

It's time to hold America accountable for policies that leave children
at the mercy of poverty, abuse and violence

TAKING A STAND



EVERY 45 SECONDS A BLACK CHILD drops out of school. Every 50 seconds a Black child is arrested. Every two minutes a Black baby is born into poverty. Every six minutes a Black baby is born at a low birth weight. Every four hours a Black child is killed by gunfire. Our children are hurting. They are the front-line casualties in a war they cannot fight alone. We adults must fight it with them and for them.

Since 1979, more than 50,000 children have been killed by gunfire in our homes, schools and neighborhoods. Although we are the world's leading military power, we stand by, silent and indifferent, and we cut after-school programs that give them positive alternatives to the streets. About every day and a half, gun violence kills as many children as the 13 who were killed in 1995's tragic Oklahoma City bombing. In the richest nation in history, a child dies from poverty every 53 minutes, and children are the poorest group of Americans.

For all of America's talk about family values, we have turned our backs on the

real needs of families for jobs, decent wages, child care and health care. We tolerate a child welfare system that abuses and neglects children already abused and neglected by their families. While we bemoan a few victims of child abuse, such as Susan Smith's young sons and little Elisa Izquierdo in New York City, we do not mend our cracked child welfare system that lets an abused child die every seven hours.

How much more suffering, death and neglect must children endure before parents, grandparents, and religious, civic, community and political leaders stand up and say, "Enough," with our hearts, voices and votes to protect our children, who are our sacred trust and collective American future?

When Jesus Christ invited little children to come unto Him, He did not invite only rich, middle-class, White male children without disabilities from two-parent families, or our own children, to come. He welcomed all children. There are no illegitimate children in God's sight. Yet every day, too many of us fail our responsibility toward our own children and those of millions of other people.

It is not just poor or minority children who are afflicted by the breakdown of moral, family and community values today. Every American child is threatened by the pollution of our airwaves, environment and values; growing economic insecurity among middle-class and young families; rampant drug and alcohol abuse; teen pregnancy and domestic violence among rich, middle-class and poor alike; AIDS; random gun and terrorist violence; resurging racial intolerance in our places of learning, work and worship; and the crass, empty materialism of too much of our culture. "Affluenza" is a more dangerous malady than influenza for millions of American children.



HE STRESSES AND STRAINS of making a living leave too many parents too little time with their children. Many parents are more preoccupied with material than with eternal things, with fun rather than faithfulness in providing the family rituals, continuity and consistent companionship children need to grow up healthy, caring, loving and productive. Parenting itself is not a valued calling, and people who care for children get the least support in America. Too many neighbors look out for just themselves and take little or no interest in one another's children. Too many business people seem to forget they are parents and family members and treat children as consumers to whom they can market violent, sexually charged messages and products that they would not want their own children to see or use. And too many faith communities fail to provide the strong moral leadership parents and communities need to meet their shared responsibilities to children.

In 1996, Americans will make nation-defining, moral, economic and social choices. The Congress and the president will decide whether to end or weaken the role of our national government as protector of last resort for children, the poor and the disabled, while maintaining and increasing federal support for the non-needy and widening the gap between the haves and have-nots by slashing tens of billions of dollars from crucial health, income-maintenance and early-childhood assistance programs in order to provide tax breaks for wealthy corporations and individuals. While raising taxes on the working poor, national leaders would continue to exempt the Pentagon, corporate welfare recipients and millions of non-needy



Americans from their fair sacrifice in balancing the budget and ensuring our children's well-being.

The current budget-balancing debate is not about money. It is about values, ideology, national direction and the ideals of fairness and morality we seek to reflect and pass on to our children.

