The President remains firmly committed to continuing the fight to guarantee that every American has health insurance and to get health care costs under control. 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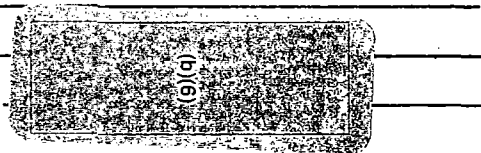
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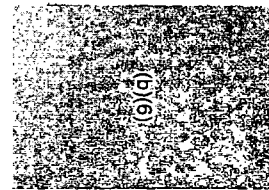
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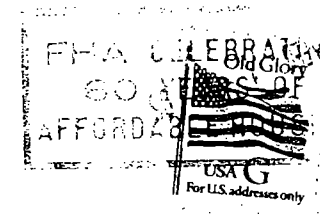
