Jazz is America's classical music. Unlike its European, aristocratic counterpart, jazz is participatory; written, yet improvised; a music which commands not only the attention but the participation of the audience. Like the country itself—and especially like the people who created it—jazz is a music born of struggle but played in celebration.

This unique American musical and cultural art form, more than a century old, has paused periodically in its evolution to give us ragtime, boogie-woogie, swing, bebop, cool, free jazz, and fusion, only to continue its restless rebirth into forms that have yet to be named. Original and enduring, adapting and growing, jazz is simply one of America's greatest living citizens and proudest traditions.

And now, jazz will be heard again in the White House as President and Mrs. Clinton revive another tradition, the PBS program titled "In Performance at the White House." To celebrate the 40th year of the Newport Jazz Festival's creation, a concert by some of America's most prodigious jazz performers will occur at the White House tonight. A one-hour version of this planned two-hour concert will be broadcast on the evening of September 12, 1993, when "In Performance at the White House" is televised nationally on PBS and broadcast locally on WETA TV.

Tonight's concert is co-produced by George Wein, creator of the Newport Jazz Festival who, as much as any living American, has made jazz music available and accessible to ever widening audiences. Joining Mr. Wein in the role of co-producer is the Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz, a non-profit organization, under the leadership of Tom Carter, dedicated to the advancement of America's jazz tradition by nurturing the ability of young performers to study and play jazz.

Prior to tonight's televised concert, the Smithsonian Masterworks Orchestra will perform a variety of jazz favorites from the White House Balcony.

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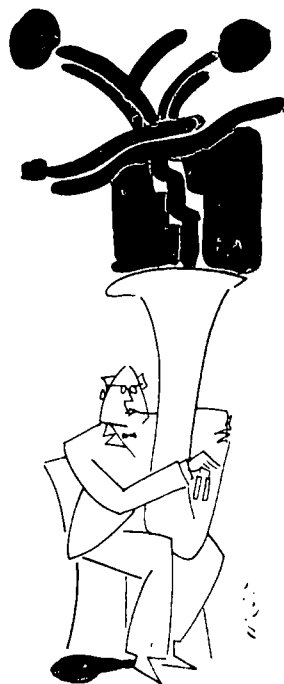
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JUMPIN' AT THE WHITE HOUSE

IN the middle of June, 1978, President Jimmy Carter gave a serene and joyous jazz concert on the South Lawn of the White House. It began with the sun boiling in over the old Executive Office Building and ended, three hours later, under a cool yellow moon. Almost everyone who mattered played, from the Young Tuxedo Brass Band of New Orleans to Cecil Taylor and Ornette Coleman. At the end of the evening, Dizzy Gillespie invited Carter to sing the bebop tune "Salt Peanuts" with him, and, after some Gillespie coaching, he did. Gillespie asked



the President if he would like to go on the road with him, and Carter said, "I might have to after tonight." But the concert was not a White House first. Nine years earlier, President Nixon celebrated Duke Ellington's seventieth birthday with a dinner followed by a concert and a dance. Nixon presented Ellington with the Presidential Medal of Freedom, and Ellington gave the President the classic French greeting of right cheek on right cheek, left cheek on left cheek. Nixon played "Happy Birthday" on the piano in G, and Ellington improvised a Debussyesque solo in honor of Mrs. Nixon. Two dozen Ellington numbers were played—not by the Ellington band, which, for whatever reason, was absent, but by a faultless all-star group made up of the likes of Clark Terry, Paul Desmond, Hank Jones, Gerry Mulligan, Jim Hall, and Louis Bellson. Jazz, excluded from the White House for seventy years, had suddenly arrived.

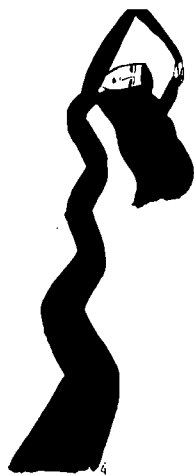
This past June, fifteen years to the day after the Carter concert, the White House again embraced the music. The celebration, prompted by the fortieth

anniversary of the Newport Jazz Festival, came in two parts and lasted nearly four hours. The first part was taken up by the superb Smithsonian Jazz Masterworks Orchestra, nineteen strong and conducted alternately by Gunther Schuller and David Baker, and the second part by three small bands, with two solo pianists and several singers interspersed. The S.J.M.O., starting around six o'clock, held forth on the South Balcony of the White House, and the rest of the music, starting two hours later, took place inside a huge warehouse of a tent that had been set up on the South Lawn directly behind

the White House. (President Carter's entire evening had been alfresco, with the audience seated at picnic tables or on the grass.) The Smithsonian band included the mellifluous trumpeter Joe Wilder; two old Ellington trombonists, Britt Woodman and Buster Cooper; and the ingenious Lester Young saxophonist Loren Schoenberg, and it offered upward of thirty big-band anthems, among them Charlie Barnet's "Cherokee" and "Skyliner," Tommy Dorsey's "Well, Git It," Count Basie's "Shiny Stockings," and Duke Ellington's "Rockin' in Rhythm" and "Main Stem." As it turned out, though, the band, sitting some thirty feet above the ground behind a substantial railing, was barely audible. The music either wafted into the nearby magnolia trees, or, piped into the tent, was reduced to Muzak. WETA-TV, the PBS outlet in Washington, had agreed to film the second part of the evening for an "In Performance at the White House" program, and apparently someone had decided that the S.J.M.O., if allowed to perform inside the tent, would only clutter up the bandstand. In fact, the bandstand

seemed big enough to hold a symphony orchestra, and the band's paraphernalia could have been removed from the stand several times over during the half hour between its last number and the second part of the program. In effect, the best jazz repertory band in the country, playing what was often the best music of the concert, was used for seating music.

