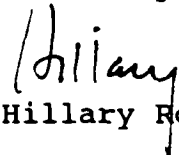
Your caring and thoughtful note meant so much to me. Our friends continue to be an enormous source of encouragement, support and strength -- we are richly blessed and deeply grateful.

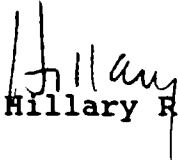
Dear Lillian:

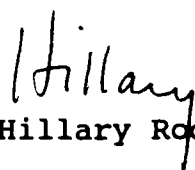
Dear Representative Darden:
