Mr. Hugh Ellsworth Rodham

A native of Scranton, Pennsylvania, Rodham was born on April 2, 1911. He graduated from Pennsylvania State University in 1935 with a bachelor of science degree in physical education and was a member of the varsity football team.

Rodham first worked at the Scranton Lace Company and then moved to Chicago where he worked in a drapery and curtain business. In Chicago, Rodham met his future wife, Dorothy Howell of Alhambra, California, in 1937. The couple married in 1942.

After serving as a Navy basic training instructor during World War II, Rodham returned to Chicago where he started a textile business. In 1970, he retired and he and his wife remained in Park Ridge, Illinois until moving to Little Rock, Arkansas in 1987.
