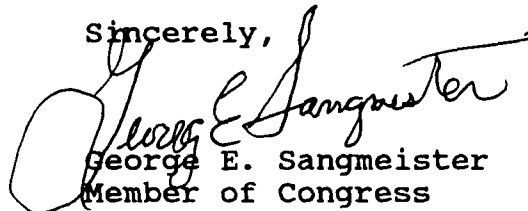
Dear Mrs. Clinton:
