Faubus: From farm girl to first lady

OZARK PROFILE

As a child, Alta Haskins Faubus said, she never dreamed she would be first lady of Arkansas, playing hostess to world leaders.

She said she had a quiet, happy childhood in the Madison County community of Bald Creek.

"I was just one of seven kids on a hillside farm," Faubus said. "I didn't know there was another world."

Faubus said they had chores, but there was always time to play.

"We had to make our own entertainment, so we played outside, climbing trees and playing in the creek," she said. "Our dresses were made out of calico flour sacks, and we were proud of them."

She met Orval Faubus at a teachers' meeting at Old Main when she was 19 years old, she said.

"I think we liked each other pretty well right away," Faubus said. "He came to see me the next Sunday."

They were soon married and living on their own farm, within walking distance of her childhood home.

"When Orval and I got engaged, he had \$200 in the St. Paul

bank," Faubus said. "The bank failed and he lost his money, so I didn't get an engagement ring then. But we were happy."

Her fond memories of the former governor stay with her today.

"After we got married, when he was walking in the woods, he'd always bring me a pretty flower or leaf," she said. "He loved nature."

Their pastoral lifestyle lasted until World War II started.

"That was when our lives really began to change," Faubus said. "He went in a private and came out a major. After Orval got out of the service he asked me if he should go into government or stay

in the service. I wanted to tell him to stay in the service. We'd had such fun in the service. But I said, 'It's your life. I'm not going to tell you what to do. Maybe I should have told him to stay in - maybe then things would have ended differently.'"

Orval Faubus' political career moved quickly from local offices to the state level, she said.

"I begged him not to run for governor," Faubus said. "He said 'Why do you care? You won't have to do anything. On the night of his first election he said to me 'Alta, you're going to do something tonight you've never done before. You're going to sleep with the governor.'"

But politics soon took over their lives, Faubus said.

"It was like a whirlwind,

everyone was pulling me this way and that," she said. "We didn't have a private life. When Orval came home he was tired. He didn't have any time or energy for anything but his job."

Faubus said she had a difficult time at first adjusting to life in the mansion.

"I didn't feel comfortable," she said. "I felt like I was in a museum. At first I was doing my own work, washing out my personal clothing and all. Then one of the maids said to me 'Mrs. Faubus, let me do that. You be Cinderella while you can.' I finally came to feel the mansion was home. I loved living there. I just didn't like all the duties."

Not only her life changed, however. The state has seen many changes, too.

"This state was so poor when Orval was elected governor," she said. "He was a man of the people. He identified with the people. We both did."

"We would read letters that came in," Faubus said. "I'd get up at night to see why he hadn't come to bed yet and he'd be sitting up reading letters. He'd read them to me for a while, then I would read some to him. Some of those letters were so sad we'd cry."

Alta and Orval Faubus worked together during his campaigns until 1964, when he became ill and was hospitalized.

"I took over his campaign in 1964," Faubus said. "I won that election. It was the last time he won. In 1970, after our divorce, a lot of people asked me to run

against him. I think I could have won against him."

The years after the divorce were dark ones, Faubus said. Her husband had left her for a younger woman, and her son, Farrell, died of a drug overdose.

"There has long been a misperception about Farrell's problems," Faubus said. "He became addicted to prescription drugs while he was a teenager. He was not a bad boy, or a criminal. He had just gone through a divorce when he died. I think it's important for people to know that."

As much as her life switched gears from farm girl to first lady of the state, Faubus had make other changes after her divorce.

"It was hard to adjust after being the governor's wife," Faubus

said. "I was always on the go and never had to cook or keep house. For 12 years I had everyone doing for me. And suddenly I had to readjust."

Her life might not have been easy, but Faubus has certainly not lived a boring existence. She said she spent the last night of 1967 in the governor's mansion with her granddaughter Fara.

"We slept on the sofa, because the furniture was already moved," she said.

After that final night, she returned home to Huntsville, where she has lived since. But for all the experiences she's had, she said she wouldn't change a thing.

"I wouldn't change any of my time with Orval," Faubus said. "We did things together, neither of us would never have done alone."

