The health care reform package will provide that every American citizen and legal resident receives the basic benefits package. The President is still reviewing provision of coverage to other groups. But please be assured that no individual will lose health care services currently available.

I am sorry I was unable to meet with the governors of the U.S. Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands as you suggested. 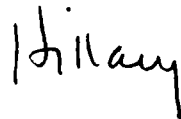
Dear Representative De Lugo:
