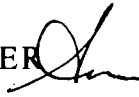

RE: FACES OF HOPE

Attached are Faces of Hope update memos that we prepared for the President in August 1994 and November 1994. We are currently working on an update for the President, Mrs. Clinton, the Vice President and Mrs. Gore that will be completed by Monday, June 5.

We have kept in contact with all of the Faces and have tried to be responsive to their needs and requests. Sue Hazard, our outside White House liaison to the Faces, has just recently been appointed Director of the White House Travel Office (official notice of appointment still pending). She has been spectacular and has kept me informed when Faces come to D.C. so we can arrange tours, photo ops when possible and include them in events that are pertinent to their concerns.

In addition, we have sent letters recognizing special events (retirements, sympathy, graduation etc) on behalf of the President and First Lady and all of the Faces receive Christmas cards from the First family each year. The comments I most often hear from Faces are "we know how busy the Clintons are and it is so nice that they still remember us, send us letters/cards, keep in touch through staff and want to have this reunion with us."

This is a very friendly group who adore the President and First Lady.

We will have an update for you as soon as possible -- we are calling each one of the Faces to get the most current information. In the meantime, please call if you have any questions or need additional information.

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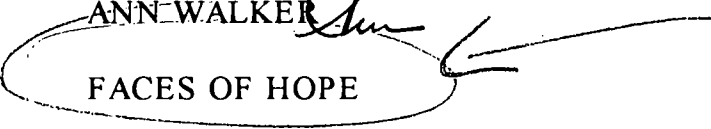

Attached is the updated briefing on the individuals who comprise the FACES OF HOPE. Each name is followed by the initials of the principal who identified the Face, the city and state where they reside and a brief description of how they came into contact with the principal. We then provide any additional background information, as well as information on the current status of the individual or family.

The last few pages of the briefing list those Faces who have passed away. Unfortunately, we lost four people: Josh Cox, Sheri Kohlenberg, Sarah Weber and most recently, Michael Quercio. Each will have a family member present at the luncheon: Josh's parents; Sheri's husband and son -- Larry and Sammy Goldman; Sarah's mother and sister -- Marie Kostos-Weber and Amy Weber; and Micheal's companion, Joseph Madison, will attend.

All of the Faces of Hope are excited and enthusiastic about the Reunion and are thrilled to have been invited. They are looking forward to seeing you, the President, the Vice President and Mrs. Gore. Over the past two and a half years they have written letters, sent Christmas and birthday cards, sympathy cards (when your father and mother-in-law mother passed), and called to offer words of encouragement in tough times. They have remained extremely loyal and supportive of you, the President and the Administration.

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## **FACES WHO HAVE PASSED ON**

### **Josh Cox**

In September 1992, Mrs. Gore met Angie Cox and her 12 year old son, Joshua, at Akron's Children Hospital. Joshua passed away in February of 1993 shortly after his return from the Inauguration.

Mr. and Mrs. Cox will be attending the reunion luncheon.

### **Sheri Kohlenberg**

Sheri Kohlenberg spoke with Mrs. Clinton on October 16, 1992 at a meeting organized by the Virginia Breast Cancer Foundation. For more than an hour Clinton met and listened to women like Kohlenberg, who have confronted their disease and its treatment. Kohlenberg was first diagnosed with breast cancer when her son, Sammy, was 18 months old. In July 1993, breast cancer took Sheri Kohlenberg's life.

Sheri's book, Sammy's Mom Has Cancer, won the Rose Kushner Award for excellence in the field of breast cancer research. Her husband Larry remains in contact with breast cancer advocates.

### **Michael Quercio**

Mr. Quercio met the President at the Park Plaza Diner in Boston in 1992. Mr. Quercio, who is HIV positive, is an advocate for HIV/AIDS education for school age children in Massachusetts. In April of 1994 Mr. Quercio called to let the President know he was speaking to several large university audiences on behalf of the President's health care plan and AIDS. The response was very good in each of his presentations.

Mr. Quercio passed away in April 1995 from complications of AIDS. Before his death, he spoke out for realistic AIDS education across the country.

### **Sarah Weber**

Sarah Weber passed away in July of 1993.

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
