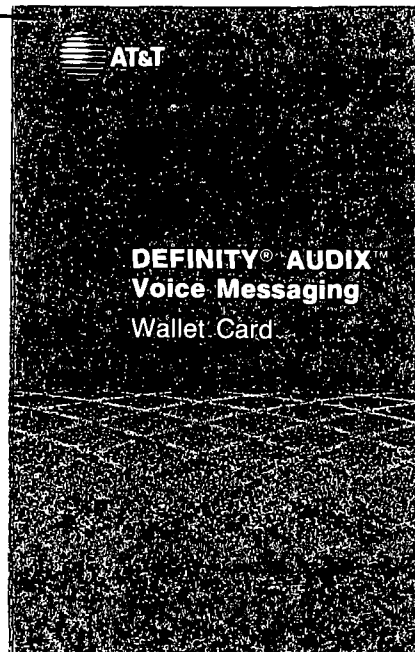

Your ISDN 8510T Voice Terminal

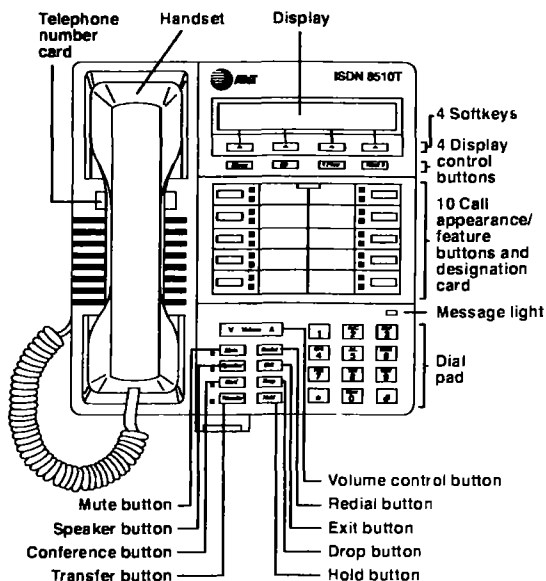


FIGURE 1 8510T Voice Terminal (Top View)

Before you begin using your ISDN 8510T voice terminal, familiarize yourself with its features, lights, jacks, and other components. To help you do this, Figure 1 shows you the top view of the 8510T voice terminal.

Feature Descriptions

Here are brief descriptions of the voice features and the features accessed with the softkeys, including what each one does and how you might want to use it.

VOICE FEATURES

Conference Allows you to add an additional party to a call so that you can conduct a conversation with more than one party. Use to set up time-saving conferences, or to spontaneously include a party important to a discussion.

Drop Disconnects you from a call without requiring you to hang up the handset or press the switchhook. Can also be used with the Conference feature to disconnect the last party added. Use whenever you are using the handset and want to continue using it for another action after ending a call.

Feature Descriptions (Continued)

VOICE FEATURES (Continued)

Hold Temporarily disconnects you from a call, holding it until you can return to it. While a call is on hold, you can place another call, activate another feature, answer a waiting call, or leave your voice terminal to perform another task. Use when you have a call that you don't wish to drop, but which you have to interrupt briefly to do something else.

Message Retrieval Your Message light goes on to let you know that a caller has left a message. Follow your System's message retrieval procedures to get your message.

Mute Turns off the microphone associated with the handset or the speakerphone, whichever is currently active. Use when you want to confer with someone in the room with you, but you do not want the other party on the call to hear your conversation. (You are still able to hear the person on the call.)

Redial (Last Number Dialed) Automatically redials the last number you dialed manually from the dial pad, either an extension or an outside number. Use to save time in redialing a busy or unanswered number.

Speakerphone Your voice terminal has either the Speaker (listen-only) or the Speakerphone (listen and talk) function or it may have neither. Check with the System Manager to see how your voice terminal is set.

The **Speaker** feature allows you to place calls or access other voice features without lifting the handset. (Press **Speaker**.) Use with features that require listening only, such as on-hook dialing or monitoring calls on hold. To speak to the other party, you must use the handset (the speaker must be off).

The **Speakerphone** feature allows you to place and answer calls or access other voice features without lifting the handset. (Press **Speaker**.) You may use the softkeys on the voice terminal to set or reset the speakerphone. When you set the built-in speakerphone, it performs a test of the surrounding environment and adjusts itself for optimal performance. Use the built-in speakerphone any time you prefer hands-free communications, both speaking and listening, or for group conference situations.

Transfer Transfers a call from your voice terminal to another extension. Use when your caller needs to speak further with someone else.

FEATURES ACCESSED WITH THE DISPLAY AND SOFTKEYS

The following features can be accessed using the four softkeys located below the display.

Call Log The Call Log is initially set to list only the ten most recent unanswered incoming calls. Another option allows you to access the ten most recent answered calls, and the ten most recent outgoing calls placed from your terminal. Use to check on calls you missed (unanswered calls) and to remind yourself of calls you answered or placed most recently.

