And remember, all this is being accomplished by a man who was elected two years ago by only 43% of the people. He didn't exactly arrive in Washington with a ringing mandate. (That's a number to bear in mind when reading polls about his popularity. When "only" 45% of the nation think he's doing a good job, that's an increase from the percentage that elected him.)

So, why is he getting all this guff?

Because of blunderbusses on the radio and dunderheads in his administration.

The blunderbusses — the first blunderbusses were guns that made a lot of noise and were capable only of random firing, and can you think of a better word to describe today's talk-show hosts?

Anyway, starting over ... The blunderbusses simply are wealthy cynics whose livelihoods would disappear if people felt good about this country and this president. So, on their radio talk shows, they fire noisily and randomly at anyone and anything linked to the president. They give a skewed picture of America and America's mood. If they reflected reality — conceded that things probably were better right now than at any time since the days of Dwight Eisenhower — they'd have no jobs.

The dunderheads don't help. They're

like the gang that couldn't shoot straight. They dominate the headlines and dilute the good news by their antics. The administration, ever since it was elected, has been plagued by mini-scandals. Now the agriculture secretary is caught cadging sports tickets.

So, in truth, the president's friends are as damaging to him as his enemies are.

And, then, there's Whitewater, the thing nobody understands, and sex, the thing everybody understands. Those divert our attention and diminish the man.

In truth, too, there still are too many poor people, and homeless people, and addicted people, and jobless people in this country. Some test scores are falling, and some social programs are failing. Life is far from perfect.

But it never is perfect. And if you can look behind the headlines, if you can peer around the scandals, if you can see through the radio haze, you will discover that things are pretty good in this country right now.

Don't you think you should thank President Clinton?

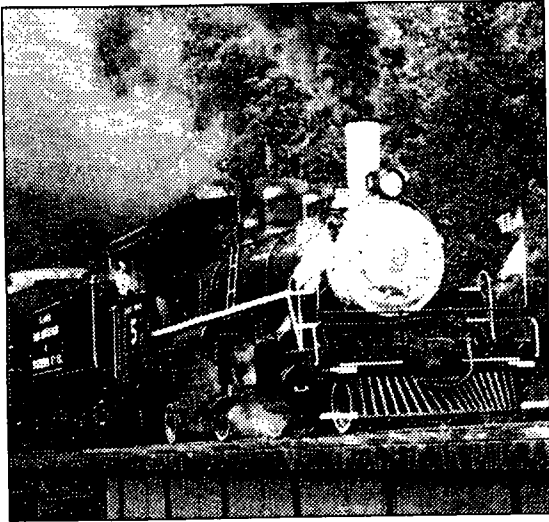

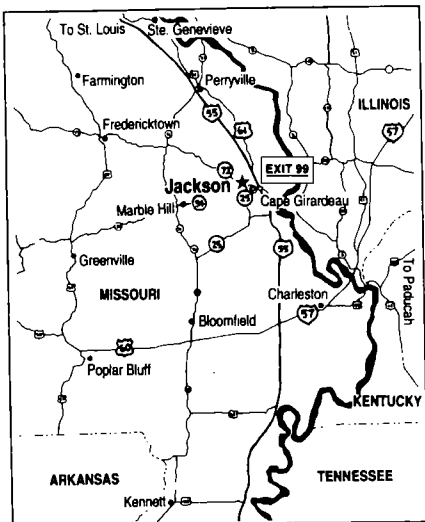