Have we Americans become so allergic to sharing, caring and sacrifice that we will continue to sit back mute and stand by apathetically when our leaders make decisions that mock the prophets, the Gospel and basic fair play? Have we become so spiritually dead that the morally unthinkable killing and maiming of children is acceptable? Will we let powerful lobbyists trample powerless children and corporate welfare grow at the expense of child welfare? Do we believe massive back-end

investment in prisons and punishment is preferable to front-end investment in prevention and early intervention? Does it make sense for the Pentagon to spend between \$30 million to \$35 million an hour when the internal enemies of poverty, violence, neglect and abuse are killing our children every day? Is America more about providing hope and opportunity or about providing "Mortal Kombat" and the "Power Rangers" toys for our young?

Regardless of our point of view, we need to be informed if we are going to stand up for our children.

Imagine two houses. One is a small house at the seat of our national government. President Franklin Roosevelt began constructing it over six decades ago to make sure America's children, poor and other vulnerable citizens would be guaranteed a floor of decency, regardless of the state or family they chanced to be born in. One of its four basic rooms is a family support room with Aid to Families with Dependent Children, child care to help mothers get off and stay off welfare, Supplemental Security Income for families with disabled children and the Earned Income Tax Credit to help poor working families get out of poverty and to make work pay. A majority of the families residing in this room have children, are White and have a parent in the labor market, but Black children are disproportionately affected.

While the family supports in the room never were designed to lift all its residents out of poverty or to close the gaps in the economy for all those left behind, over the decades they have kept the wolves of hunger and homelessness at bay for millions of poor families and helped many mothers and children escape domestic violence.

The second room is for child and family nutrition; more than 25 million of its occupants are children. School lunches, child care and Head Start programs reside here. Construction of this room began in 1948 with school lunches, and it was expanded significantly during the Nixon years, virtually eradicating child and family hunger in America in the 1970s.

The third room is for health care, primarily Medicaid, on which 20 million poor children depend for immunizations and prenatal and primary health care. One in three newborns, almost one in three preschoolers and one in two Black children depend on Medicaid health coverage. Here also reside the poor elderly and disabled persons and others who need long-term and nursing home care. A majority of Medicaid children have a parent who works outside the home and are White.

The fourth room is for children in danger of neglect and abuse, whose families are at risk of breaking down, or already have done so, and require the help of our overburdened child welfare system. About 3 million children need a safe haven in this room.

THE ROOMS in this house cannot accommodate all who are in need of help. More than 15 million American children, or one in five, are still poor. One in eight lacks health coverage, and millions more lack adequate child care. Some of the rooms need renovation and some need expansion, but the people who live here do not have a lot of money, power or ability to lobby for their needs. Since a majority of residents are children, they are particularly unable to voice their needs.

Now imagine a much bigger house at the seat of our national government alongside the smaller house. In this house live Americans who are not poor or disabled. Its occupants can hire lots of people to keep their house in good shape and even

add to it. This house has rooms that cost taxpayers a lot more. Its furnishings include \$600 billion of entitlements indexed for the cost of living for 48 million Americans, most with incomes above the poverty level; indeed, \$81 billion a year goes to 6 million Americans with incomes of \$50,000 or more. It houses welfare subsidies and tax breaks for big corporations, rich farmers and ranchers and wealthy individuals that total about \$100 billion a year. The Pentagon and its contractors live here, too. Congress recently gave them a \$6.9 billion bonus they did not request.

 MOST OF THE occupants in this house have not been asked to contribute much toward balancing the budget, although they cost taxpayers three times more than the occupants in the smaller house. In fact, 50 percent of this house has been exempted from budget cuts, including corporate welfare recipients, Social Security and military pensioners and the Pentagon.

Now imagine our political leaders saying they want to balance the budget. What was the first step they took in 1995? They voted a \$229 billion tax cut for many of the people in the big house and paid for it by cutting \$228 billion from the children and families in the little house. President Clinton wants to give a tax cut of \$87 billion, although he, like Congress, understands that someone has to pay for it, someone without much money or power.

Americans will have to decide whether a big tax cut, or any tax cut, for non-needy citizens makes sense while our leaders say we cannot pay our bills or afford to feed and educate our children. Is it credible for any congressional leader to argue they are protecting children from a future debt children did not create by destroying the vital laws and investments children need to live, learn and grow today? This is the domestic equivalent of bombing Vietnamese villages in order to save them.