Feature Descriptions (Continued)

FEATURES ACCESSED WITH THE DISPLAY AND SOFTKEYS (Continued)

Clock For setting the date and time on your voice terminal display.

Contrast Change the contrast level of your display so that the letters or numbers are darker or lighter against the background of the screen.

Director Used to create and edit a personal directory of up to 30 extensions or outside numbers and the names of the associated parties. Use **Dir** to quickly dial a call. Use as a handy place to store numbers you frequently call.

Dir Button When you press **Dir** followed by a softkey button associated with that Directory entry, a call is immediately placed to a telephone number. The phone number appears on the display screen as it dials.

Exit Button Exits a display feature and returns the voice terminal display to normal call-handling mode.

Lock Allows you to lock your Directory so that no one can make unauthorized changes in it; lock your Call Log so that no one else can view your Call Log entries; lock all of the softkeys so that no one can view or change any of the features accessed by the softkeys.

Number of Names (on a Directory Page) Allows you to view either four names or three names + **Quit** on the second line of an individual Directory page. If you can choose to have four names on the Directory screen at one time, you can leave the Directory or cancel calling a name in your Directory only by pressing **Dir** (rather than using **Quit**).

Personalized Ring Allows you to select your own personalized ringing pattern from among eight available patterns. Use to distinguish your voice terminal's ring from that of other nearby voice terminals.

Screen Timing (Rate at which the Display Message is Shown) Allows you to set the length of time the display message remains on the screen. There are three rates: Slow, Medium, and Fast.

Self-Test Performs a diagnostic test of your voice terminal, including the lights, ringer, dial pad keys, and display.

NOTE: When you perform a self-test of the voice terminal, it clears the contents of the Call Log and the last number dialed from Redial, and returns the volume control to the default setting.

Set Speakerphone When you set the built-in speakerphone, it performs a test of the surrounding environment and adjusts itself for optimal performance.

Tones A confirmation tone (sequential low and high tones) is provided to let you know a selection has been accepted; an error tone (one beep) alerts you that you made a mistake in your softkey entries. You may choose to turn these softkey information tones on or off.

ANSWERING AND PLACING A CALL

To place a call:

- The green light (below the red light) goes on steadily at the selected call appearance button.

2. Listen for the dial tone and dial the number you want to call.

To end (or drop) a call:

To prevent other party from hearing you:

