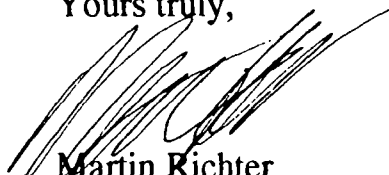

Mrs. Clinton,

The writing of this letter is probably quite presumptuous, but I have been waiting for others who were trying to make this presentation to you, and I feel that even though a personal presentation would be preferable, I would at least like for you to have the opportunity to see this new concept and product, ***The Woman's Health Journal***.

For more than fourteen years I have been researching, creating, designing, and trying to secure funding for this project. The first official public presentation was at *The American Public Health Association's* national convention in San Francisco last week, and the response was overwhelming.

At first, it was difficult for some to understand the concept of each of us maintaining our own health records. But, once the concept was understood, there was unanimous support.

I firmly believe that the greatest problem with the delivery of health care in this country is the irresponsibility of the consumer. If we go our lawyer's office, we take our legal papers. If we go to the accountant's, we take our receipts and information. We keep maintenance records for our cars, motorcycles and lawn mowers. We keep schedules for our vacations, business and children. But 95% or more of us keep absolutely no records of the most important of all, our health information. When was your last tetanus shot?

At present, the majority of us walk into our physician's office with no more than a smile and an attitude of "Fix me, I'm Stupid". We expect the doctor to have the interrogation skills necessary to ask the right questions, to extract from our limited memory all of the critical pieces of information, and then to arrive at the correct diagnosis.

Each diagnosis can only be as accurate at the information we provide. We cannot possibly remember details about our physical condition two days ago, let alone a month. The doctor is invariably short on time and long on patients, and consequently the verdict is given... "We'll try this, and if it doesn't work, come back in two weeks and we'll try that." Every person who has been to a doctor has heard that statement.

It is not inappropriate, and no one can blame a physician for wanting to cover his/her situation with an 'if/then' clause, ...but the cost is too great, in dollars and time, and it is a luxury the health care system cannot afford. An 'if-then' diagnosis means a second trip to the doctor, a second trip to the pharmacy, and twice as long a recovery period, all because we have failed to maintain the same records we keep for our cars.

The time for change is now. Each of us must immediately begin tracking our own health information, and taking that accurate information with us into the doctor's office. We must become an active partner in our health process. Of particular importance are the health histories of our parents and grandparents, and unless we ask the right questions and record the answers, much of that invaluable information will be lost. Hospital and physician records, on paper, microfiche, and computer, are regularly and automatically purged. There is not a system capable of maintaining all those records forever.

The Woman's Health Journal is the first medium in history to be specifically created and designed to record personal health information. Each of us will have different things we wish to track, and **The Journal** is the basic format for meeting those individual needs.

When we become informed health care consumers, and take the responsibility for our own information, we will be able to provide our physicians with accurate information. Having that accurate information will significantly shorten the interview/interrogation portion of each visit and increase the accuracy of each diagnosis, which in turn makes the prescription more accurate, and shortens each illness or discomfort.

We can no longer afford the time and cost of our own ignorance. Under the present system, we are not even allowed access our own medical files and information. That might have worked thirty years ago when the family doctor took care of grandparents, parents, and children, and kept most of the information in his head.

Now there are dozens of different kinds of health care providers, insurers, facilities, and needs, hundreds of specialties and a thousand sub-specialties. We are a mobile society, and each time we change cities or add a new physician, therapist, orthodontist, we become one more step removed from our critical information.

Perhaps my vision is to simplistic, but no one has yet presented a reasonable argument against it. In fact, most physicians and other health care providers think it will help them immensely.

Shared participation and patient responsibility are two of the critical keys to resolving our present health care dilemma. Fortunately, they are relatively easy to install, and relatively inexpensive to maintain. In fact, compared to the cost of a single extra visit to the physician, the means and the process are free!

I hope this letter and **The Woman's Health Journal** have piqued your interest and will receive your prompt consideration. Sooner or later, each of us will have to take responsibility for our own health information. The change is long overdue, and there is really no viable option. I hope you will become one of the catalysts for that change, if for no other reason than to save money.

Thank you for taking the time in this review, if, that is, this letter and **The Journal** will make it through the many people who proof and pre-screen your correspondence. I hope they are able to see the kernel of hope that comes with this vision.

Dear Hillary Rodham Clinton,

When I last spoke with Robert Barnett on the telephone back in the early part of the year, he suggested that I wait until you were finished with your report on health care and insurance reform before I contacted you again about the possibility of writing a book about you. Congratulations on putting together such a comprehensive and impressive package. It looks as if we might now have substantive change in this area of American life that has been begging for reform for so long.