Although the unjust budget cuts directed at poor children and families are six to seven times worse than Reagan-era cuts, they are not the most serious battle children face in the multifront budget war.

The massive cuts are like stealing the furniture from our children's rooms and knocking big holes in their walls and roof. But through block grants, congressional leaders seek to permanently bulldoze our children's house, remove it from the seat of national government and consciousness and disperse responsibility for American children out to 50 states with billions of dollars less and no safeguards for children. Pending block grants have been wrapped in attractive slogans like welfare reform, state flexibility, getting government closer to the people and decreasing teen and out-of-wedlock births — all goals I share. But when you unwrap the box and examine its contents, as citizens in a democracy must do, you find a cruel gift to children struggling to beat the odds.

The governors would, through block grant proposals introduced this year, bulldoze the smaller house where so many Black children live and cut safety-net protections by tens of billions of dollars. They do not ask the people in the bigger house to sacrifice anything.

So what we Americans stand for and do now as parents — and encourage our political leaders to stand for and do in this last national election year of the century — will shape our nation's fate and our children's futures in the next century and millennium. It is time to ask whether America truly values and will stand up for children, not just with words, but with work; not just with promises but with leadership and investment in

child health, early childhood education, after-school programs and family economic security; not just with a speech or photo opportunity, but with sustained positive commitment to meet the needs of children.

Americans will Stand For Children on June 1 at the Lincoln Memorial to rededicate ourselves personally, and as a national community, to children. It will be a day for parents and grandparents, aunts and uncles, brothers and sisters, students and educators, and Americans — not as Republicans or Democrats, Baptists or Methodists, Blacks or Whites or Latinos, poor or middle class — to unite in the common goal of improving the quality of life for all of America's children.

 F YOU ARE struggling to raise a child but know you could do better, come stand with us. If you are from a young or middle-income family working hard to make ends meet, come stand with us. If you are worrying about whether your child's school is preparing students for the 21st century, come stand with us. If you are anxious that your children will get sick and not get decent medical care because you lack health insurance, come stand with us. If you are lying awake nights concerned about your child's safety, come stand with us. If you've had enough of political leaders talking about family values while not supporting what families need to raise healthy, safe, moral and educated children, come stand with us on June 1.

Judy Lewis is one of the many thousands of people who will Stand For Children on June 1. She is leading a group of people from her tiny town of Hammond, Ind., to Washington, D.C. So far, Lewis has reserved a 49-passenger coach bus for the historic gathering. "I'm getting teachers and others who are interested.... Things are moving so fast that I can't believe it. Now we're thinking about ordering another bus," Lewis says.

After many years of working with girls at the Mayflower Teenage Home, Lewis says children are a cause worth marching for. "Our children are getting killed in the streets. Drugs and gangs are taking the place of family life. I keep telling people that all they have to do is light one little candle, and it will catch on. That's what we're going to do on June 1."

It Is Time To Stand For Children

Edelman says we all could learn something

from the city of Lynn, Mass. "A child was killed near a church," she told me. "It was a terrible tragedy. The minister and the church members got together and went down to City Hall and said, 'We need someplace for our children to go. We need to give them things to do.' But the City Council told them there was no money. So they read the city budget. They realized they could read it just like their church budget. They found places where they could make cuts and raise the money to fund recreation activities. They were doing what this whole nation has to do: standing up for children."

On Saturday, June 1, if Edelman has her way, this whole nation will do just that in a dramatically visible way. On this first national Stand for Children day, Edelman—president of the Children's Defense Fund—is planning to assemble many thousands of parents, grandparents, teachers, clergy and leaders in front of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, D.C. Police officers and pediatricians, nuns and nurses and families from around the country will come to the nation's capital for one reason: "We're going to send a message that we want to protect children," Edelman said, "and we want that message to be heard in the Capitol, in the White House, in every part of America."