TRANSFER

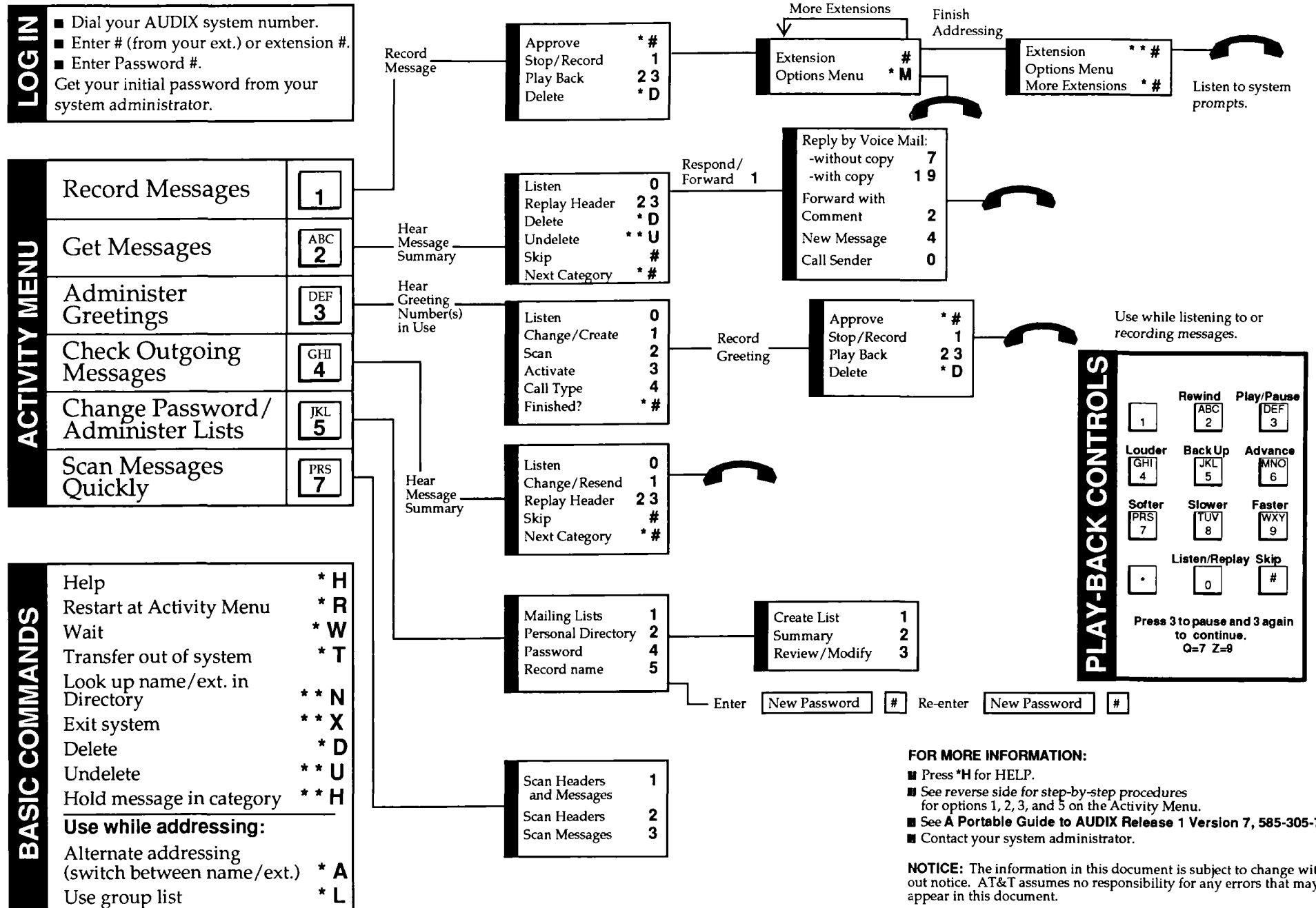

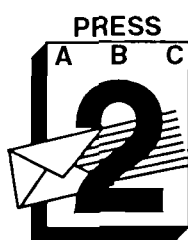

Talking It Over



You owe it to yourself to get a mammogram

Every Thursday, a woman named Miriam volunteers in my staff office at the White House. She is a retired schoolteacher, mother of two, proud grandmother and caring colleague who seldom arrives at work without cakes or cookies.

I wish her story ended here. But it doesn't. Like more than 2 million other women in America, Miriam has breast cancer.

She found a lump in her breast five years ago. Since then, she has undergone two surgeries, 33 days of radiation treatments and five separate chemotherapies, including the debilitating sessions she now has every week.

Miriam is not the only woman I know who is battling this disease. In fact, it is hard to find a family in our country — or a workplace, neighborhood, church group or social club — that has not been touched by breast cancer.

My mother-in-law, Virginia Kelley, died last year after a four-year struggle with the disease. The mother of one of my best friends was diagnosed a few months ago. Another friend just told me that his sister — only 41 years old — has a massive lump as well.

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. and if you want a chilling statistic, here it is: One in eight women in our country will develop breast cancer during her lifetime, compared to one in 20 a generation ago. And 46,000 American women will die of breast cancer this year.

Those numbers shouldn't be so high. When detected early and treated aggressively, breast cancer does not have to be a death sentence. Every week, I meet women who are longtime breast cancer survivors living full and healthy lives. The key to early detection is a regular mammogram, particularly for women over 65, who account for half of all breast cancer cases.

Younger women should discuss with their doctors whether they should get regular mammograms. When I turned 40, for example, I began having one every year.

In traveling around the country to talk with women about breast cancer, I was startled to learn that only 40 percent of older women, whose mammograms are now cov-

party at Jane and Bob Wilson's River Glen Circle home.

covered by Medicare, actually take advantage of this potentially lifesaving benefit.

Why do so many women fail to get mammograms?

Unfortunately, many are reluctant to get screened because they have been told that the procedure is painful or embarrassing. Some women lack insurance coverage or the money to pay for the test. Still others have never been told by their doctors that a mammogram is one of the most effective ways of detecting malignant breast lumps. Some women have even told me they didn't want to find out if they were sick because they believed there was little they could do about it.

Finally, many women are so busy taking care of their families that they forget to take care of their own health.

I know that a mammogram is not the most comfortable experience. And when you are responsible for kids, a spouse, a job and all the other pressures of daily life, taking the time to get one may seem like too much of a hassle.

But getting a mammogram is a lot more comfortable and a lot more convenient than the pain that comes with cancer and its treatments.

That's why it's important that Medicare continue to cover older women for mammograms every two years and at any other time a doctor believes it is necessary. And it would be a big step forward if communities and local health facilities also offered screenings for women who don't have health insurance.

When appropriate, doctors should encourage women patients to have regular mammograms. Any woman who fears breast cancer should remember that if she does have the disease, she should find out quickly so that she can begin treatment and get on with living her life.

That's what Miriam does. My staff and I often talk about how much we admire her courage and her selflessness. She tells us that she gets through her treatments by setting personal goals: getting her kitchen remodeled or living to see the birth of her new granddaughter, who was born last month. Now she is looking ahead to her 60th birthday in March.

She says she is no longer afraid of the disease and has no plans to stop her volunteer work. "I will come in until I just can't do it anymore," she said a few days ago. "The chemo hasn't knocked me down yet."

"Get a mammogram," she frequently reminds us. "It's much less frightening than not having the chance to see your children grow up or your grandchildren graduate from high school. You owe it to yourself and your family."

We should all listen to the words of one so wise.
