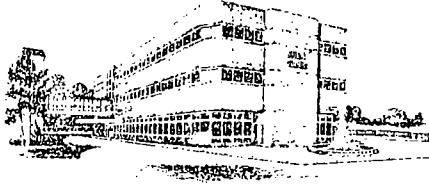

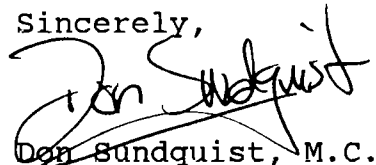
I would be pleased and honored to include your thoughts in my presentation December 17. It need not be lengthy. A few sentences or a paragraph would be much appreciated and gratefully received.
