TEXT:

Reggie White, All Pro NFL Football Player for the Green Bay Packers, a board member of the President's Community Development Financial Institutions Fund, and an ordained minister, called me today about the church-burnings across the country. Reggie's church in Tennessee was burned down last year. He has met the President and the Vice President, and served on a panel of the President's Economic Conference last year in Atlanta.

Reggie is coming to town on June 9th and 10th along with the National Council of Churches of Christ USA. They supposedly have a meeting with the Attorney General, but would like to also speak to the President and VP briefly. I know the President's schedule is very tight and he probably does not have time, unless you feel it is in his interest to meet with Reggie, who has a very high profile.

I know you are trying to coordinate the Administration's response to the burnings and I wanted to know if you felt a meeting between the President and Reggie was appropriate. If not, I will try and redirect him and ensure that the Attorney General meets with him. I promised to call him back early next week. What is your recommendation?

Thanks.

SUBJECT: Church Fires

Earlier today, Paul Weinstein, Kevin Varney and the two of us met with Vickie B. Tassan, a Senior Vice President with NationsBank, to discuss ways to respond to the epidemic level of African

-American church burnings in the South. As you know, NationsBank has pledged up to \$500,000 for information leading to convictions in church burning cases. Ms. Tassan informed us that the Bank is looking to increase their role in helping to rebuild these churches. Serving as a convener for corporations to help rebuild the churches and taking the lead in organizing corporations to express their concern over this disturbing trend are two ways NationsBank is interested in getting involved.

NationsBank's actions are going to take place with or without Administration involvement. But the Administration has a real chance here to play an important role in the private

sector's response and, in doing so, build upon the President's corporate citizenship challenge. We also have the opportunity to draw a number of diverse groups together -- from corporate CEO's to professional athletes -- to help raise money to rebuild the damaged churches and to express their concern about the fires.

Of the ideas discussed this morning, establishing a toll

-free 1

-800 number for the general public to contribute money towards the rebuilding of the churches seemed the most feasible and easily accomplished. It is currently estimated that \$3 million will be needed to restore the 33 damaged churches.

A number of organizations are currently involved in fund

-raising efforts. We felt that if NationsBank could establish an account to consolidate these funds, they could then reach out to a number of different sources for contributions. These would include, but not be limited to individuals, corporations, the professional sports industry, and various religious organizations throughout the nation. The President would be involved in spearheading a challenge for these groups to come together to donate time, resources, and money towards a unified effort.

Elgie will be in contact with Vickie Tassan as they are planning to discuss possible actions at NationsBank today and tomorrow. We are waiting for them to get back to us with some more concrete possibilities so that we can discuss our options in more detail. Obviously, the sooner we can nail down our plan the better. But we want to make sure we do so with your blessing.

Does this tack fit in with your plans? We want to make sure that we are aiding this effort, not confusing the process. Please give us guidance as to whether to proceed or to pull the plug.

SUBJECT: Church Fires

It looks like all activity on church fires is rapidly progressing at a level above my paygrade, so I just wanted to braindump what I know, make sure you are aware of a couple of issues and let you take it from here.

There are two principle issues that NEC staff have touched upon: corporate involvement in responding to the fires and pulling the insurance community into the issue.

The President's leadership in coordinating corporate sector involvement would serve as an excellent followup to his corporate citizenship event. The President could congratulate corporate America for viewing their role as broader than looking after their bottom line. He could note that some corporate leaders recognize that their employees are affected by these disturbing acts. NationsBank has already received positive press for being a responsible corporate leader for their rapid reponse to the problem (see attachment 1). I recommend that we find a way to include them in the process when we create a response structure.

The insurance issue is not as developed as far as I know. Kathleen Wallman asked the NEC to think about ways to involve the insurance industry, both in the rebuilding effort and in loss prevention. Most of the burned churches were either underinsured or uninsured (see attachment 2). Helping the burned churches may not be in the insurance industry's best financial interest, but

their must be some creative way to involve them. I have had some conversations with Cheri Carter and Flo McAfee on both the NationsBank and insurance issues.

Let me know if there is anything you need. From the looks of things, it appears you know where you want this to go.

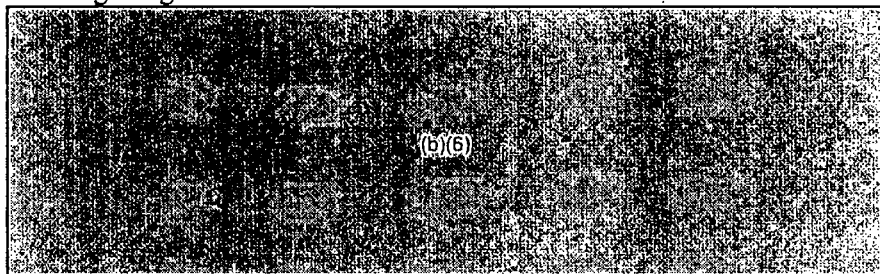

H.R. 3525 - Church Arson Prevention Act
(Hyde (R) Illinois and 79 cosponsors)

The Administration strongly supports House passage of H.R. 3525. Religious freedom is one of the founding principles of our democracy, and it is imperative that attacks upon that freedom do not go unpunished. This bill is a bipartisan effort to remove unduly restrictive statutory requirements in 18 U.S.C. ?247 that currently inhibit the prosecution of persons who destroy or deface religious property. The Administration unequivocally supports that effort.