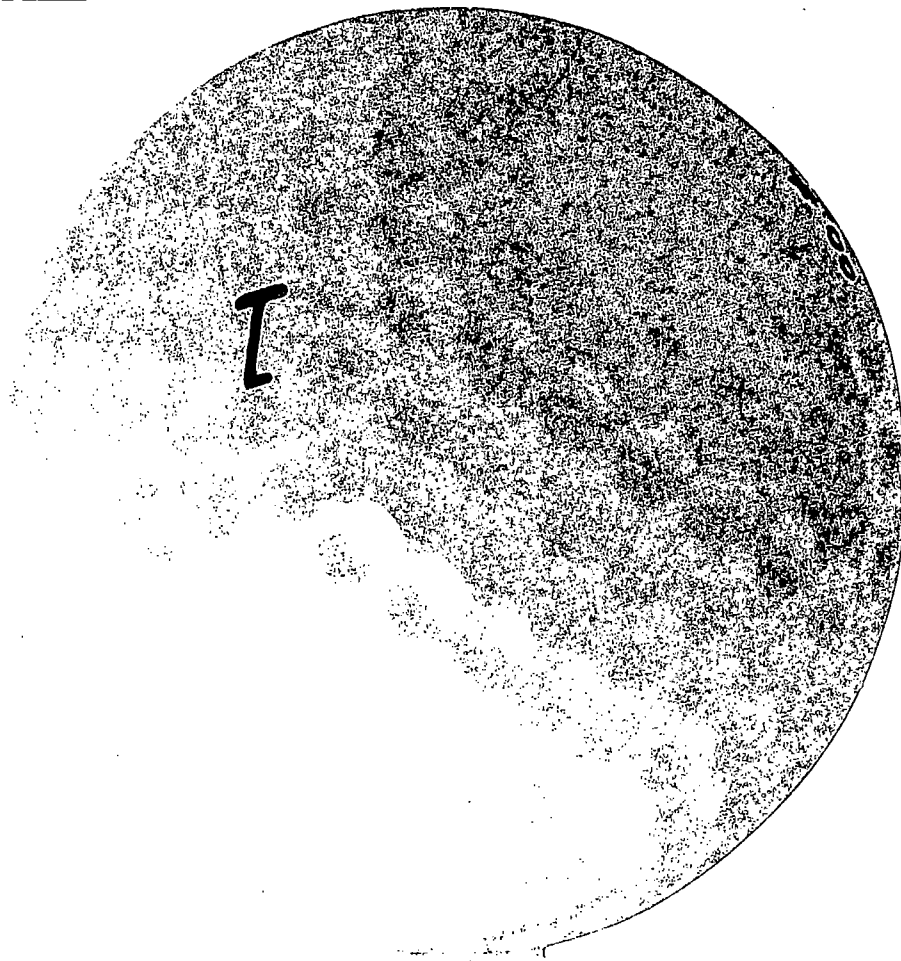

GOLF BALL

The golf ball, made for centuries from boiled feathers stuffed into a sack of bull's hide, now has a liquid, rubber or steel center wound with 30 yards of rubber thread. The "dimples" on the outer casing increase the distance and accuracy of flight. With the modern ball and steel club, a spectacular drive can exceed 400 yards.

One of America's favorite outdoor sports, golf is played by more than 16 million people annually at more than 20,000 golf courses in the U.S. on land valued at more than 4½ billion dollars. Today's game of golf began in Scotland at least five centuries ago, though Chinese golfers trace its roots back to second century B.C. China. In 1947, golfing was banned by the King of Scotland because its popularity threatened the practice of archery required for national defense. Golf came to America in the late 19th century and soon became a widespread popular recreation, as well as a major competitive and spectator sport. The game combines healthy outdoor recreation and relaxation with concentration, power, precision, and friendly competition.

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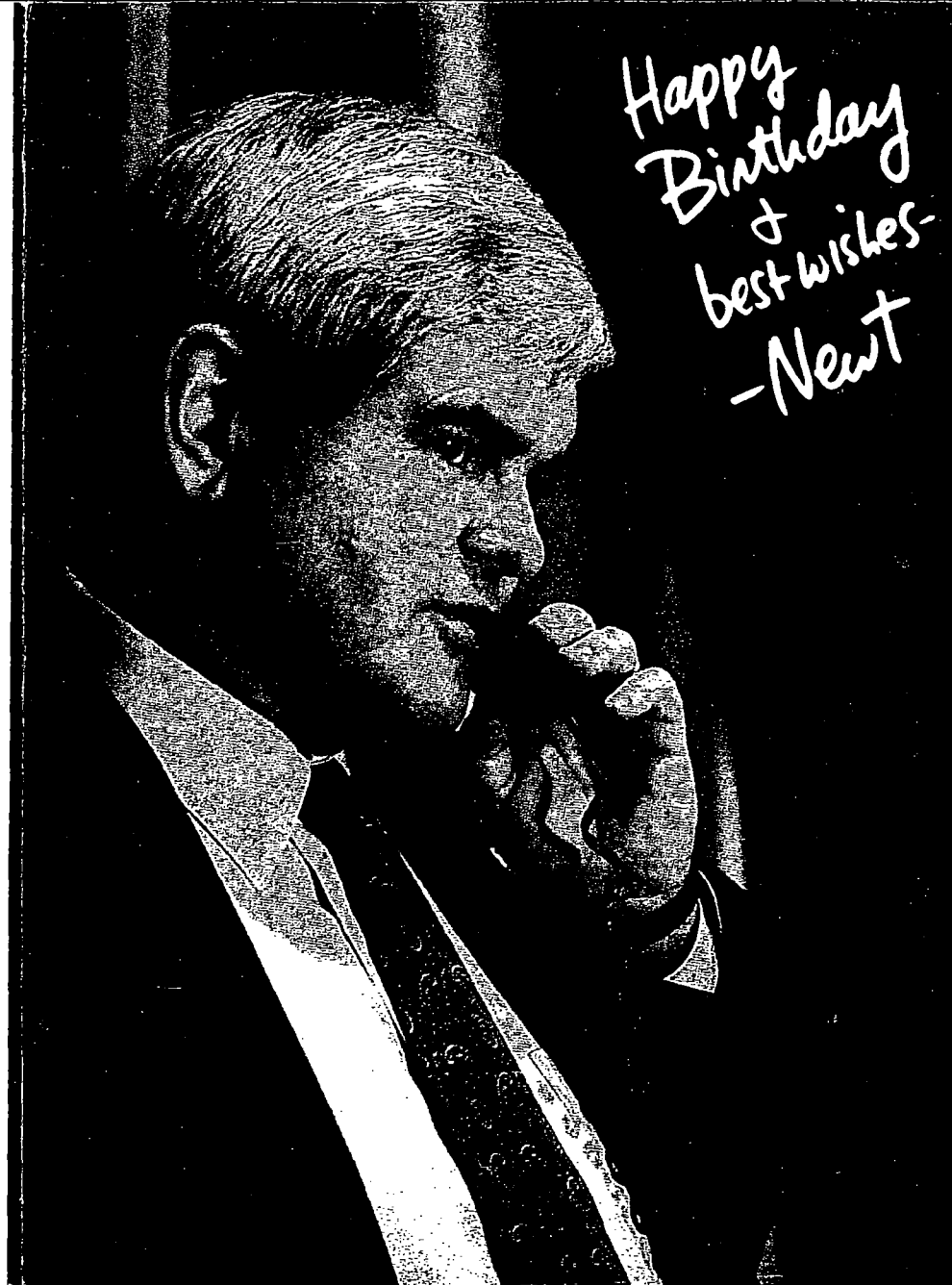

