Former NJ Governor Tom Kean Endorses Lamar Alexander for President

Joins "Alexander's Band" as National Co-Chair and Chairman of NJ Campaign

CHERRY HILL, NJ - Republican presidential candidate Lamar Alexander scored a key endorsement in the delegate-rich northeast today as former New Jersey Governor Tom Kean announced he is joining the Alexander campaign as a national co-chair, and chairman of the New Jersey campaign effort. Kean joined Alexander at press conferences in Cherry Hill and Newark, New Jersey.

Alexander said Governor Kean's leadership would prove valuable in helping steer his campaign both nationally and in the New Jersey, Pennsylvania and New York metropolitan areas. Kean joins another prominent New Jersey GOP leader on the Alexander Team. Larry Bathgate, a former chairman of the Republican National Committee's Finance Committee who served as Jack Kemp's national finance chairman, signed on with Alexander as a national finance co-chair earlier this year.

Alexander was in Atlantic City, New Jersey last week to speak before the Northeast Republican Leadership Conference.
