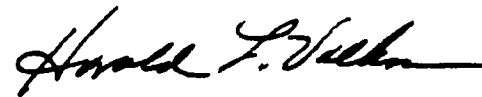

I don't know your address but I am going to try getting this letter to you.

I don't know it will do me any good except to get some of my worries on paper.

I am a white female, 50 yrs old. Divorced twice. Three sons grown and on their own. I have one grand son.

Quite school after ninth grade at sixteen, went to work to help my family who was on SSI at the time. Three sister and one brother went on and finished high school.

I have worked lots of odd job only one good job in my life. I worked at a local brick plant only to be laid off when the world economy slowed. Seven years on a good job and now that is lost for good. They won't hire with out a high school education.

at the time I am writing this

letter, I live with my son, who isn't working either.

our electric and gas has been shut off for non payment. The rent is 3 months past due. and if we don't come up with some money we have to get out this month.

I have an old car (78 ford) not worth much. The license is out in May and it won't pass inspection is time.

Last fall I made an application to G.A.M.M. but they can't find a place for me.

I make applications 2-3 times a week somewhere but every body else does too. I even answer ads, but my lack of transportation and education hasn't found me any work yet.

we have been off food stamps for two

months, but will get them back on May 16th. In the mean time we have been hitting up forest pantrys every where we can.

When we get our forest stamps we can buy food. But it will have to be already cooked, & we don't have a place to cook when we do cook we have to go to a park on river front and build a fire.

Right now we can't do that we don't have any change to buy gas for the car. And soon the license on the car will be out and we will have to junk it out.

I hope you can read this. My glass came from Walworts about three years ago. I need new glasses but haven't figured out how to get them. Besides my arthritis is bothering me this damp weather and my hands cramp a lot.

Here in Missouri it has done nothing but rained for 2 fortnights

how long. Two months I guess.

The weather makes me sort of blue. When the sun shined I can and do pick up aluminum cans along the road ways as far as I can walk in one day.

I have went to a lot of trouble to write this letter I am desperate at this time as to what to do now.

I have no place to go and it seems I don't qualify for help any where.

I am too old for one kind of help and too young for another.

May be you can suggest something for me to do.

I am willing to try doing any thing. I will move if I have to. But it will have to be somewhere I can set up a tent and walk to where I am going.

I have heard of homeless people before, but did not know what it felt like. But now I know I can see why there is so much crime in the world. I haven't went to crime yet, but I am about to lose my sanity. I think the worse part is not being able to take a bath and put on clean clothes. I have enough clothes they just aren't clean or more. and I don't have any hot water for a bath.

When we had hot water I took a bath every day. Now I am lucky to get a bath any time.

I have made it this far with the help of a few friends but the givings are about to run out.

I guess I have about said enough. I would like to hear from you with any suggestion you might have.

I will keep trying but I do need a little encouragement. Maybe there is ~~no~~ something to look forward to that I don't know about.

type things.

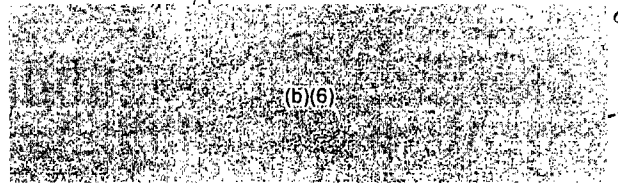
But I don't picture an old

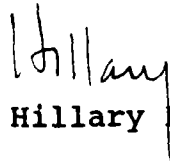
