Anthem and Vatican Anthem), Red Carpet

The President and First Lady Greet
Other Greeters TBA - Vatican to provide their
lists today or tomorrow. So far they have
suggested the greeting line to include the
following people:

The Archbishop of Denver, The President and
Vice-President of the National Conference of
Catholic Bishops, the six U.S. Cardinals, the
three suffragan bishops of Pueblo, Colorado
Springs, and Cheyenne, the Ambassadors of
Poland and Italy (they suggest we invite the
Ambassadors), Governor Roemer and wife, the
Mayor of Denver and wife, Members of Congress
from Colorado and their spouses.

About 1,100 guests not included in the
official greeting line will be present at the
airport for this event. (Members of Congress,
Cabinet Members, Senior White House Staff,
Lay people, Clergy, CO State and Local
Officials, young adults and children from the
World Youth Day Conference.

After official greeting POTUS and the Pope
will proceed to a stage where each will make
5 min. remarks.

After the remarks POTUS and the Pope will
proceed to separate helicopters. They will
shake hands on a ropeline with 200 children
from the World Youth Day Conference while
walking to the helicopters.

MEMORANDUM

JUNE 15, 1993

SUBJECT: UPCOMING PAPAL VISIT, AUGUST 12, 1993, DENVER, CO.

After a two day pre-advance to select possible sites for a private meeting between the President and the Pope, I propose the following:

2:00 p.m. - Arrive Stapleton International Airport (Combs Aviation) This is the site of the official welcome on behalf of the President. There will be approx. 1000 young adults and children in attendance. Both the Pope and the President will make brief remarks and work short ropeline before exiting. Upon our exit the 1000 attendees will be bused to Mile High Stadium where the Pope will address them later as part of the National Youth Conference.

Ceremony of Welcome (to be determined)

2:45 p.m. - Transfer by helicopter to Regis University. The reason for the use of the helicopters is to avoid a logistical nightmare of two separate motorcades through the neighborhoods and tapping into security for the routes.

The reasons I propose for selecting Regis University are as follows: campus is relatively easy to secure and is only minutes from Stapleton International Airport, a media center will already be operational on campus for the International Youth Forum, Regis is the only Catholic University in the Rocky Mountain region and the President received his Jesuit education through Regis's sister institution, Georgetown University. In addition, Regis provides us with beautiful visuals fitting for such a visit.

2:55 p.m. - Arrive Regis University and do a brief meet and greet at Main Hall. Proceed down pathway, through wooded area to Carroll Hall Garden and provide brief photo-op. Continue pathway inside Carroll Hall to private meeting room (brief photo-op).

3:10 p.m. - Private meeting between Pope and President.

4:10 p.m. - Proceed to depart. (Pope to transfer by helicopter to Mile High Stadium for speech. President to transfer either by

helicopter to airport to depart or motorcade to a site for possible Romer event.)

There were several other sites viewed for a possible visit (see attached photos and documentation), however, this particular site was the only one I felt worked the best and that the Vatican seemed to be willing to consider.

As I was writing this memo, I received a telephone call (Tuesday, June 15, 1993, 10:30a.m.) from Rev. Ken Jenkins, Assistant General Secretary for the National Conference of Catholic Bishops and the representative for the Pope. He informed me that out of all the sites discussed with the Vatican, the only one they would sign off on was Regis University. He stated that an official invitation should be forward to the Pope through the State Department. Furthermore, I would also suggest that the Vice-President be available for the departure of the Pope on Sunday, August 15, 1993, approx. departure 7:15 p.m.