H.R. 3525 will make victims of Section 247 violations eligible for compensation from the Crime Victims Fund. The Administration also strongly supports that effort. The bill should be construed, consistent with the Establishment Clause of the First

Amendment, to require States participating in the Fund to offer compensation to individuals injured by violations of the Federal law, and for the Federal Government to provide matching funds for that purpose. The bill should not be construed to require or permit participating States or the Federal Government to provide monetary grants to pervasively sectarian institutions or for religious uses.

The following is an update on NEC initiatives and policy development efforts:

School Construction: NEC staff completed work on the school construction initiative for the President's announcement on Thursday.

Church Burnings: NEC staff worked with the Vice President's Office toward a very successful meeting with the insurance industry on July 11. At the meeting, the industry assured the Vice President that no house of worship damaged by arson would go without insurance, and agreed to several other initiatives, including free on

-site arson inspections and fire prevention education, an arson information reward hotline, and an insurance issues/problems hotline. Companies that had cancelled or non

-renewed policies after an arson fire described what steps they had taken and were taking to prevent that from happening again.

Puerto Rico: NEC staff worked with members of the Interagency Working Group on Puerto Rico to develop an Administration position regarding the political status bill recently passed out to the House Resources Committee. The bill prescribes the process for the residents of Puerto Rico to vote on whether to remain a Commonwealth or to opt for independence or statehood. A major concern with the bill is that the process appears to be biased against retaining current commonwealth status (for instance, by requiring a new vote on status every four years if commonwealth is chosen). Moreover, the bill's ballot process could result in statehood being chosen even if this is not the most favored alternative for a plurality of Puerto Rican voters.

Pensions: The Small Business Tax Bill that passed the Senate

includes a managers' amendment that -- with help from the NEC working group on pensions -- includes a significant part of the

President's pension program. A number of items of interest to the multiemployer plan community that had been left out of the House and Finance Committee bills were included -- a doubling of the guarantee level, reduction of the vesting period from 10 to 5 years, and protection of benefits for long

-service moderate

-wage
employees -- and the

Administration's portability and missing participants proposals were also included. While the minimum wage clearly led the day, this was a big victory for another Presidential initiative. We are starting to work with Ways and Means Democrats to ensure retention of what we achieved in the managers' amendment.

Natural Disasters: NEC attended the Natural Hazards Conference and spoke on insurance issues relating to natural disasters. The Senate Commerce Committee will hold a hearing on the latest version of the Natural Disaster Protection Act on July 18. A Treasury witness will testify. The NEC is coordinating the testimony.

DoD Privatization and Base Closures: NEC staff spent four days visiting military bases in California that are being closed (Mare Island Shipyard, Treasure Island, Alameda Naval Air Station, Oakland Army Hospital, Mather Air Force Base, Sacramento Army Depot and Long Beach Naval Shipyard) or privatized in place (McClellan Air Force Depot in Sacramento). Staff met with the mayors of Long Beach and Vallejo, and took part in a press event that got coverage throughout the Bay Area (NEC and DoD officials, together with Mayor of Vallejo and Warner Brothers officials, kicked off the filming of Michael Crichton's novel, "Sphere," at Mare Island).

The Administration's efforts to improve the base reuse process have led to a significant improvement, but there is still a long way to go: the military services still make it far too difficult for communities to redevelop these huge and potentially valuable pieces of property, through unnecessary delay, penny

-pinching and
rigid interpretation of laws and regulations. Too often, conflicts have to be resolved at the political level.
The President will do an event at McClellan Air Force Depot on July 23 to announce a series of high

-tech projects and progress
on privatization; NEC staff is working with DoD on getting the

pieces (funding, property conveyances, etc.) for that event in place. There is considerable follow

-up on other California base issues as well, particularly in Long Beach, Los Angeles and San Diego. NEC staff met w/ Rep. Filner regarding a controversial closure issue in San Diego.

Aerospace Negotiations with Russia/Gore

-Chernomyrdin: NEC staff worked with USTR and Commerce to prepare for consultations with the Russians on market access for U.S. aircraft. Gore and Chernomyrdin signed a market access agreement in January, but the Russians have been slow to implement it; this week's consultations yielded the first concrete results. Gore will site this in his talks with Chernomyrdin and perhaps push for additional concessions.

Fund for Rural America: NEC staff will convene a group to come up with an approach/ideas for implementing the Fund for Rural America -- a \$300 million appropriation that was part of the Farm Bill. The NEC developed the Administration's Farm Bill guidance on rural economic development, and this is an opportunity to put that guidance into practice. In addition, the lessons from key Administration technology programs (ATP and TRP) and economic development initiatives (EZs/ECs) are relevant: e.g., competition and cost

-sharing is essential; and small amounts of federal money can have a substantial catalytic effect.

National Church Arson Task Force Report: On October 22, the National Church Arson Task Force, jointly directed by Treasury and DOJ, issued its Second Year Report. In 1995, the President established the Task Force to address a sharp increase in the number of arson attacks against houses of worship. Since the inception of the Task Force, arson attacks have decreased from a high of 297 in 1996 to an estimated 170 in 1998, a 57 percent drop. To date, 670 cases have been opened resulting in the arrest of 308 suspects in connection with 230 investigations. This represents a 35 percent arrest rate--more than double the 16 percent arrest rate for other arson crimes. The report is being distributed to major news organizations, and Under Secretary Johnson met with members of the press to discuss the report and the ongoing efforts of the Task Force.
