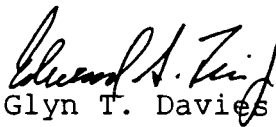

NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCILSUBJECT: Request for Presidential Mission Status and
Support for Special Envoy Reverend Jesse Jackson

In furtherance of the President's foreign policy initiatives, Reverend Jesse Jackson, Special Envoy of the President and the Secretary of State for the Promotion of Democracy in Africa, will travel to Togo, Central African Republic, and Ethiopia during the period of May 13 through 19, 1998. Reverend Jackson will visit Togo in a run-up to elections, and will encourage President Eyadema to ensure that the electoral process is as free and fair as possible. He will also meet with members of civil society. In Central African Republic we want him to deliver to President Patasse a tough message about adhering to peacekeeping time frames, now that an international mechanism is in place in that country. In Ethiopia, Rev. Jackson will deliver a speech on human rights and democracy and will hold meetings with leaders across the political spectrum.

Because of the importance of this visit in advancing U.S. foreign policy objectives, and because there are no scheduled commercial flights within Africa that meet the mission's needs, the Department requests that a Special Air Missions aircraft for the Special Envoy and a party of three be provided from Europe on a non-reimbursable basis. Rev. Jackson will be accompanied by two employees of the Rainbow-PUSH Coalition and one State Department officer; it is possible that another State Department official will join the party en route.