If I may, I'd like to remind you of the idea for a book I want to write about you. Using as a model White's book on John Kennedy, *The Making of a President*, I want to write a book about your development as a public figure--as a lawyer, a children's rights advocate, a governor's wife, a *de facto* politician, and now the First Lady. This would not be a biography, although I would provide some biographical material on your youth and trace your career as a college and graduate student; instead, the book would be a long piece of journalism that would focus on your work as an advocate with the Children's Defense Fund, as one of the country's top attorneys on children's issues, and as a political figure who has gained a unique position of power.

Of course, the book must cover the job you are doing as First Lady. Already, by taking a leading position in the movement to reshape the health care and insurance systems in this country, you have revolutionized the way many Americans view the role of the President's wife. I'm sure that the future work you do as First Lady will help you continue to reinvent the office, especially if, as you say, you intend to focus on children's issues next. It's been said before but it bears repeating: not since Eleanor Roosevelt has a woman attempted to accomplish so much in the office of the First Lady as you have.

This is why I am writing to you: for a book to reflect best your ideas, your beliefs, and, most important, your personality it would be invaluable for me to have some level of access to you. I do not mean to suggest that I need for you to sit for endless interviews. Instead, I'd like to follow you around for some period of time--the exact length of time could be negotiated--to get to know better how you work, how you think, how you have accomplished what you have.

I'd like to be a member of the Washington press corps but with somewhat more access to you, your schedule, your staff, and your associates, not unlike the Newsweek reporter who followed you and your husband around during the campaign.

Let me reassure you that my book would be a flattering portrait of you. I do not undertake booklength projects on people I do not admire or subjects about which I do not care passionately. As you may know, I wrote *Rough Magic*, a biography of Sylvia Plath; recently, Tipper Gore included that book, along with two others, on her list of recommended reading for older teenagers on the subject of mental health. I have also finished two nonfiction books that will be published next year: *Boulevard of Broken Dreams*, a biography of James Dean, to be released by Viking, and *Death and Disaster*, a piece of journalism about the controversy surrounding the estate and foundation of Andy Warhol, to be released by Villard/Random House. A former reporter for the Houston bureau of *Time*, I have published journalism in *The New York Times Magazine*, *The Nation*, *New York*, *The Village Voice*, and *The Guardian* in England, among several other periodicals.

I have mentioned to Steve Wasserman and Julie Grau (my editor for the Warhol book), both of whom are within the Random House publishing group, that I would like to undertake a book on you in the tradition of *The Making of a President*. They are extremely enthusiastic that a book of this sort could not only be serious and valuable but also widely read.

I hope that this project interests you. Perhaps if I could speak with you briefly, either in person or on the telephone, I could discuss with you in more detail how I see this book coming to fruition.

I look forward to hearing from you soon.

We are writing on behalf of Oxford University Press and Wellesley College to invite you to participate in an exciting and, we believe, groundbreaking project we are jointly sponsoring.

Wellesley and Oxford are about to launch an annual lecture series modelled on the distinguished Clarendon lectures given at Oxford University. It will be called "The Oxford University Press/Wellesley College Lectures," and will feature distinguished women whose work and ideas have made a major contribution to contemporary intellectual life.

Each year one woman will be invited to deliver these lectures on a topic of her choice. The work should be original, and the lecturer will be given free reign to pursue any topic so long as it addresses questions of broad social or cultural significance. The series will be the centerpiece of Wellesley's public lecture program and, unlike other lectures at the college, will consist of multiple lectures by one speaker. We envision two large public lectures and a third talk to a smaller more interactive audience, perhaps a joint student-faculty colloquium linked to the subject matter, sometime during the week. You may require a different format, and we would of course be open to alternatives.

These lectures will be permanently preserved in book form under a special joint Oxford University Press/Wellesley College imprint, in what we hope will grow to be a unique body of creative criticism by leading women in the world of letters, the arts, public policy, the sciences, and history. With the participation of distinguished lecturers such as yourself, we anticipate that the books spawned by this venture will be widely read and will help shape both international and public policy discussions in years ahead. In the past, Oxford and the New York Public Library have entered a similar venture. Last spring, Oxford and the Library jointly published Robert Hughes's Culture of Complaint: The Fraying of America (copy enclosed). The book is based upon the Oxford/Public Library lectures he delivered in January 1992. At the time the lectures attracted a good deal of attention. The book has attracted much more, and indeed was on the New York Times bestseller list for several months.

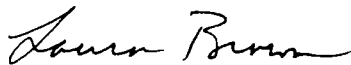
