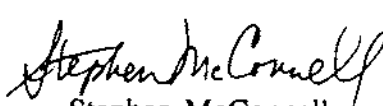
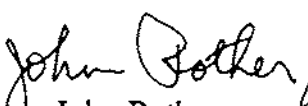
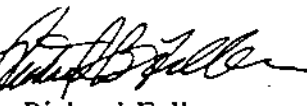
We proved them wrong. Look what happened:

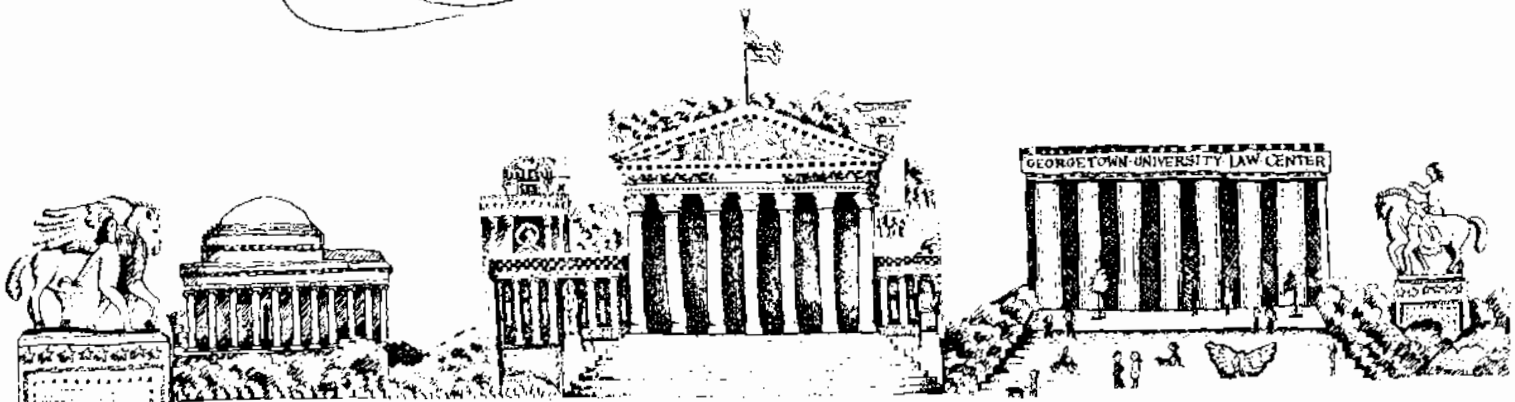

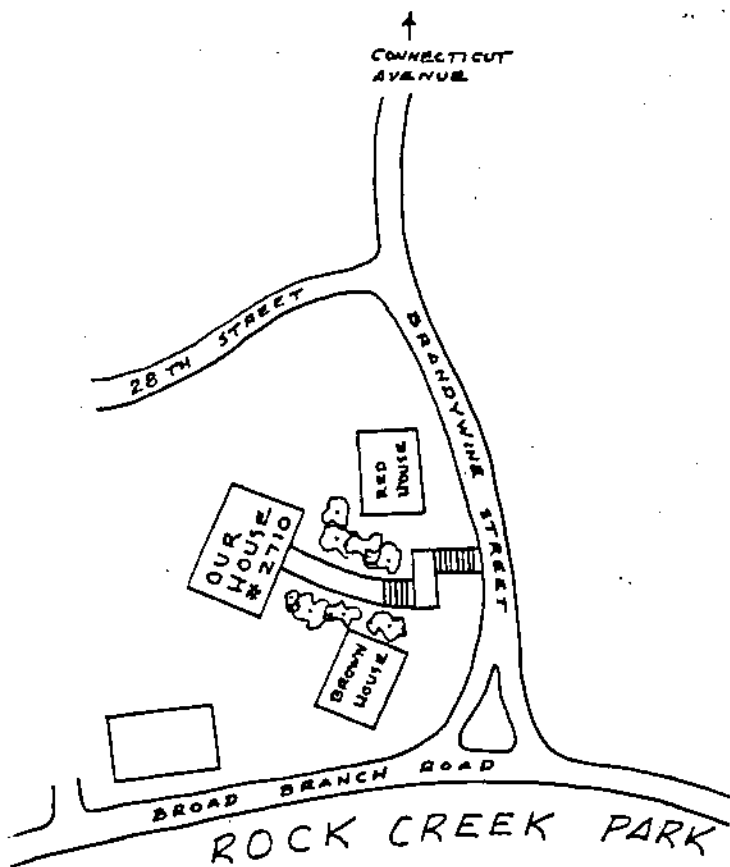
