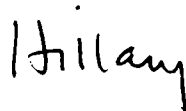
Dear Representative Murphy:

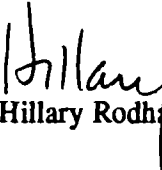

Dear Mrs. Clinton:

I am writing to invite you to testify at a hearing of the Subcommittee on Labor Standards, Occupational Health and Safety. The subject of the hearing will be the impact of the President's Health Security Act on federal and state workers' compensation programs.

The Health Security Act is one of the Education and Labor Committee's highest priorities for the coming year. I believe this hearing will be a valuable opportunity to bring the details of this important aspect of health care reform closer to consumers, business operators, health care professionals and state officials, upon whom the success of the plan will ultimately depend.

I intend to conduct this hearing during the third or fourth week of February, 1994, in my Congressional district, in southwestern Pennsylvania. I would be happy to accommodate your busy schedule by selecting a date during this period that would best suit you. Historic Washington & Jefferson College, in Washington, Pennsylvania, will make its facilities available to us for this event.

If time permits, we may be able to schedule other proponents of this legislation to testify as well. I would welcome your suggestions in that regard. Opponents will be afforded the opportunity to testify at a later hearing in Washington, D.C.

I look forward to working with you on this issue.
