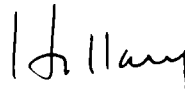

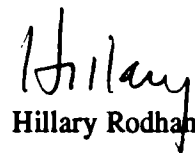
Dear Representative Strickland:

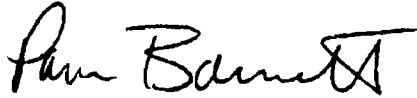