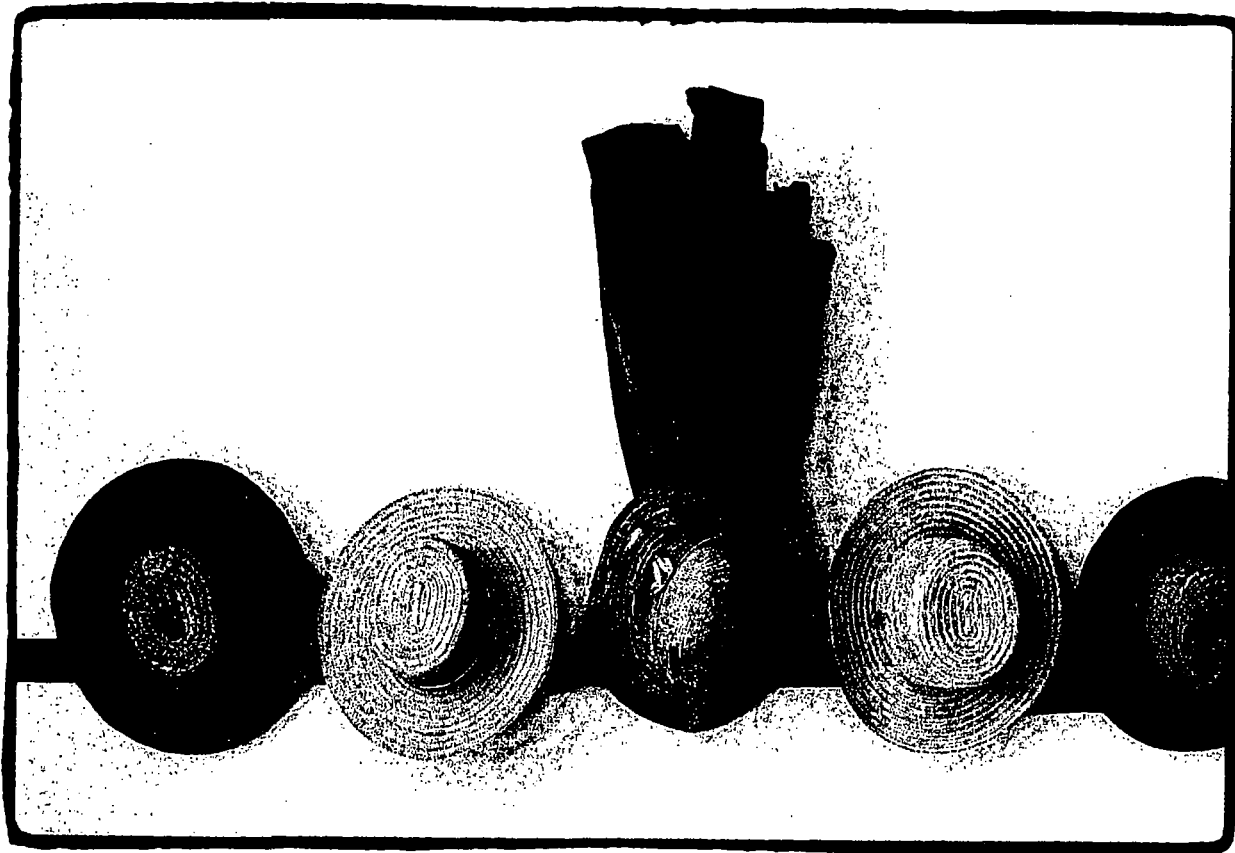
