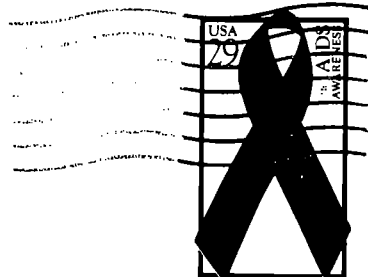
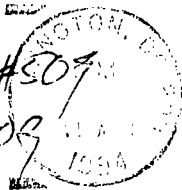
Thank you very much for taking care of the White House ticket for my family. They enjoyed the tour and were touched by your efforts.
