I want you and President Clinton to know how much we appreciate the way that your family tries to be more accessible to the public.

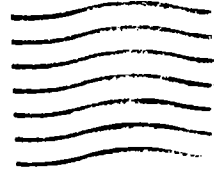
Again I thank you and your family for a wonderful Christmas memory.