I went to Washington to talk with Marian Wright Edelman and find out why the world's richest nation needs a special day to remember its children. It took her no time at all to reel off a list of reasons: "A child dies of neglect or abuse every seven hours," she said, "a child dies from gunshots every two hours—that's an entire grade-school class every other day. More than 9½ million children have no health insurance, and that number may go up to 19 million with corporate layoffs and government cutbacks. That's unacceptable."

"As a nation we pride ourselves on our commitment to family," Edelman added. "While every adult has a duty to every child, the role of parents is primary. But we also need to realize that parents can't do everything. Parents can't control it if their corporations downsize or move elsewhere. But the children are affected by this—they lose health care too, they lose their security. Parents are part of the communities we all live in. We can't go on acting as if they are an island. We have to get children

back to the center of the community."

Stand for Children, although it aims to get our nation's leaders thinking about kids—and acting—is not a partisan event. "Both Democrats and Republicans need to think about what we are doing to children in this country,"

Edelman said. As she pointed out, the government initiatives for children have come from both parties—from Harry Truman's school lunch program to Richard Nixon's nutrition programs for mothers and children. And, in the past two decades, they have been attacked by

both sides as well. "Children don't vote," Edelman said sadly. "I heard Gov. Roy Romer of Colorado say something very important the other day: He said we should all vote as if an 8-year-old was standing next to us in the booth."

Already, more than 1000 groups

around the nation—from the PTA to the Girl Scouts to the American Association of Retired Persons—have signed on as co-sponsors. "We want everybody to come to Washington and make a commitment to children," Edelman said. "We want them to take that commitment home to their families, churches, temples, mosques and communities and make it part of their daily lives."

How, I wondered, could each of us make that concrete commitment to children in our lives? Edelman told me about her own childhood as the daughter of a Baptist minister in rural South Carolina. "I grew up with adults who liked to share with children," she recalled. "There was love, a sense of community, even in hard times. Sometimes I would wake up in the morning and find a new child sharing my room. Sometimes I'd even share a pair of shoes."

That sense of obligation to children, Edelman argued, is what needs to be rekindled. "I'm talking about tutoring and mentoring and participating in the lives of children," she said. Her dream, she explained, is that every adult who attends Stand for Children day will go home and take an active part in making children's lives better. Even more important, she said, is that business and political leaders become aware of how their actions affect children. "It isn't enough not to hurt children," she said. "We have to begin thinking about helping them."

On June 1, the grounds of the Lincoln Memorial will be filled with Americans who have made an effort to be part of children's lives—and others who will soon begin to do so.

I spoke with Anne Dyson, a pediatrician from Schenectady, N.Y., who is

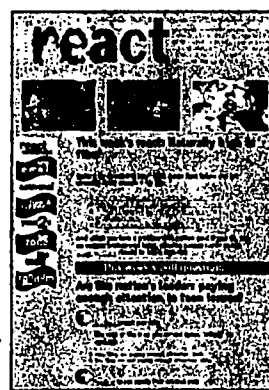

trician from Schenectady, N.Y., who is one of thousands of volunteers now helping to organize the event. "We see kids in our practices whose communities are not providing the nurturing and support all children need," Dr. Dyson told me. "Pediatricians are supporting Stand for Children because it's part of our job to be advocates for the children we care for." Arthur Pannell Jr., a police officer who works with young people in Washington, D.C., also is planning to Stand for Children on June 1. "This is a fantastic idea," he told me. "I hope it gets the support of organizations nationwide."

But it was Tiffany Padgett, 17, a Senior Girl Scout from Washington, D.C., who brought the message of Stand for Children home to me most eloquently. "I'm a teenager," she told me. "I know that there's a real need for programs and ideas in this country to help kids stay out of trouble and get ahead with their lives. But I think adults need to know that too, and that's why I'm participating in Stand for Children."

Marian Wright Edelman won't predict how many people will come to Stand for Children. "I'm not going to play a numbers game," she said, but she clearly hopes and prays that the turnout will be immense: "This can be a great moral moment for America."