At precisely seven-fifty, the President and Mrs. Clinton appeared onstage in the tent—she in a black-and-tan animal-print top and wide-legged black pants, and he in a navy blazer, gray pants, and a purplish shirt open at the neck. Mrs. Clinton introduced the President by saying that there is “no bigger jazz fan in the country,” and Clinton said that jazz was “America’s classical music,” a music of “struggle, but played in celebration.” The Clintons sat down at adjoining tables immediately in front of the bandstand. (There were more than seventy tables



in the tent, each seating ten people.) Wynton Marsalis brought out his septet and played his own thirteen-minute suite “Modern Vistas As Far As the Eye Can See,” which had discordant Charles Mingus ensembles, Ellington harmonies, a lovely repeated descending figure, and a Marsalis solo full of Rex Stewart half-valving and guttural sounds. The second number, announced as an Ellington blues called “Play the Blues and Go,” was strikingly similar to the sinuous, loose-limbed blues that Johnny Hodges used to write in his sleep. (At this point, the greenery outside was turning dusk-gray, and various helicopterlike insects had discovered that the tent, roughly the temperature of a brick factory, was open on the sides.) A young pianist from Santo Domingo named Michel Camilo played an ornate solo ballad that matched his flaming-orange suit. Rosemary Clooney, under orders to do just two numbers, sang “Love Is Here to Stay” and Dave Frishberg’s funny, forlorn hymn to the loneliness of being on the road, “Sweet Kentucky Ham,” and then, her voice just beginning to jell and the audience just beginning to get her into focus, left the stage. A somewhat ill-matched pickup group, led by Illinois Jacquet,

and including Clark Terry on trumpet, Al Grey on trombone, Dewey Redman’s son Joshua on saxophone, Dick Hyman on piano, Charlie Haden on bass, and Elvin Jones on drums, played a medium-tempo “I Got Rhythm” variant called “One More for Dizzy,” on which Jacquet pasted his famous “Flyin’ Home” solo, a classic example of a long-frozen improvisation that is nonetheless fluid and stirring every time he plays it. Not much else happened in the number until Elvin Jones, taming his style for the music at hand, took a slashing, startling eight-bar solo in the final chorus. In the group’s second tune, a medium blues, Terry, playing sotto voce, got off a double-time figure that went by so fast it was back before it had left, and Jacquet moved his sumptuous Southwestern tone around like a dealer arranging bibelots.

Television lights had been blazing since the set began, and two or three handheld cameras swam relentlessly around the stage, seemingly peering into the musicians’ ears, examining their cuticles, and counting their hairs. Dorothy Donegan, got up in a silver jacket and navy-blue pants covered with sequins, sat down at the piano and made a moue at the President, who, transfixed since the music began, gave his all-purpose half smile and tilted his head slightly to his left. For the next three or four dazzling minutes, Donegan showed us a cross-section of a number whose layers were made up of “I Can’t Get Started,” some Rachmaninoff, “The Man I Love,” and boogie-woogie. As she gained speed, her right leg began gyrating, and it looked as if she might jump up and do one of her tumultuous dances, but she contained herself, finishing with a blinding two-handed run.

Into each concert some acedia must fall, and Bobby McFerrin wound his way through two of his surrealistic vocal exercises, one solo and one with the pianist Herbie Hancock, who then accompanied Joe Henderson, a kind of secular John Coltrane, in what has become his “Body and Soul”—Billy Strayhorn’s “Lush Life.” Hancock stayed on to back the flaccid soprano saxophonist

Grover Washington, Jr., who played a Hancock tune called “Just Enough,” and both made way for the evening’s final pickup group, a muscular bebop assemblage that numbered Red Rodney and Jon Faddis; Jimmy Heath, Henderson, and Washington; and a rhythm section of John Lewis, Christian McBride, and Thelonious Monk, Jr. They played medium-tempo versions of Dizzy Gillespie’s “A Night in Tunisia” and “Confirmation.” John Lewis, soloing in both numbers, offset Faddis’s crimson overblowing, and so did Rodney, in two beautifully structured solos.

Joe Williams joined the group for the finale, and sang “Every Day I Have the Blues” and Joe Turner’s “Shake, Rattle and Roll.” When Williams sang the words “I’d rather drink muddy water and sleep in a hollow log,” he asked the audience to join in, and the President obliged. At the end of the second number, Clinton ran onto the stage, shook hands with everyone, and summoned all the earlier performers. He said something about jazz being a “music of inclusion, a music of democracy,” and suddenly someone handed him a tenor saxophone. Miles Davis’s waltz “All Blues” began, and Clinton, with Illinois Jacquet standing beside him, shepherd-fashion, took two fine choruses of the sort you might have heard on a Big Bill Broonzy record from the forties. (He is, however, a Zoot Sims fan. Not long ago, he wrote Louise Sims, Zoot’s widow, saying, “I loved Zoot’s music and would have been honored to have him play at my Inauguration.”) Williams and McFerrin started singing, and Clinton joined Jacquet and Joe Henderson for some background riffs. The music gradually subsided, and Jacquet hugged the President. Clinton left the stage and joined Mrs. Clinton, and they were immediately swallowed by well-wishers. But his two choruses of the blues hung above this jostling panorama like a prayer. ♦
